

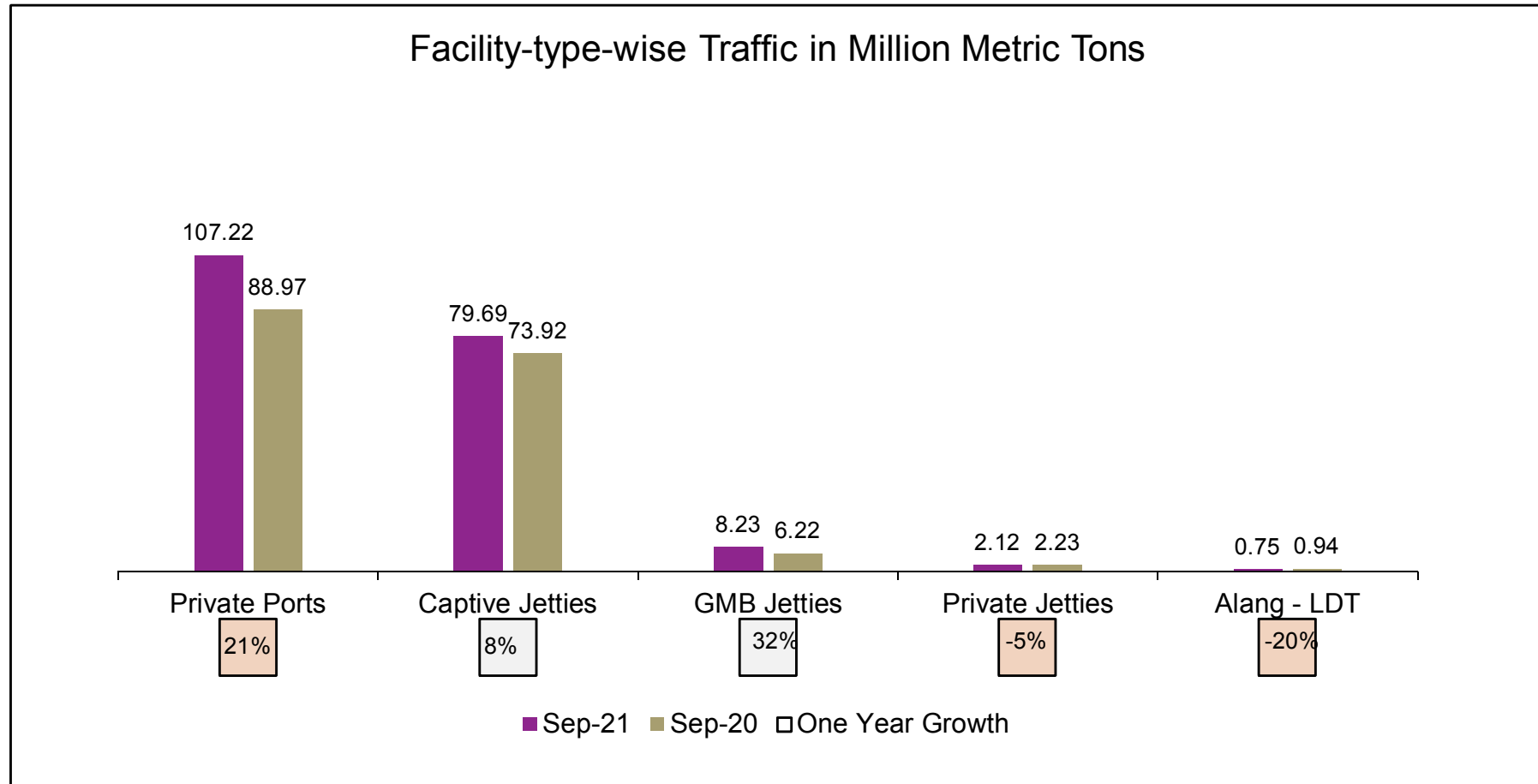

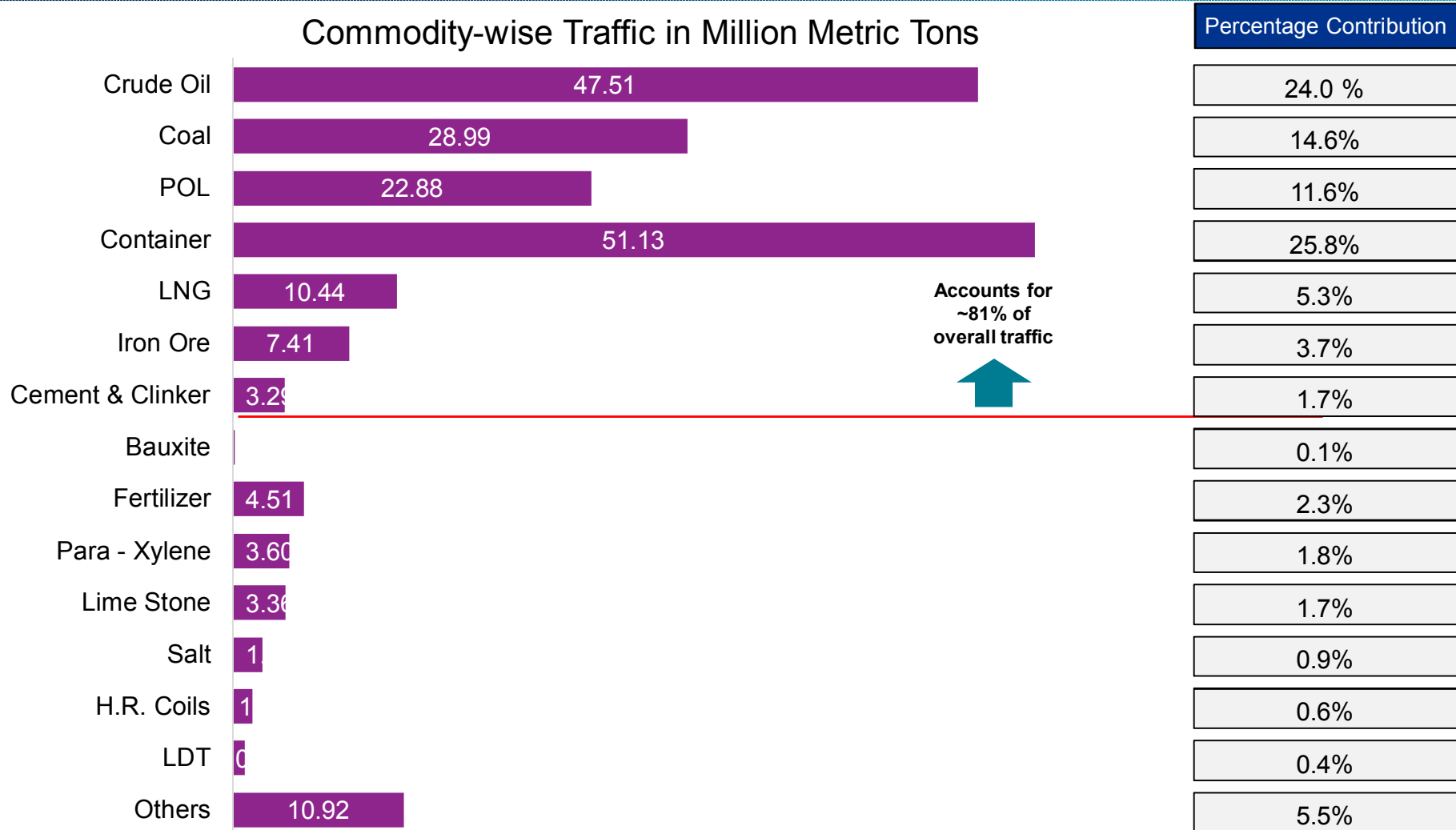

The GMB ports handled around **198.02 MMT** (Million Metric Tons) of traffic for the month of September - 21 of 2021-22, as compared to **172.28 MMT** of traffic handled during the same period last year.

Crude Oil, Coal, POL, Containers and LNG were the major commodities handled at GMB Group of ports. Major cargo handling port are Sikka, Mundra, Pipavav, Dahej and Hazira.



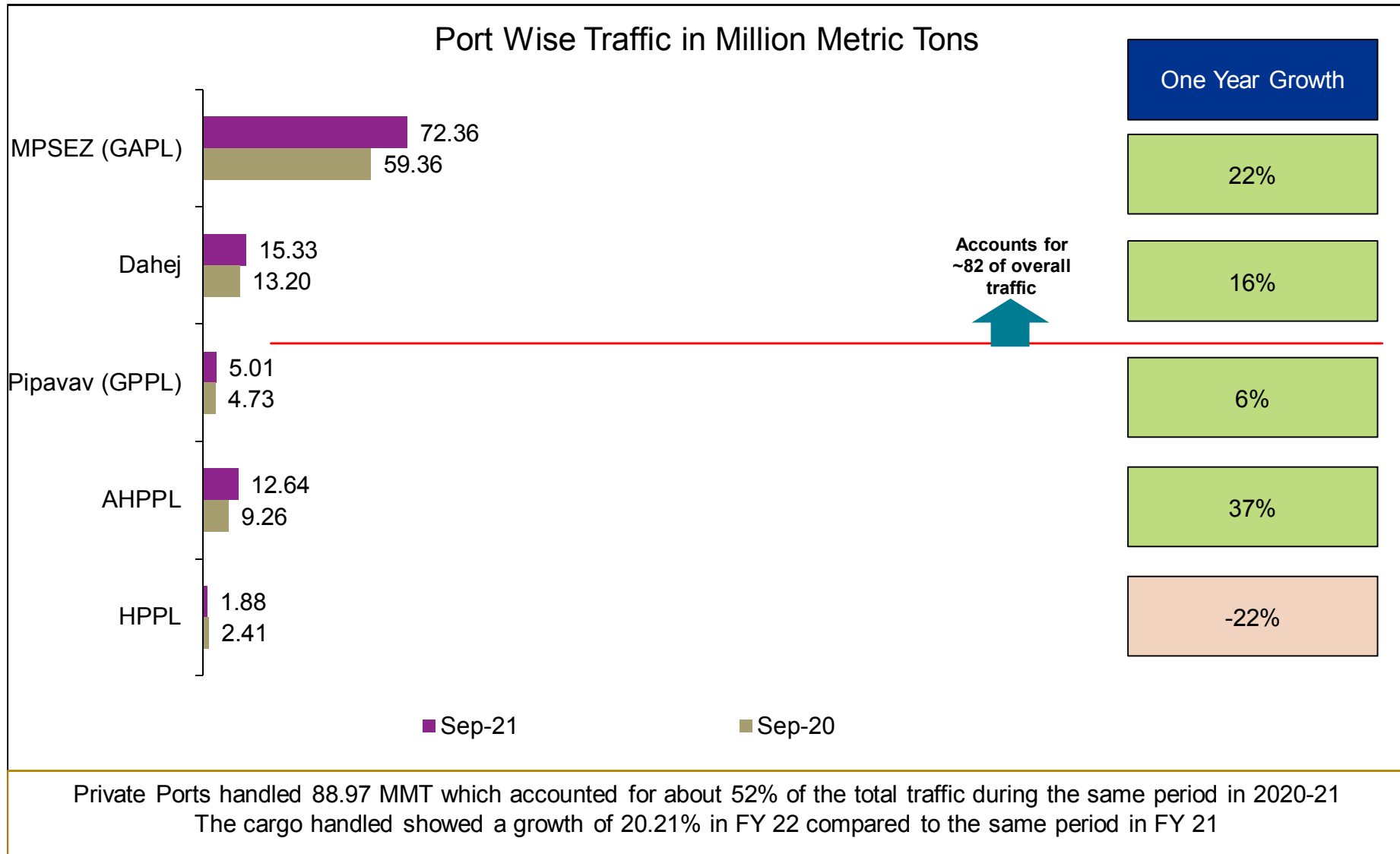

# Facility wise Traffic for the month of September of FY22

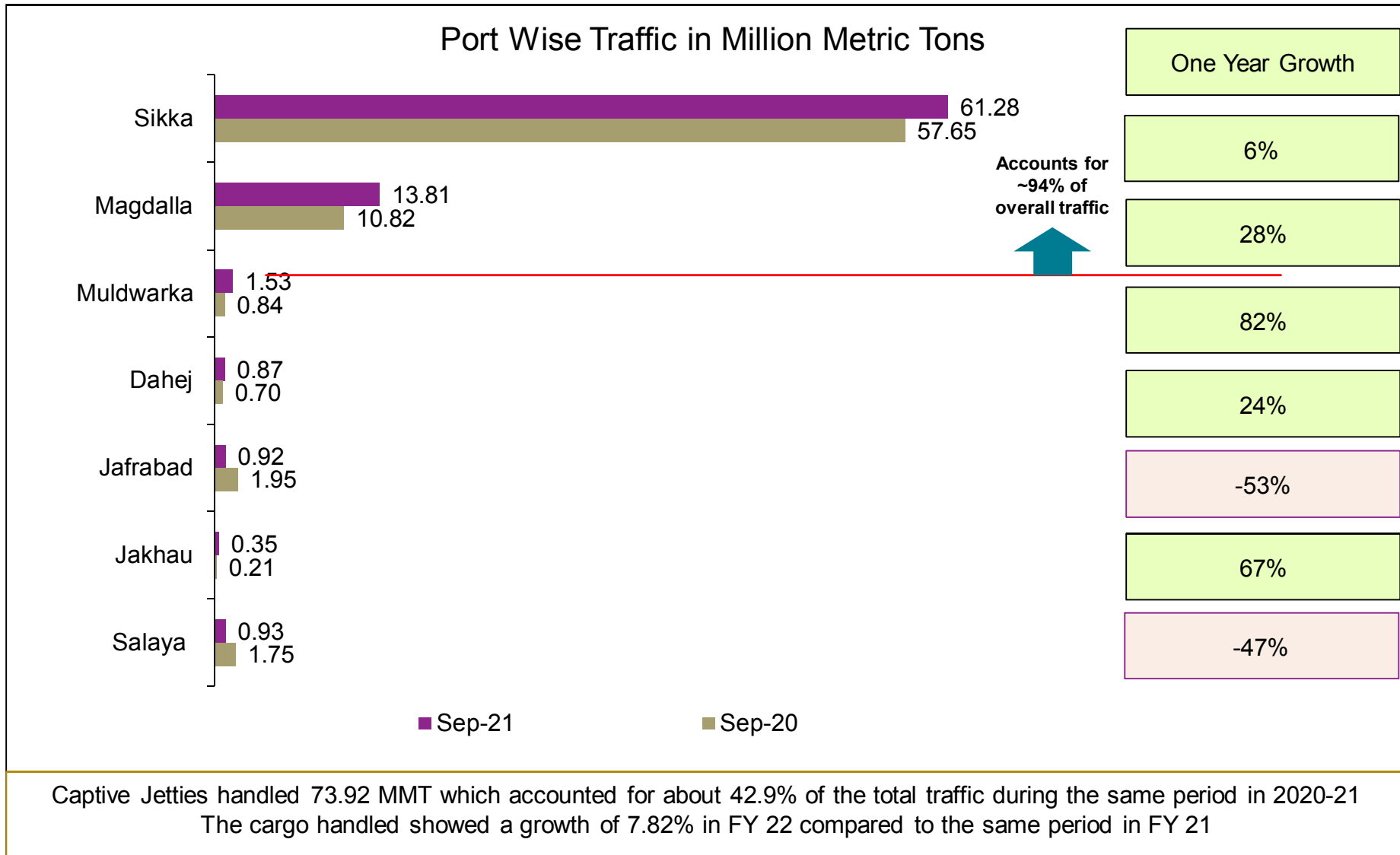

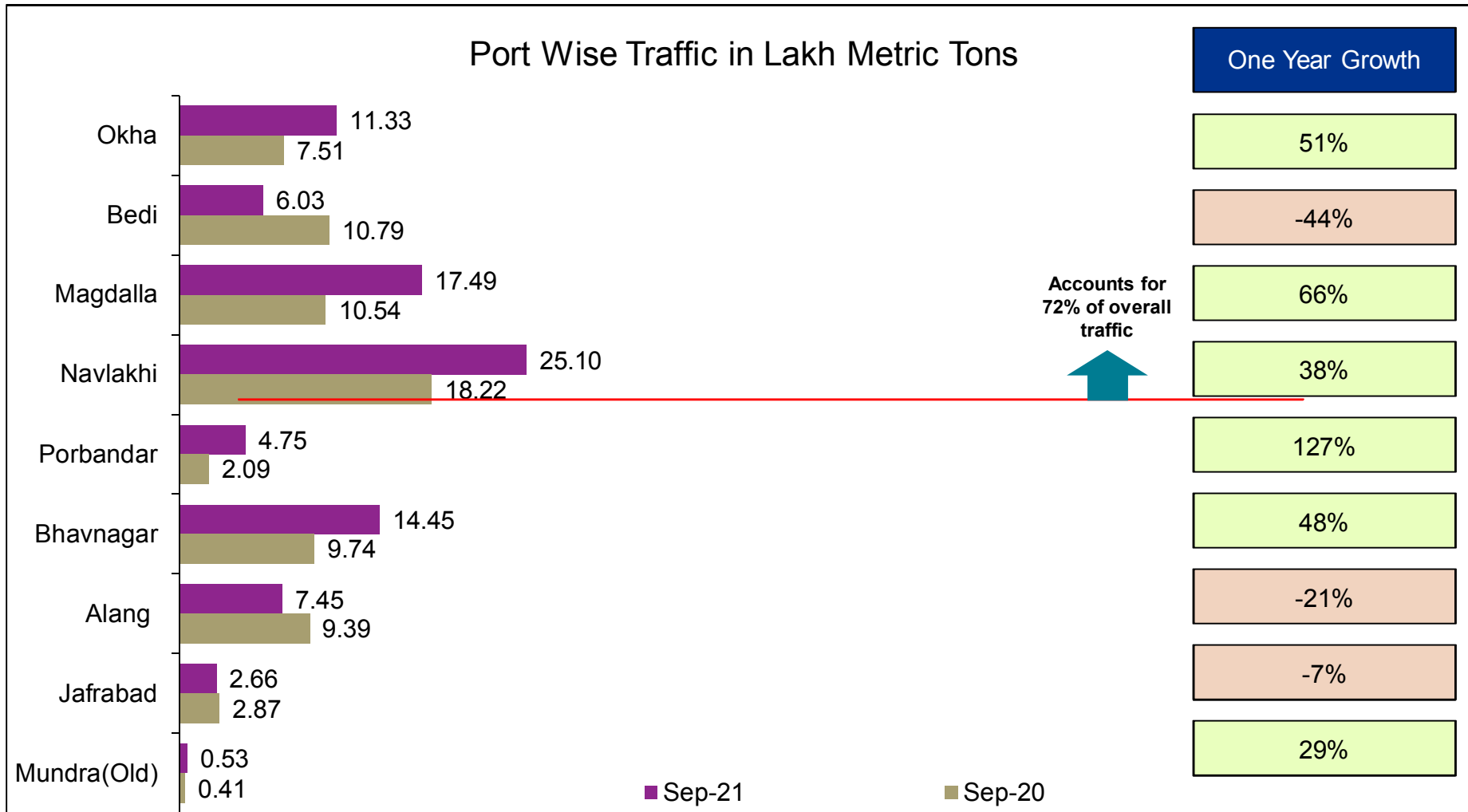
**Private Ports handled 107.22 MMT which accounted for about 54.1% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the month of September of FY 22**



**Captive Jetties handled 79.69 MMT which accounted for about 40.2% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in in the month of September of 39.9 FY 22**



**GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 8.98 MMT which accounted for about 4.5% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in the month of September of FY 22**



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 7.16 MMT tons which accounted for about 4.2% of the total traffic during the same period in 2020-21. The cargo handled showed a growth of 25.48% in FY 22 compared to the same period in FY21

**Private Jetties handled 2.12 MMT which accounted for about 1.07% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports of Gujarat for the month of September of FY 22**
