



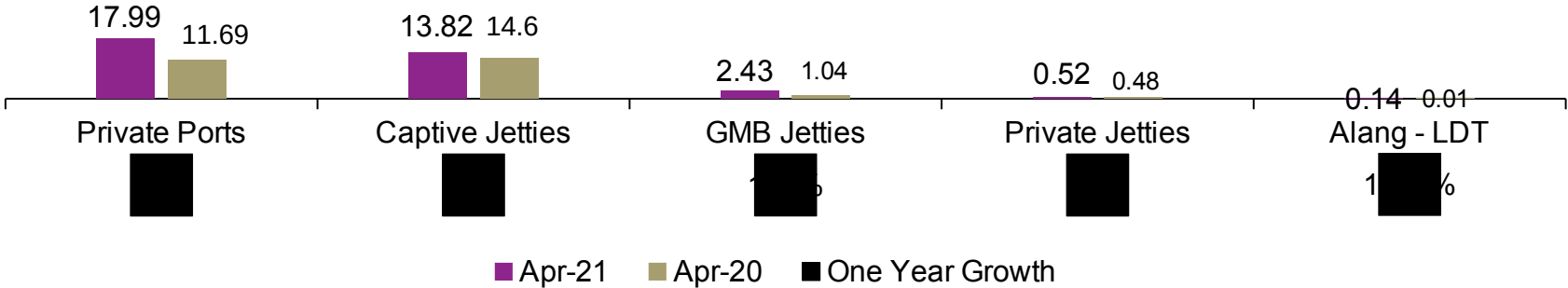

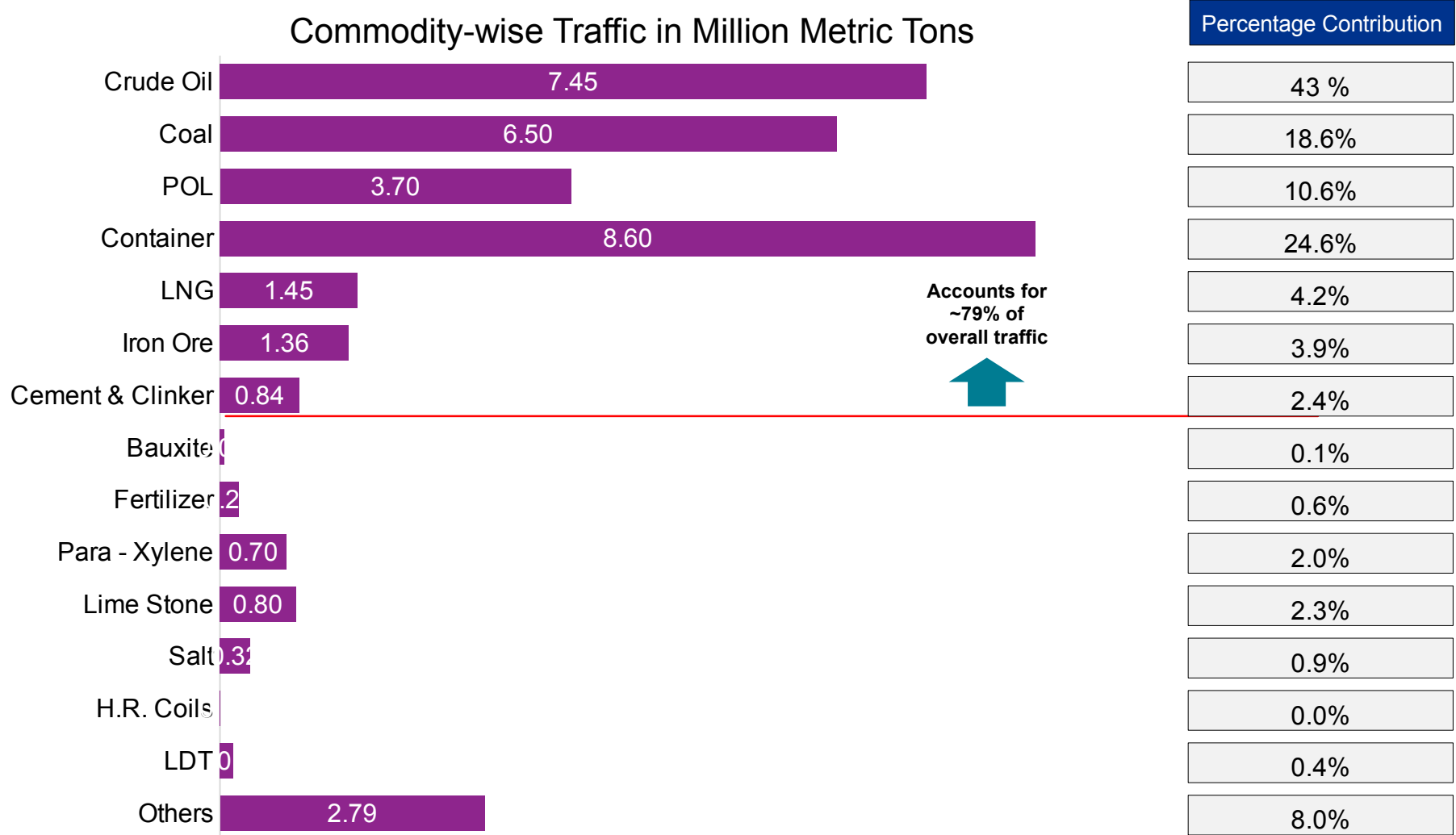
The traffic for the month of April-21 saw a increase of 37.04% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

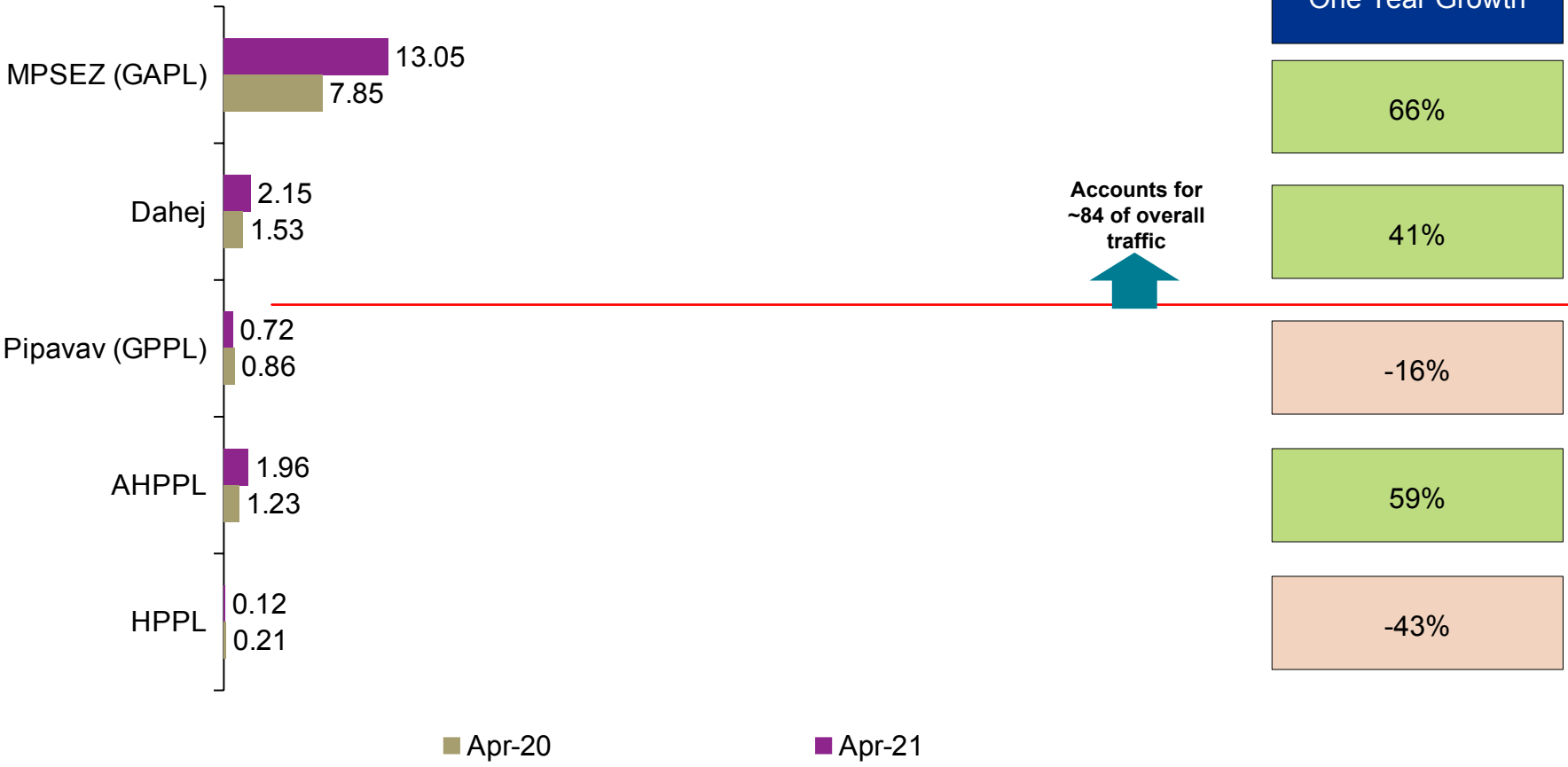

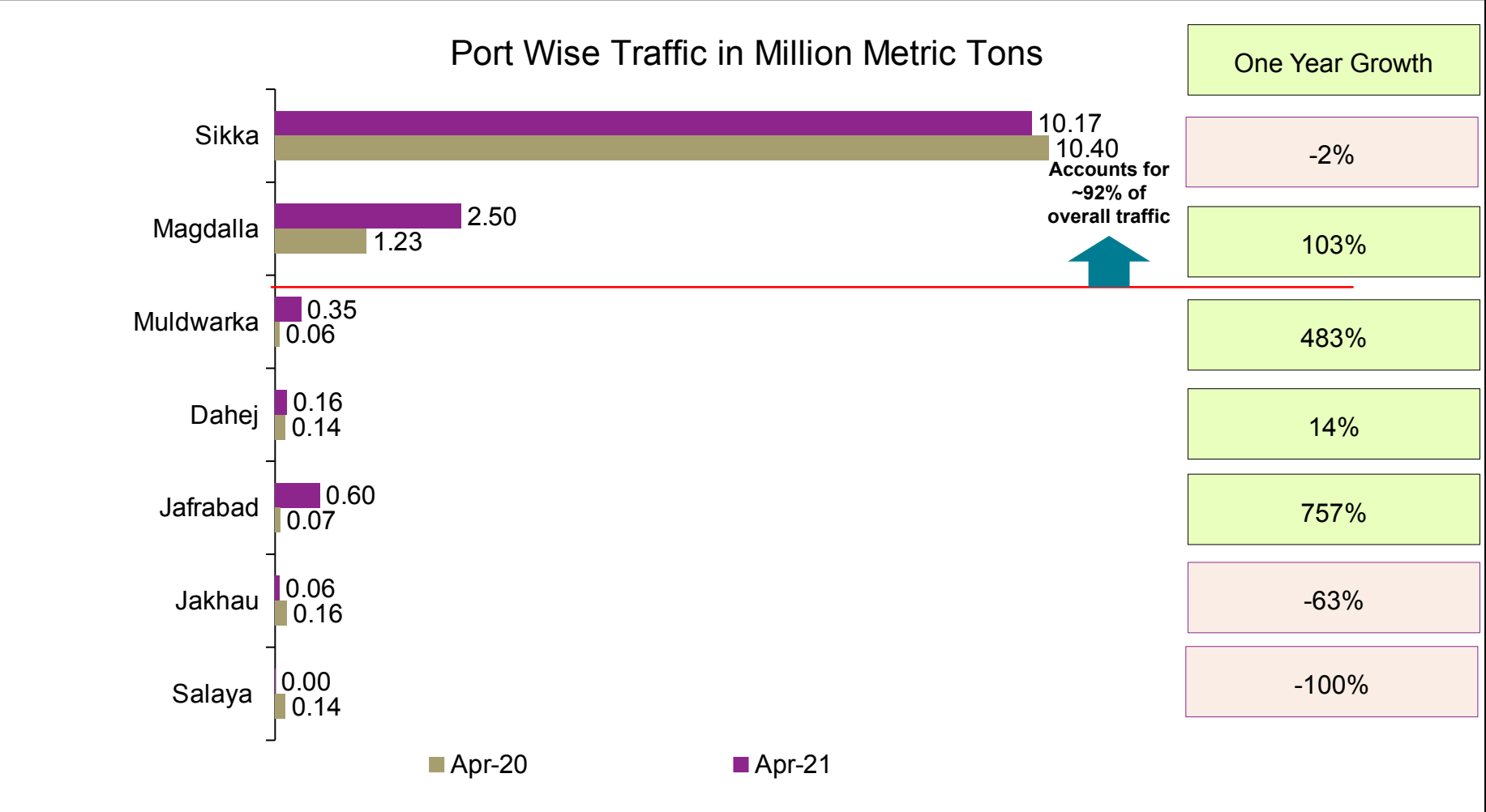
**Private Ports handled 17.99 MMT which accounted for about 51.5% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the month of April of FY 22**

Port Wise Traffic in Million Metric Tons



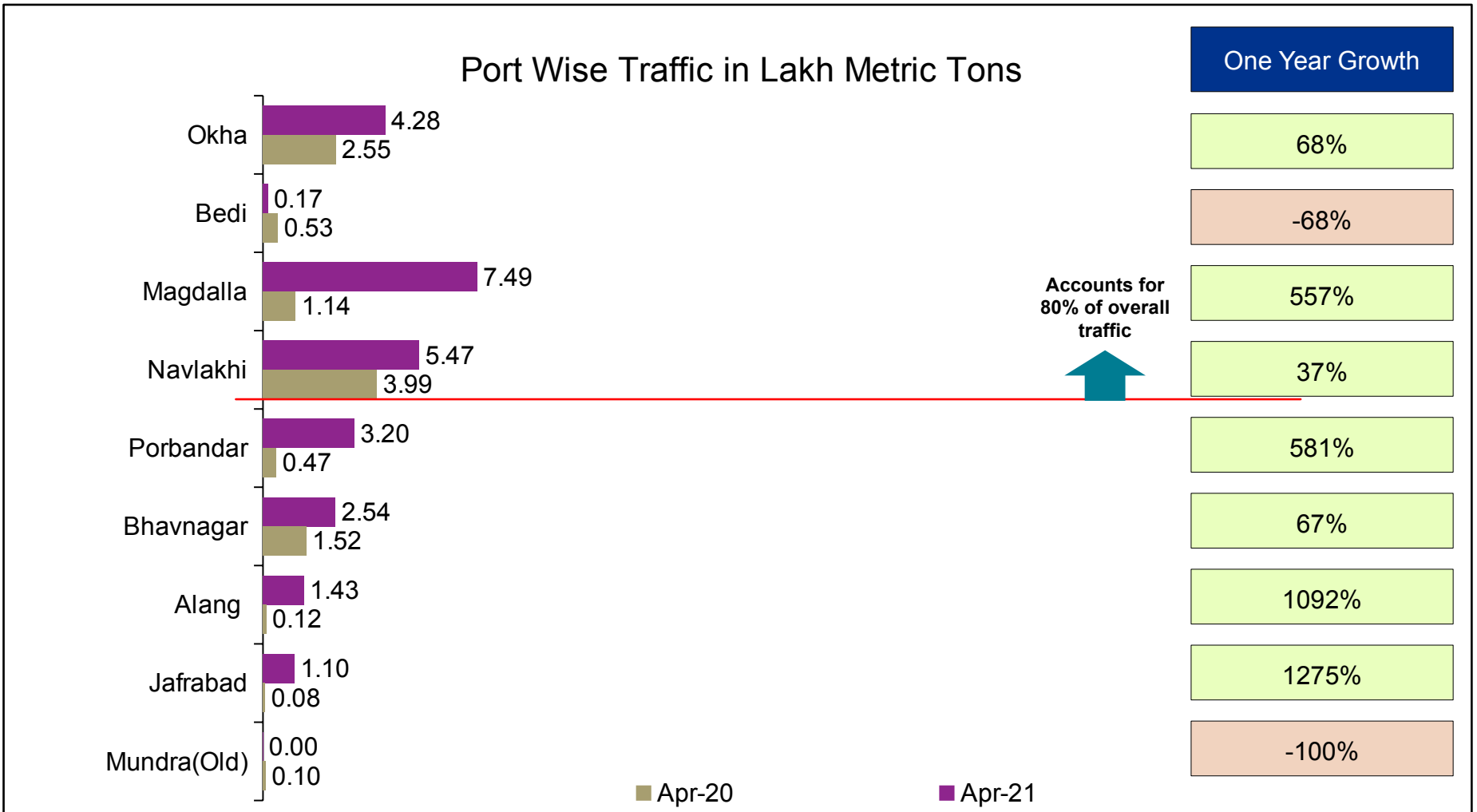
Private Ports handled 11.69 MMT which accounted for about 45.89% of the total traffic during the same period in 2020-21  
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 53.87% in FY 22 compared to the same period in FY 21

**Captive Jetties handled 13.82 MMT which accounted for about 39.5% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in in the month of April of FY 22**



Captive Jetties handled 12.2 MMT which accounted for about 48.4 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2020-21  
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 12.85 % in FY 22 compared to the same period in FY 21

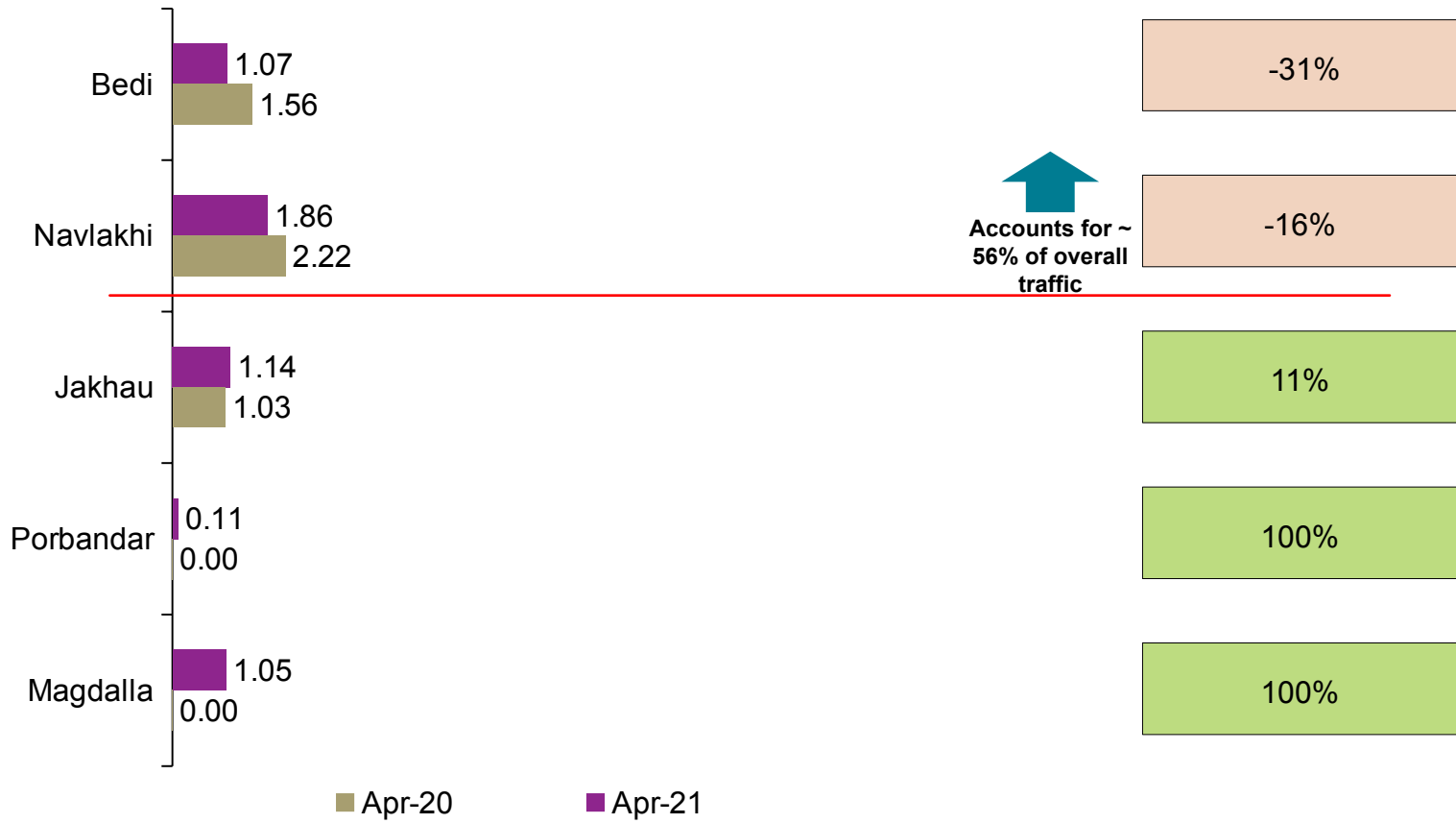
# GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 2.57 MMT which accounted for about 7.3% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in the month of April of FY 22



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 1.05 MMT tons which accounted for about 4.13% of the total traffic during the same period in 2020-21. The cargo handled showed a growth of 144.57% in FY 22 compared to the same period in FY21

**Private Jetties handled 0.52MMT which accounted for about 1.48% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports of Gujarat for the month of April of FY 22**
