



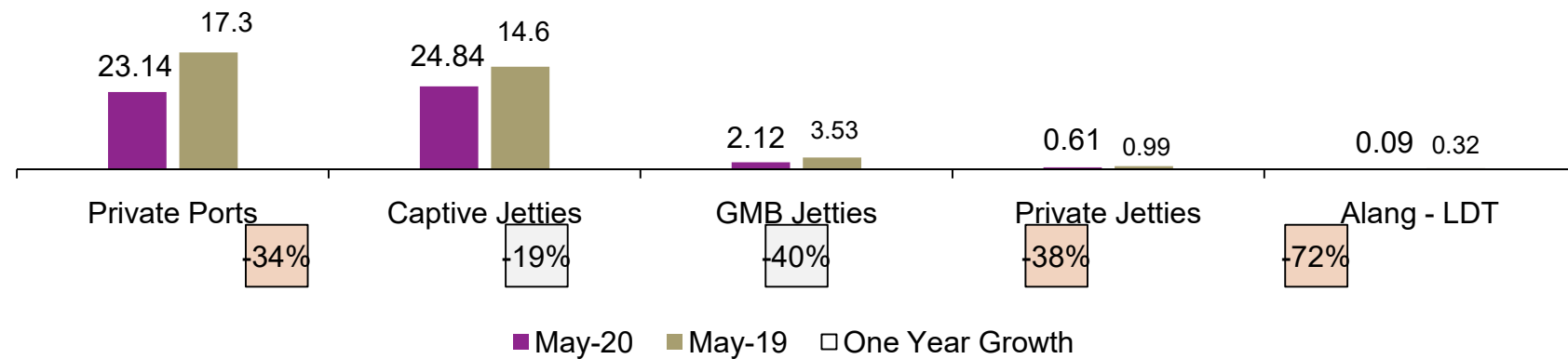

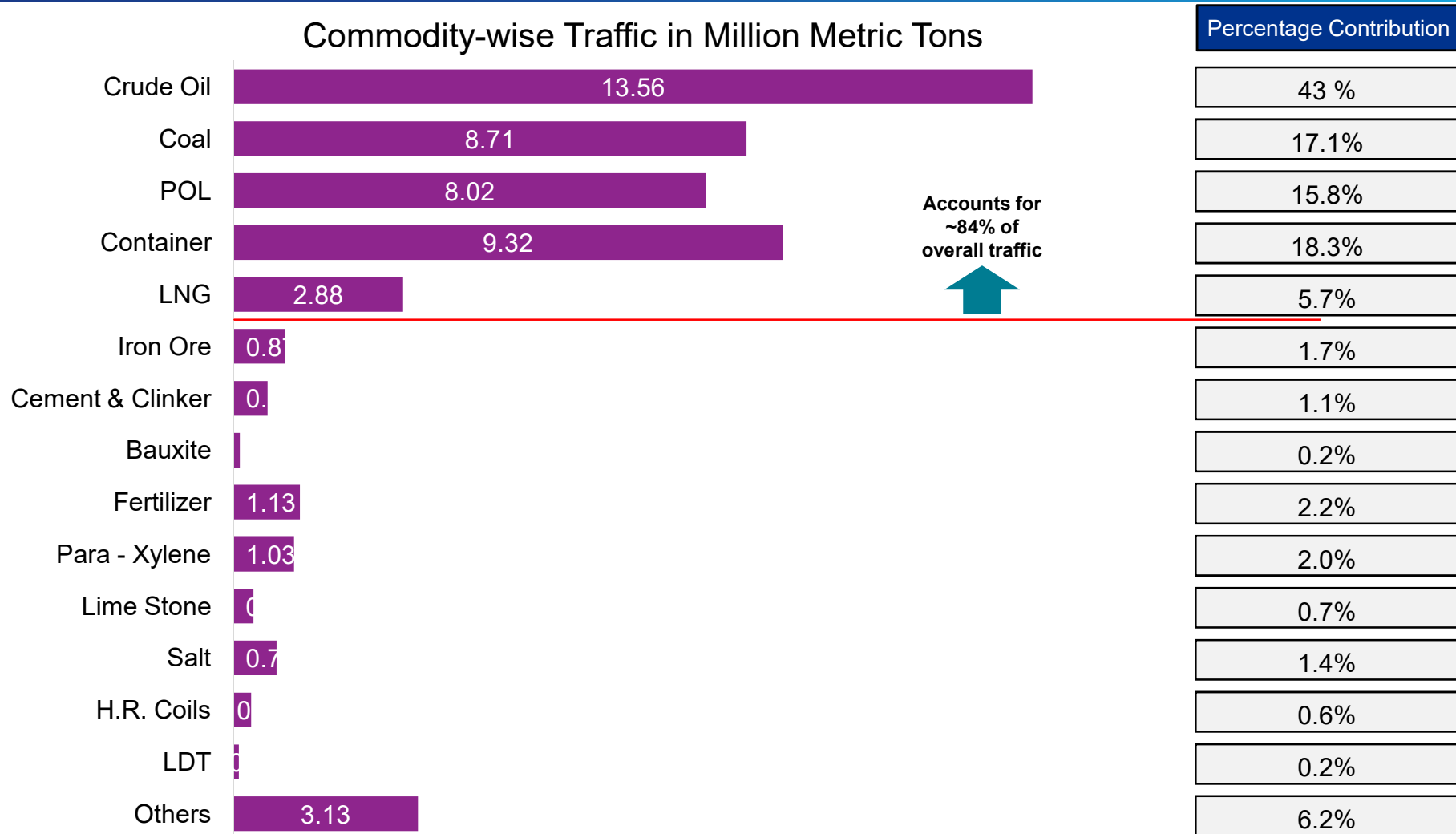
The traffic till the month of May-20 saw a decline of 28.01% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

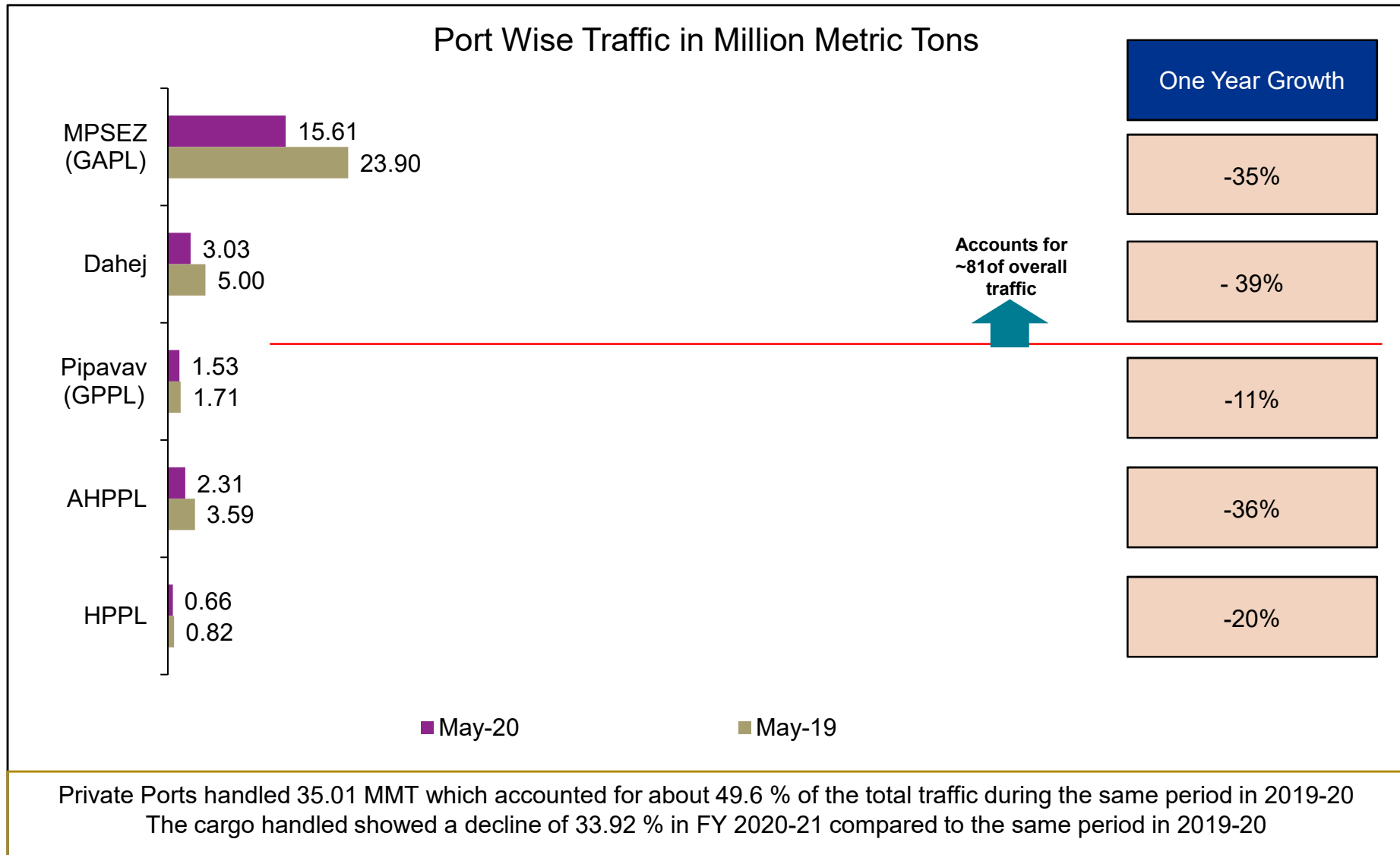

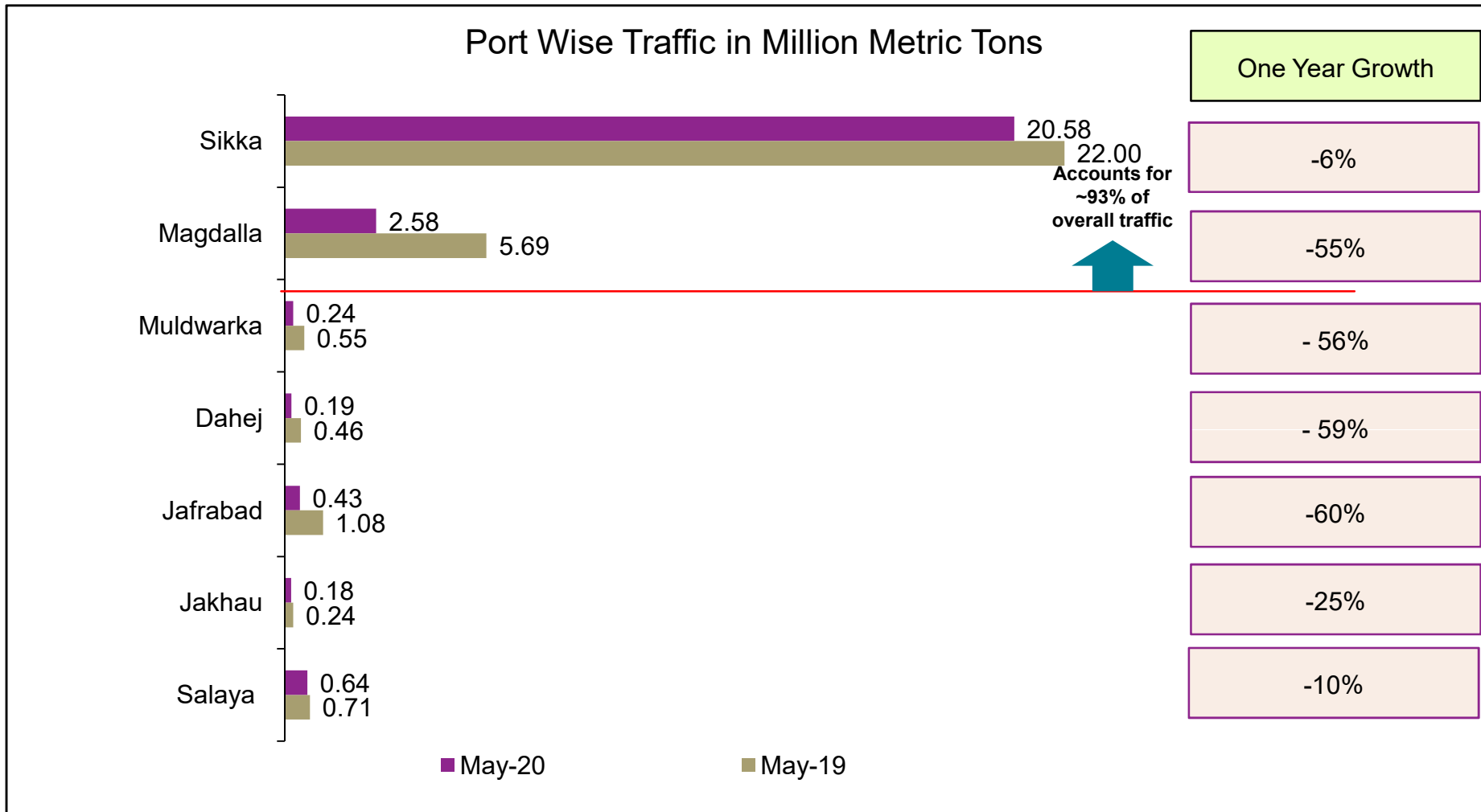

**Private Ports handled 23.14 MMT which accounted for about 45.5% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat till the month of May of FY 21**

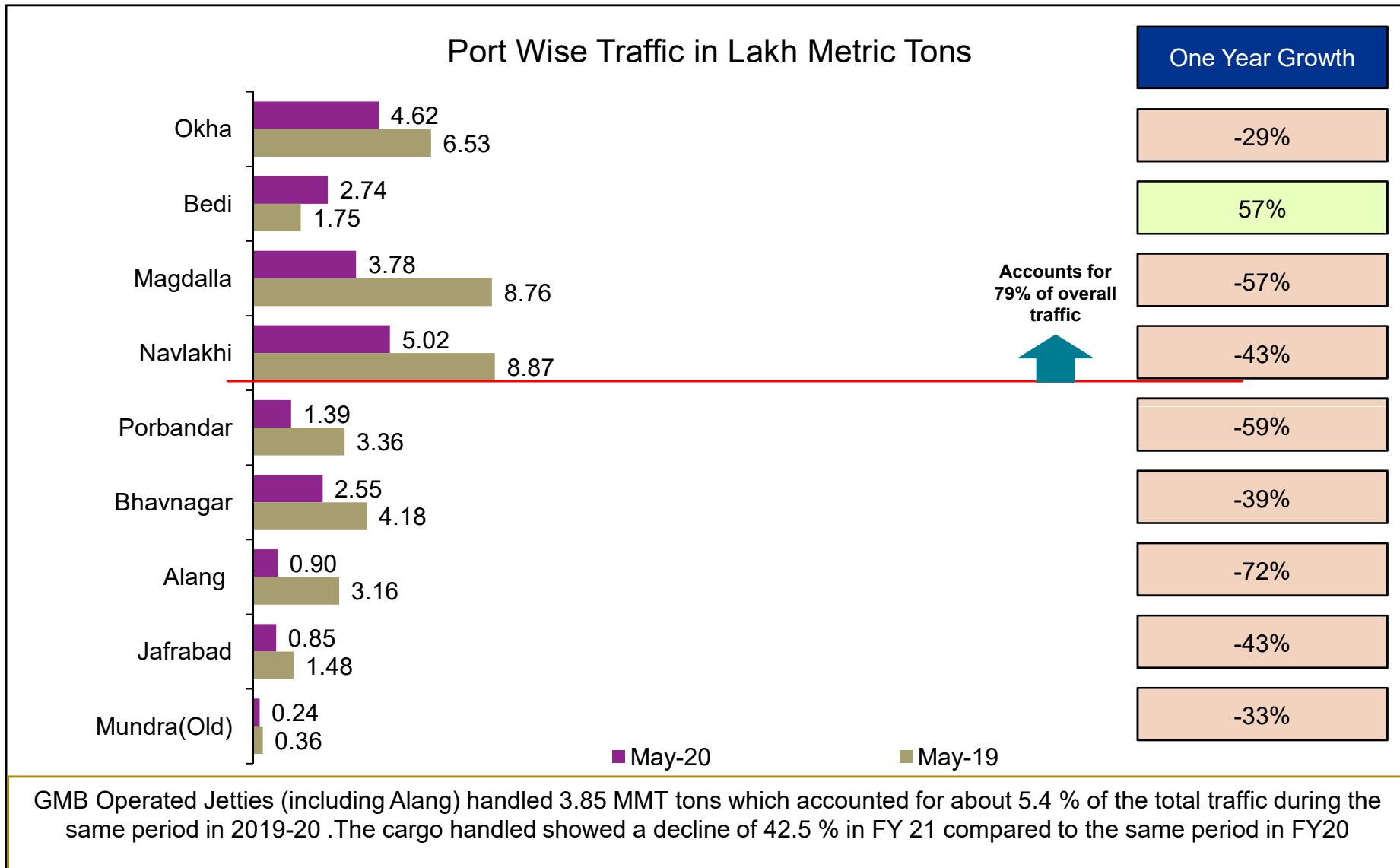


**Captive Jetties handled 24.84 MMT which accounted for about 48.8% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat till the month of May of FY 21**



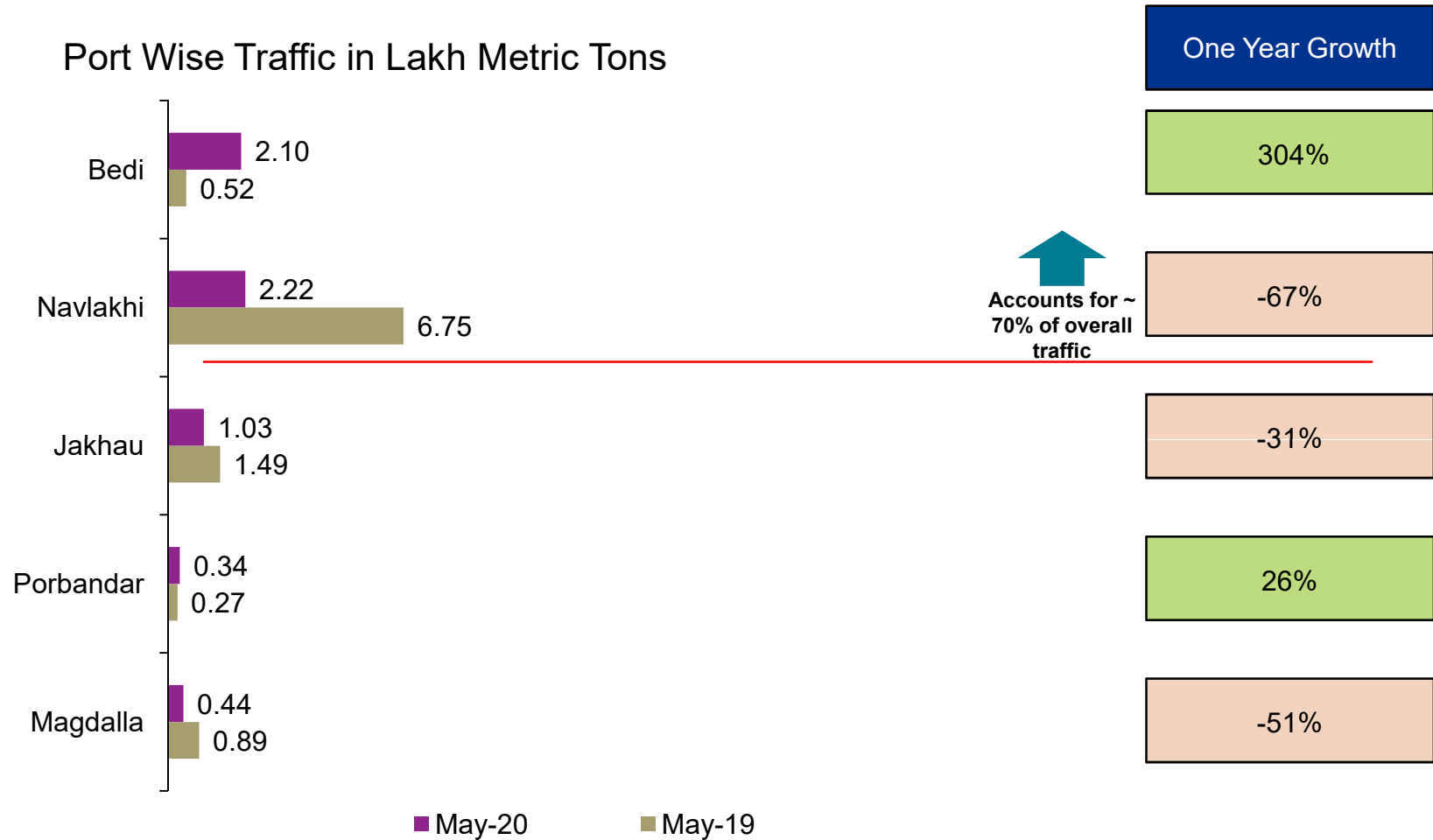
Captive Jetties handled 30.72 MMT which accounted for about 43.5 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2019-20  
 The cargo handled showed a decline of 19.14 % in FY 2020-21 compared to the same period in 2019-20

**GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 2.21 MMT which accounted for about 4.3 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat till the month of May of FY 21**



**Private Jetties handled 0.61 MMT which accounted for about 1.2% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports of Gujarat till the month of May of FY 21**
