

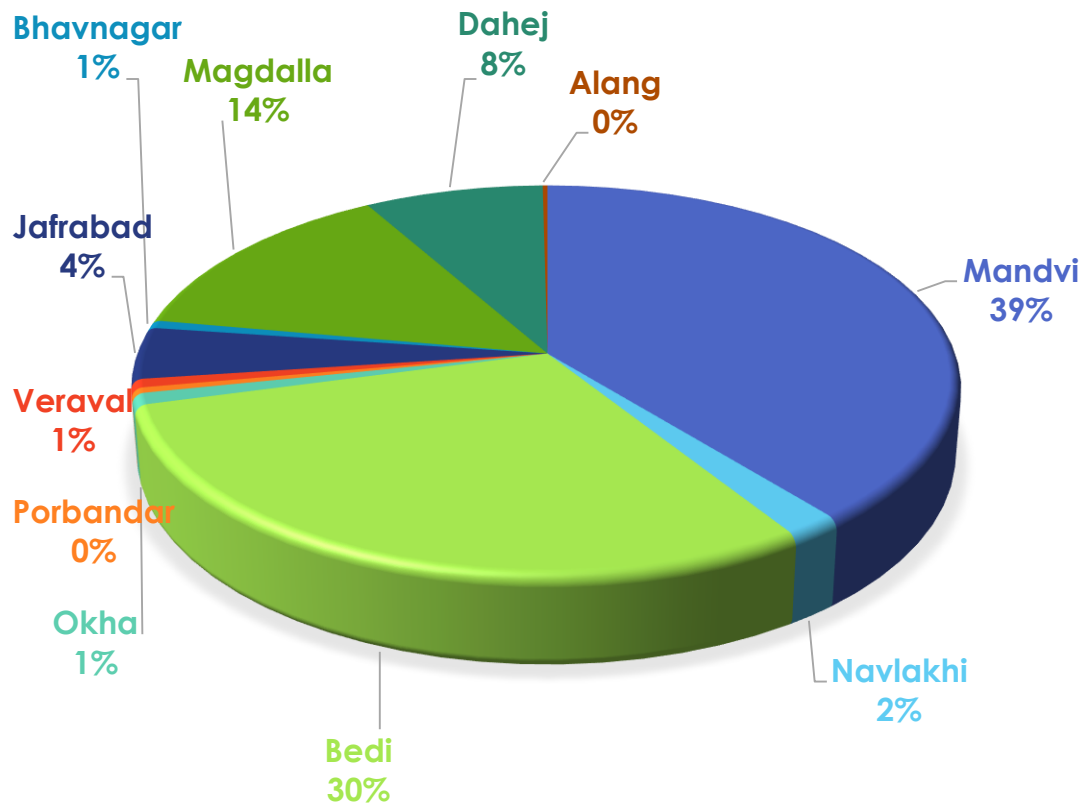

GMB Group of Ports - Cargo Share in 2023-24



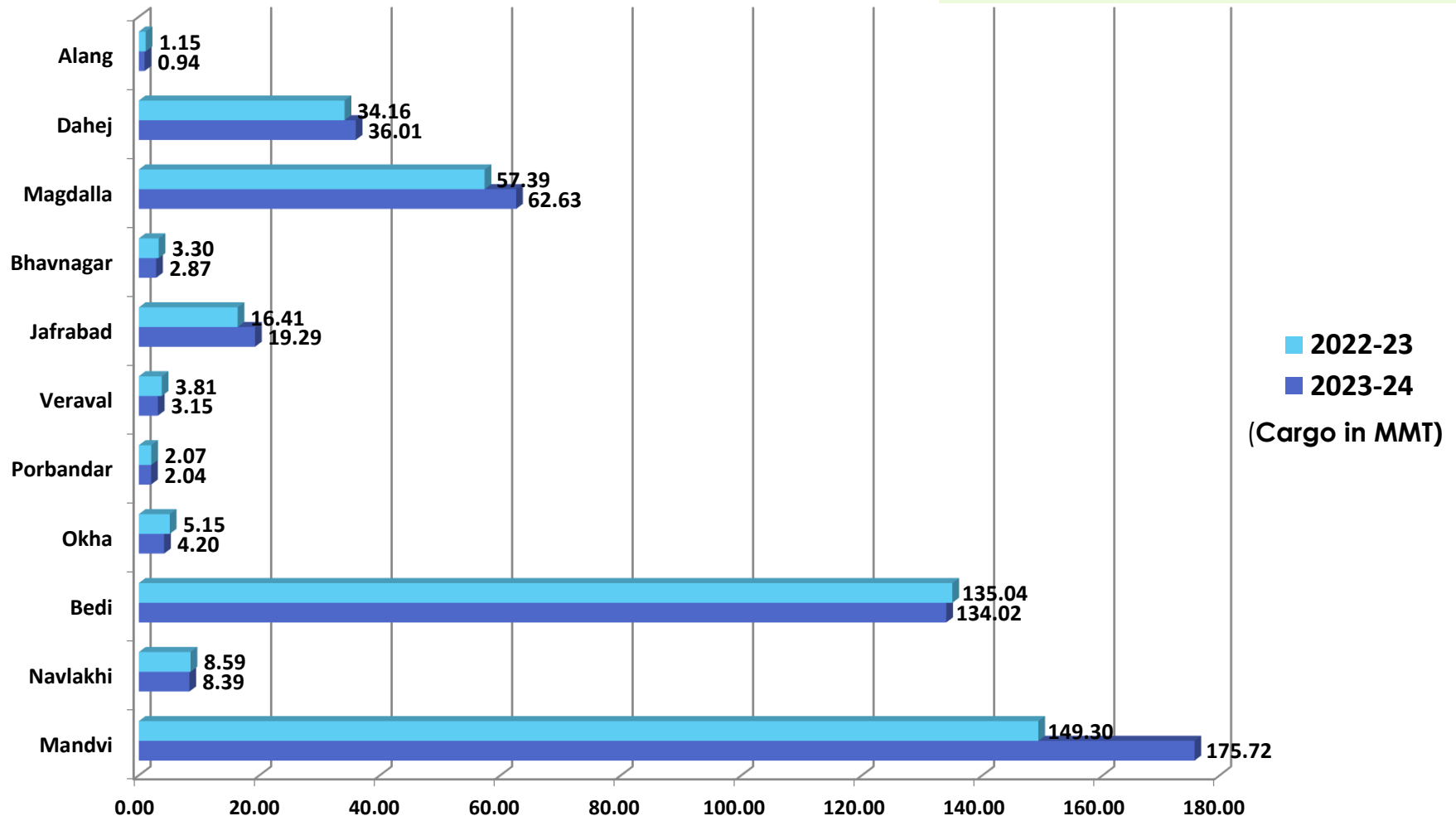

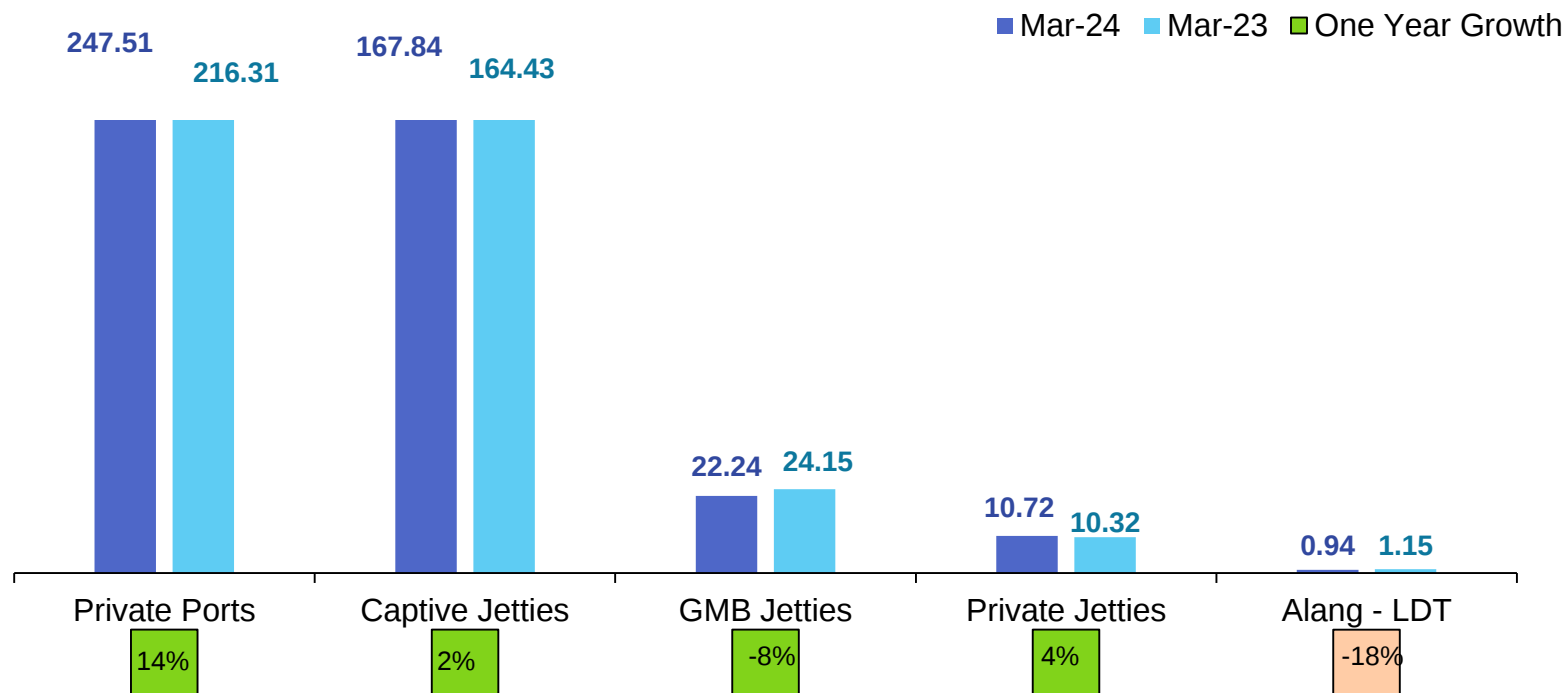
Cargo handled in 2022-23 – 416.36 MMT

Cargo handled in 2023-24 – 449.26 MMT



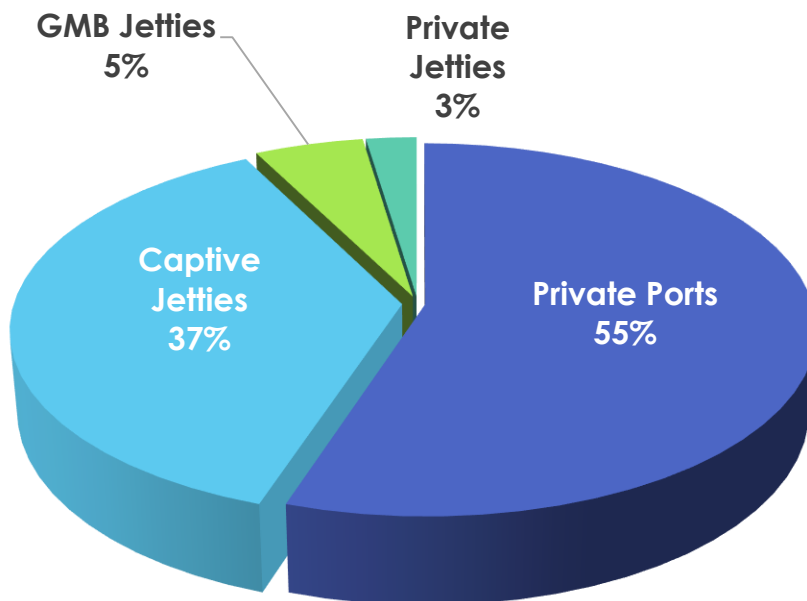
The traffic for the month of March - 24 saw a Increase of 7.90% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

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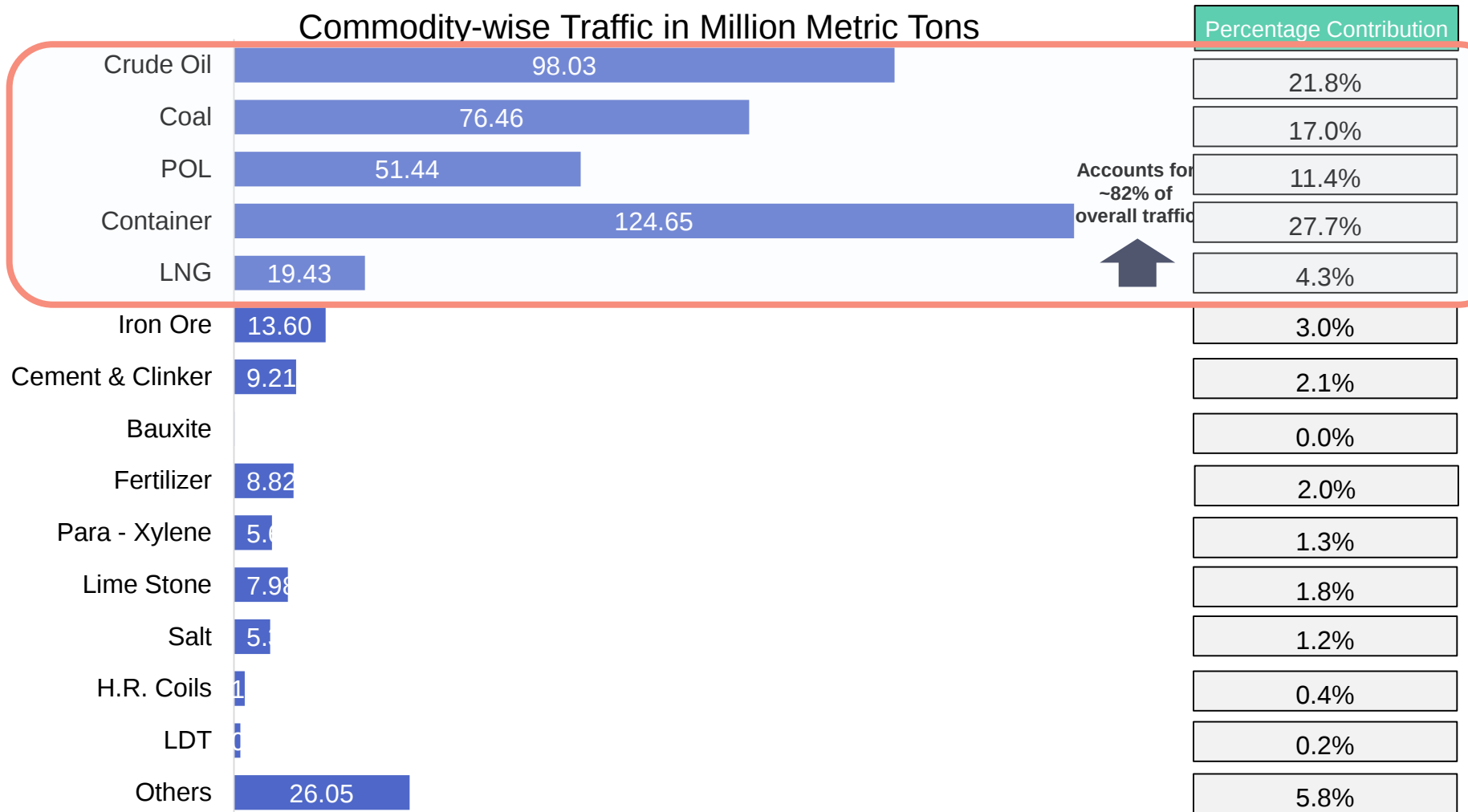
Facility wise Traffic for the Year 2023-24

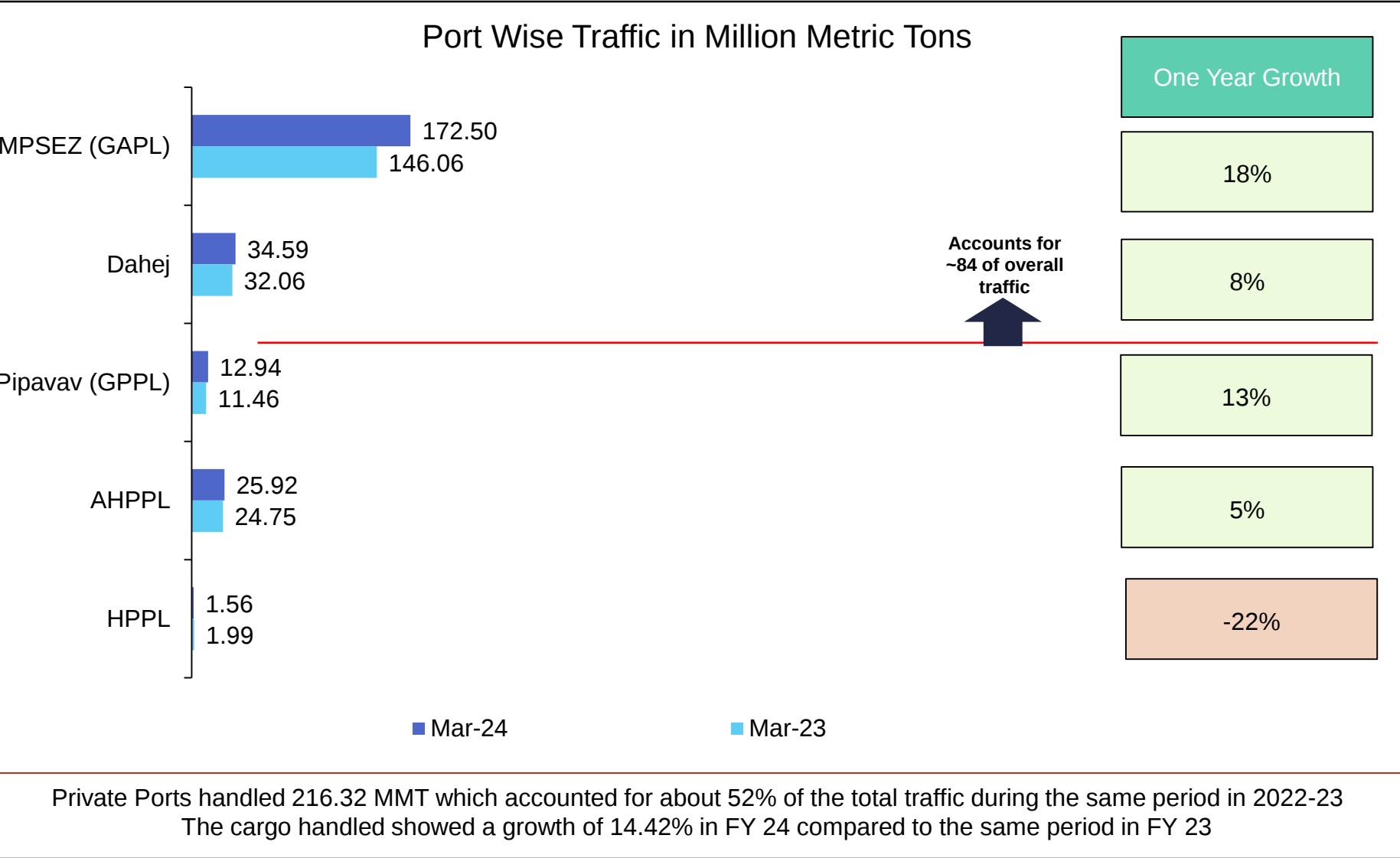
Commodity mix for the traffic handled in month of March-24

Commodity-wise Traffic in Million Metric Tons

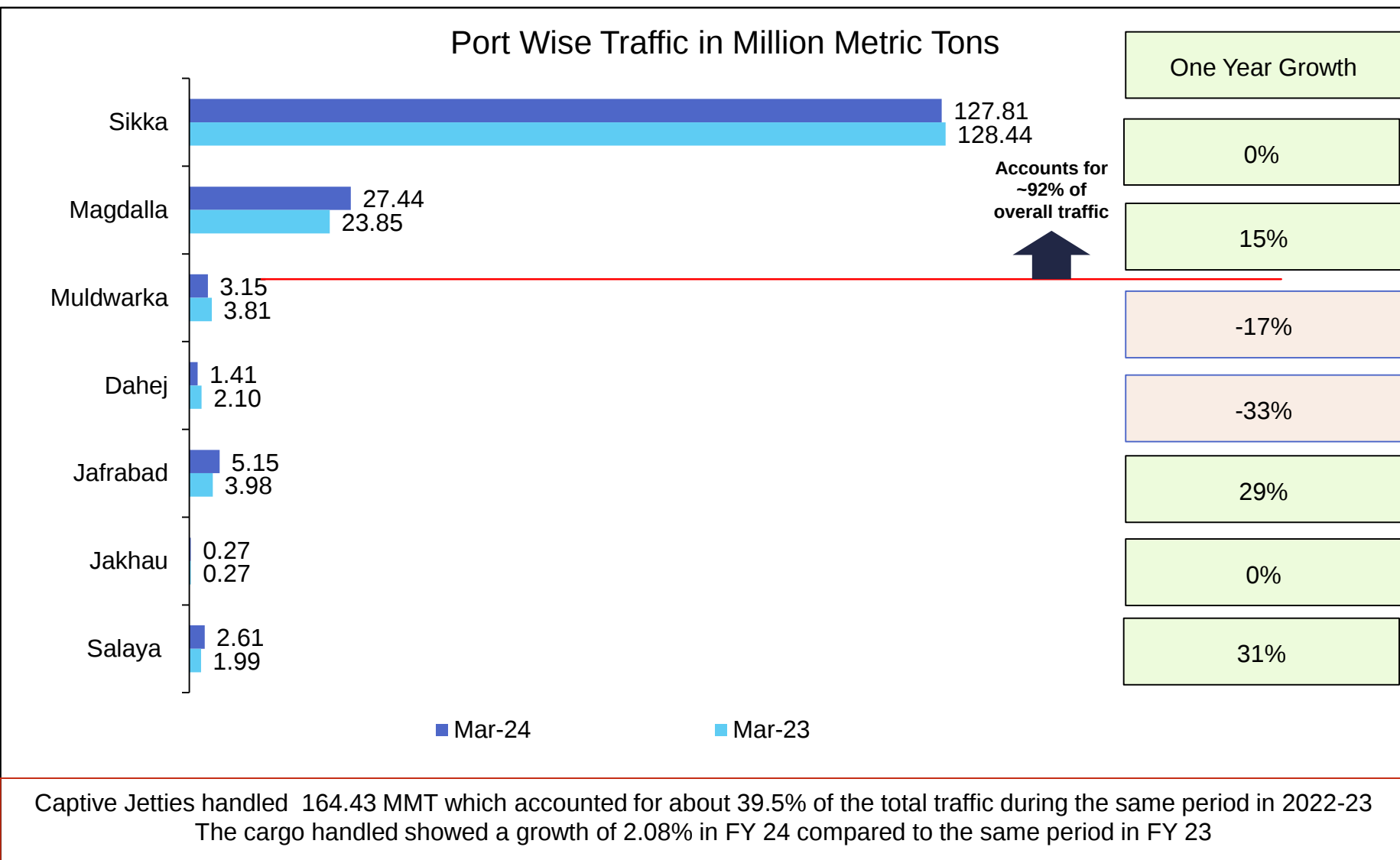


Crude Oil, Coal, POL, Containers and LNG were the major commodities handled at GMB Group of ports. Major cargo handling port are Sikka, Mundra, Pipavav, Dahej and Hazira.

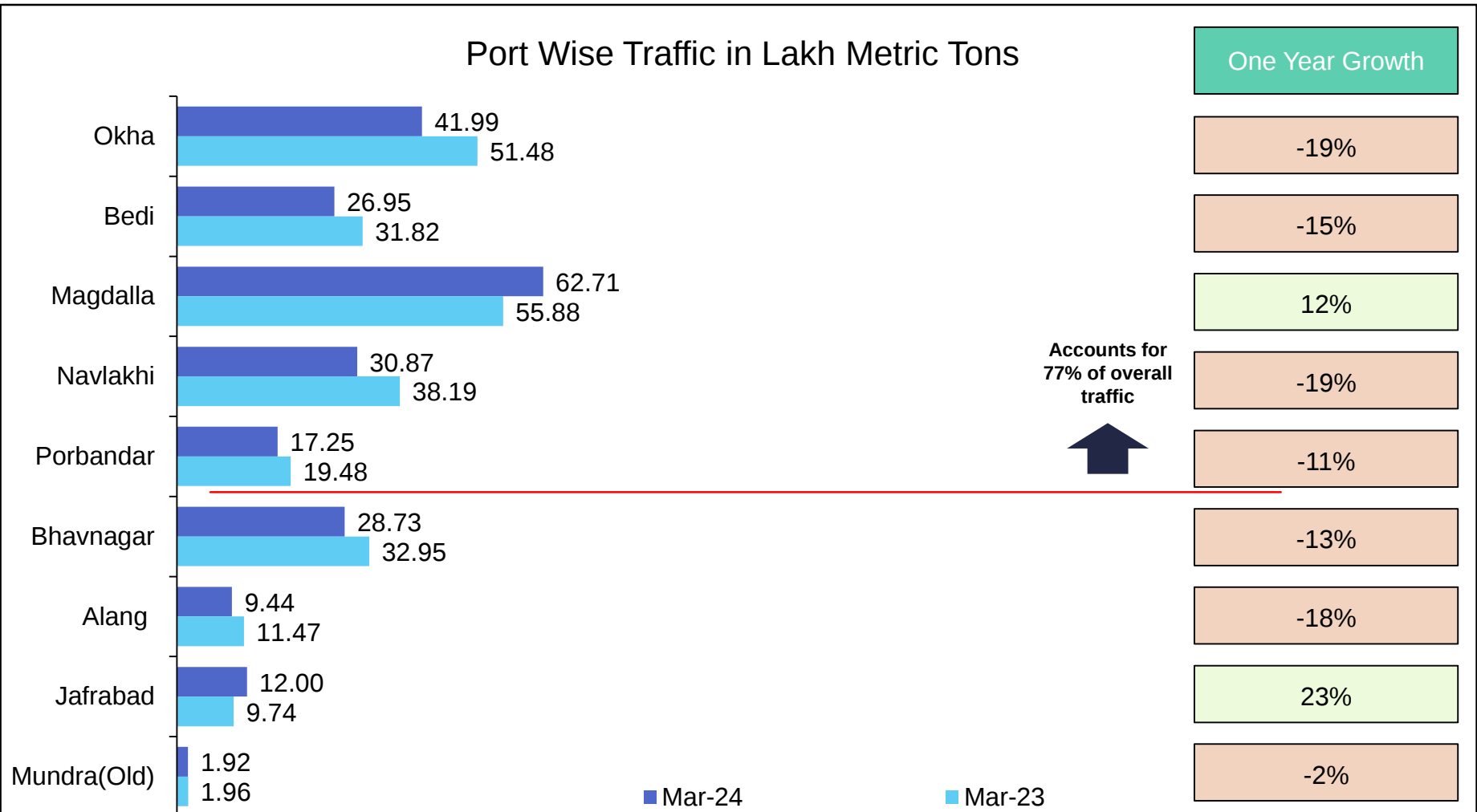
Private Ports handled 247.51 MMT which accounted for about 55% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the month of March of FY 24



Captive Jetties handled 167.84 MMT which accounted for about 37.4% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in in the month of March of FY 24



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 23.19 MMT which accounted for about 5.16% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in the month of March of FY 24



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 25.30 MMT tons which accounted for about 6.08% of the total traffic during the same period in 2022-23. The cargo handled showed a decline of 8.34% in FY 24 compared to the same period in FY23

Private Jetties handled 10.72 MMT which accounted for about 2.4% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports of Gujarat for the month of March of FY 24
