

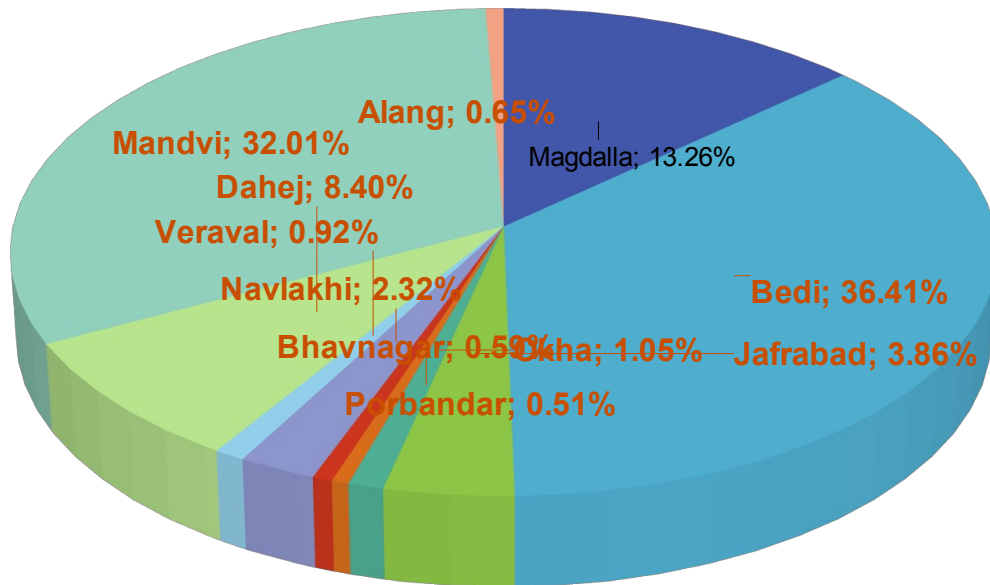

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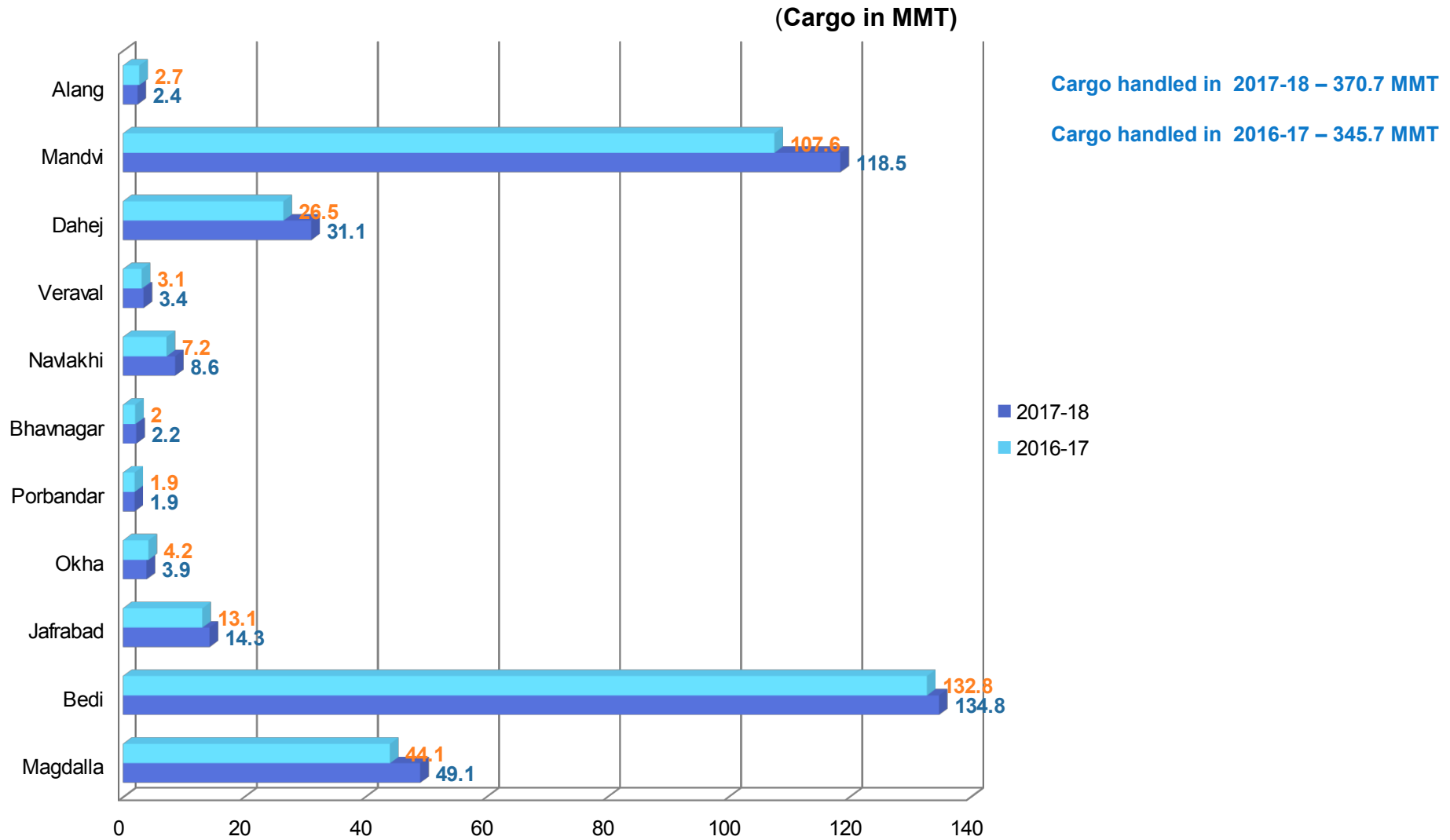
Cargo share in total cargo of all GMB Group of Ports

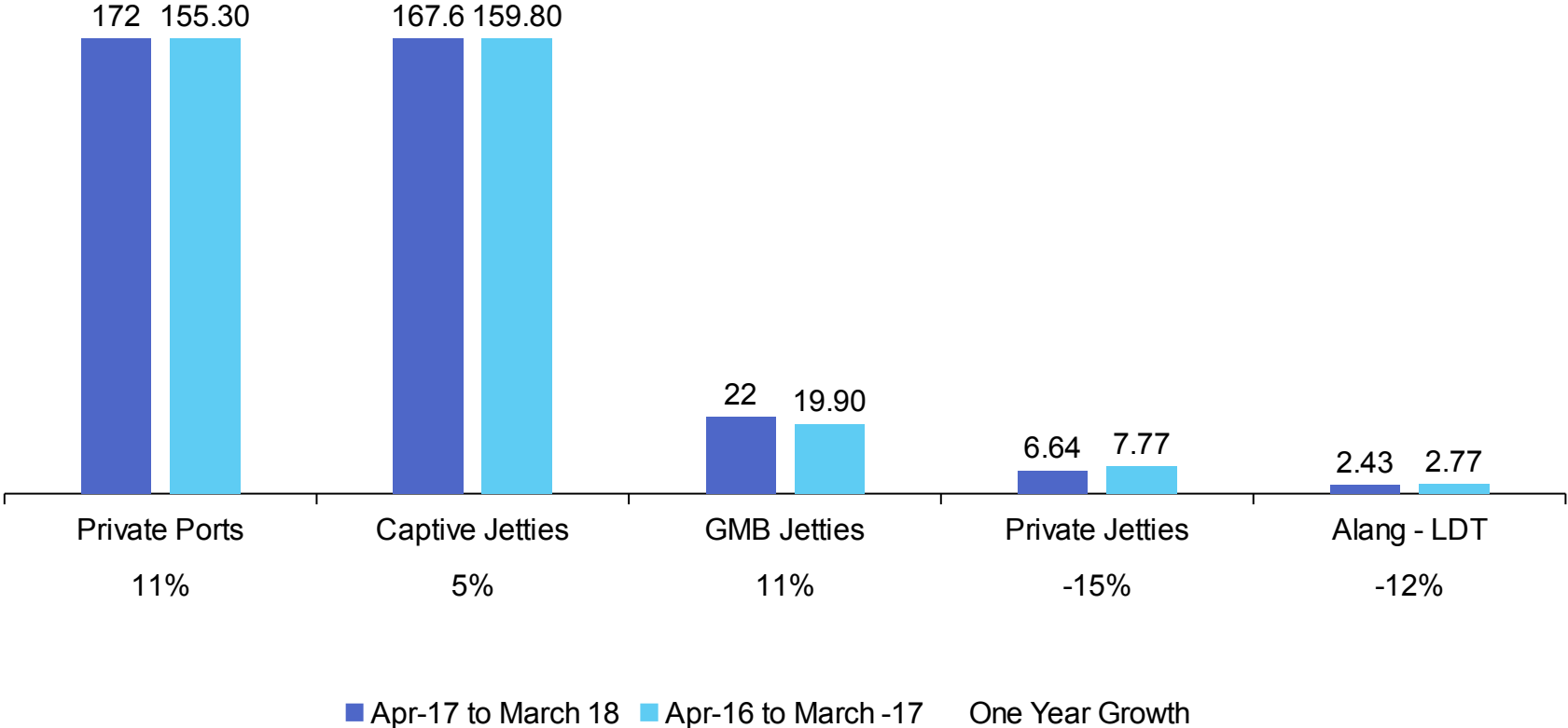

Cargo comparison of all GMB Group of Ports – (2016-17 Vs 2017-18)



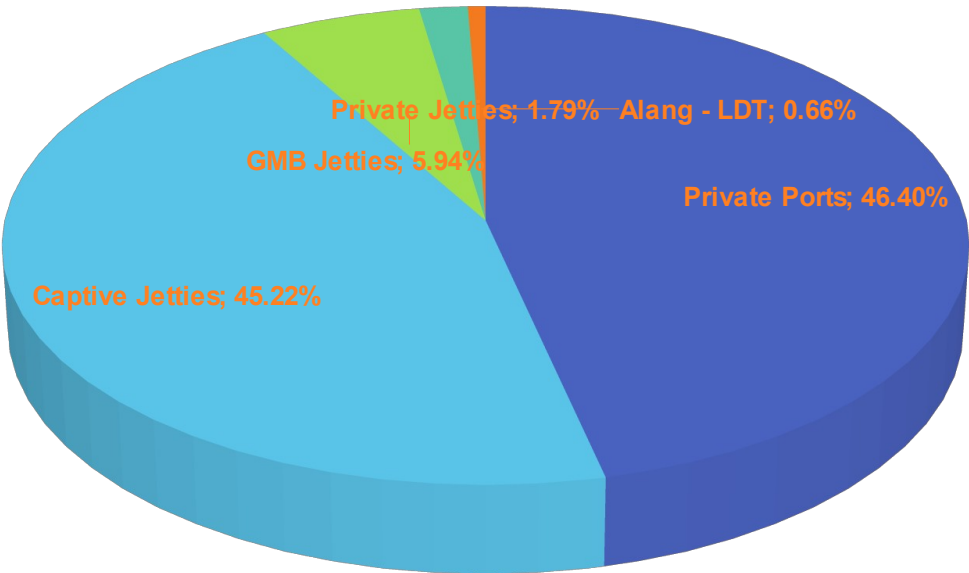
The traffic for the Year 2017-18 saw an increase of 7.24 % compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

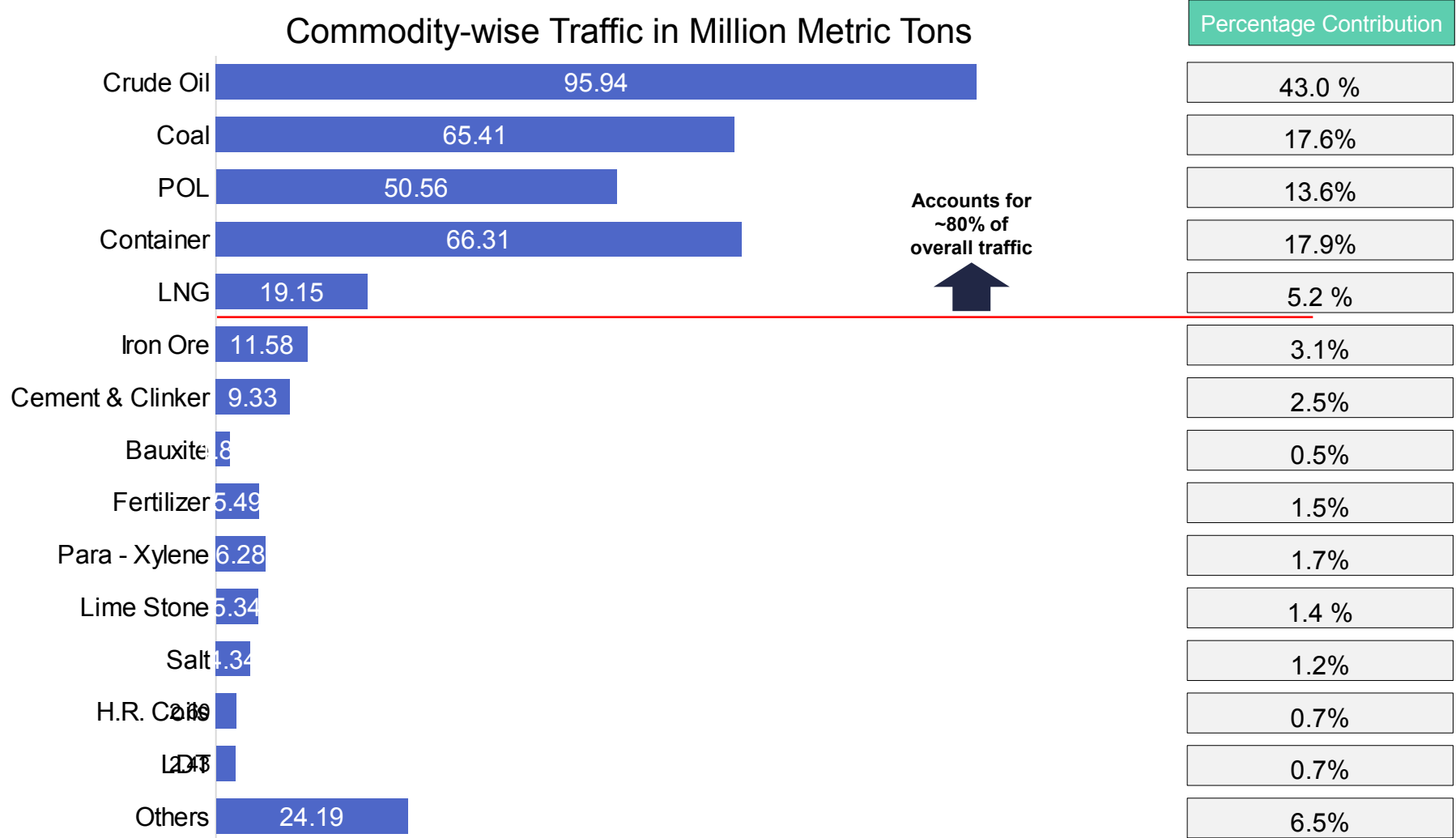
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Facility wise Traffic for the Year 2017-18

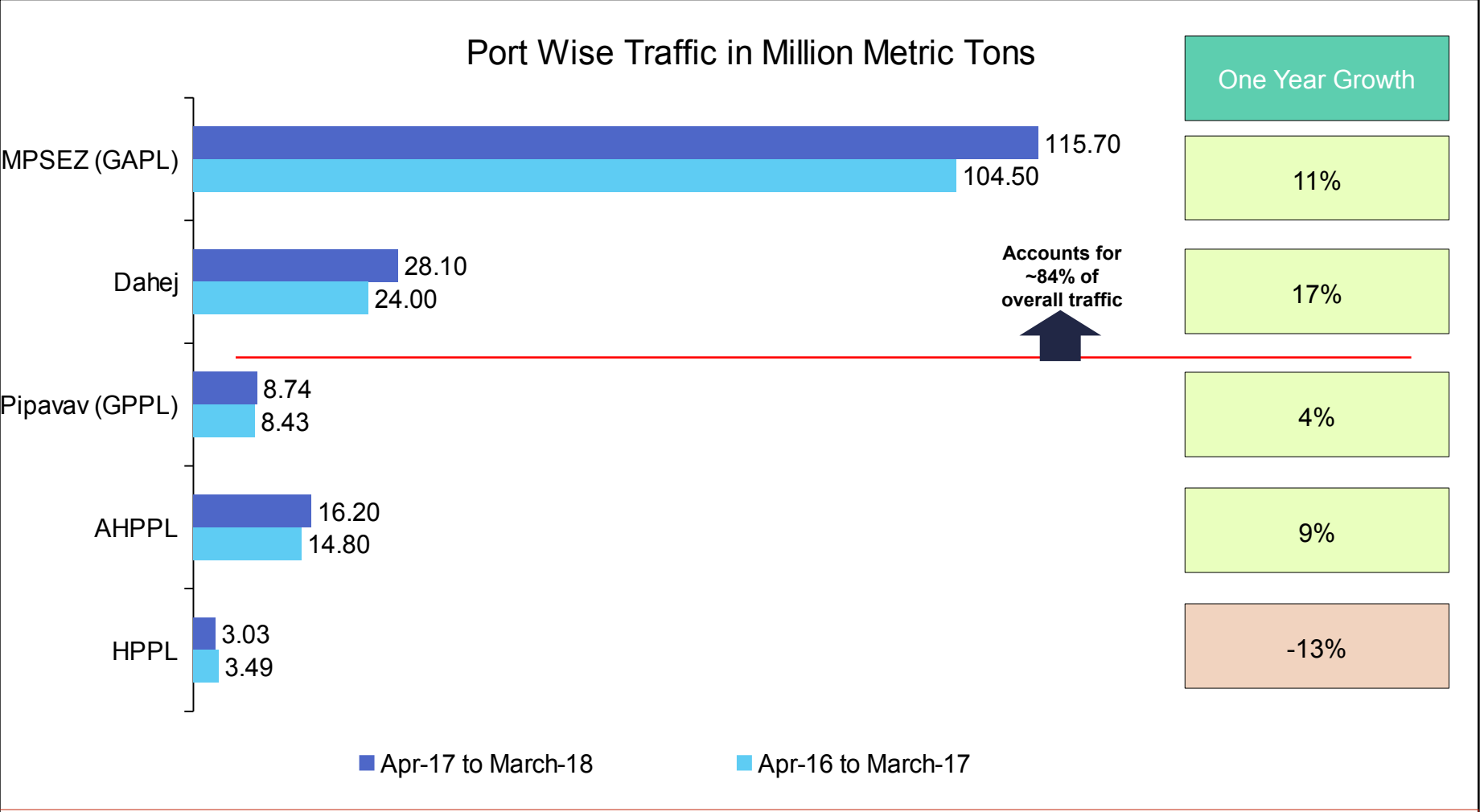
Commodity mix for the traffic handled during the Year 2017-18



■ Apr-17 to March 18

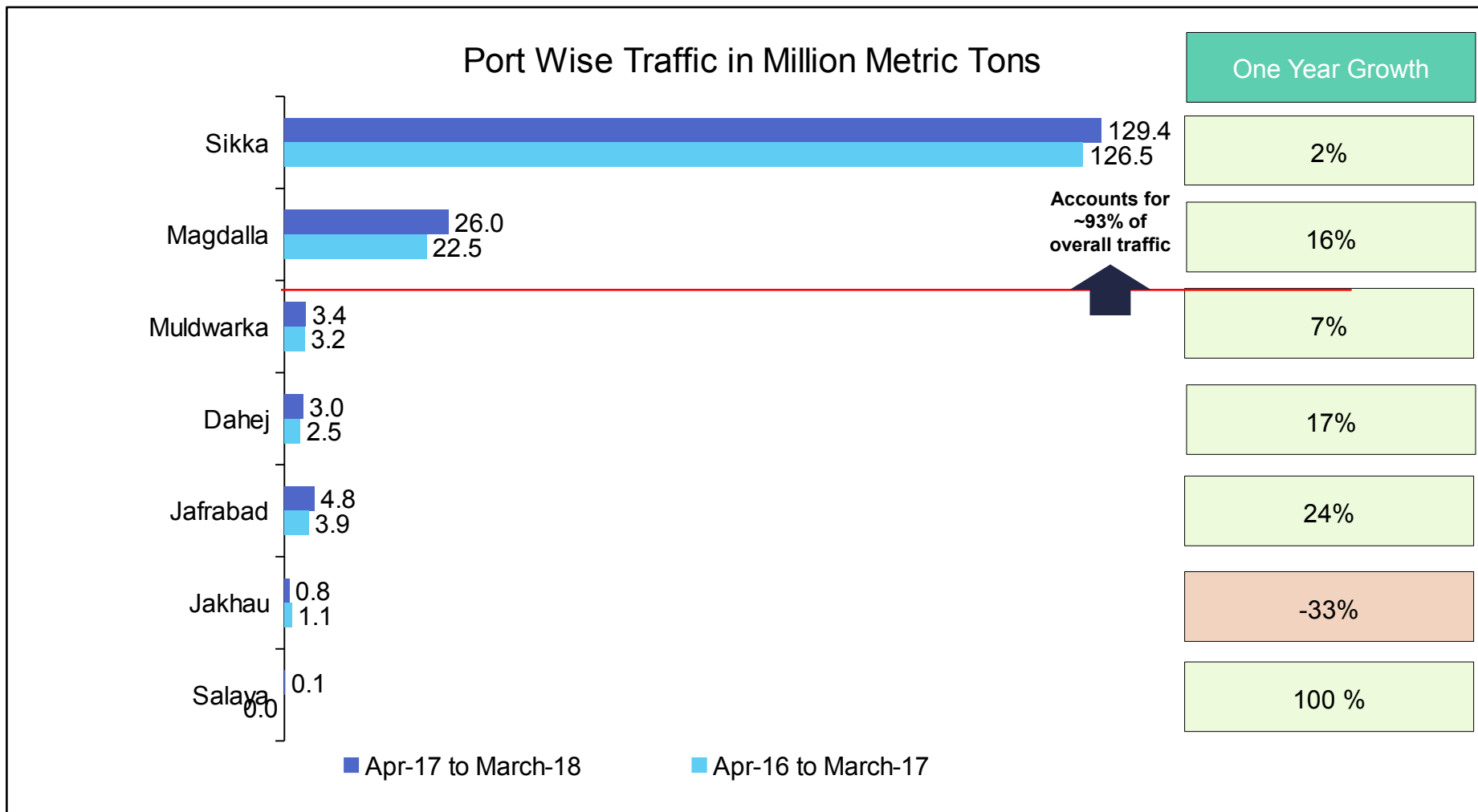
Crude Oil, Coal, POL, Containers and LNG were the major commodities handled at GMB Group of ports. Major cargo handling port are Sikka, Mundra, Pipavav, Dahej and Hazira.

Private Ports handled 172 MMT which accounted for about 46.4% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat during the Year 2017-18



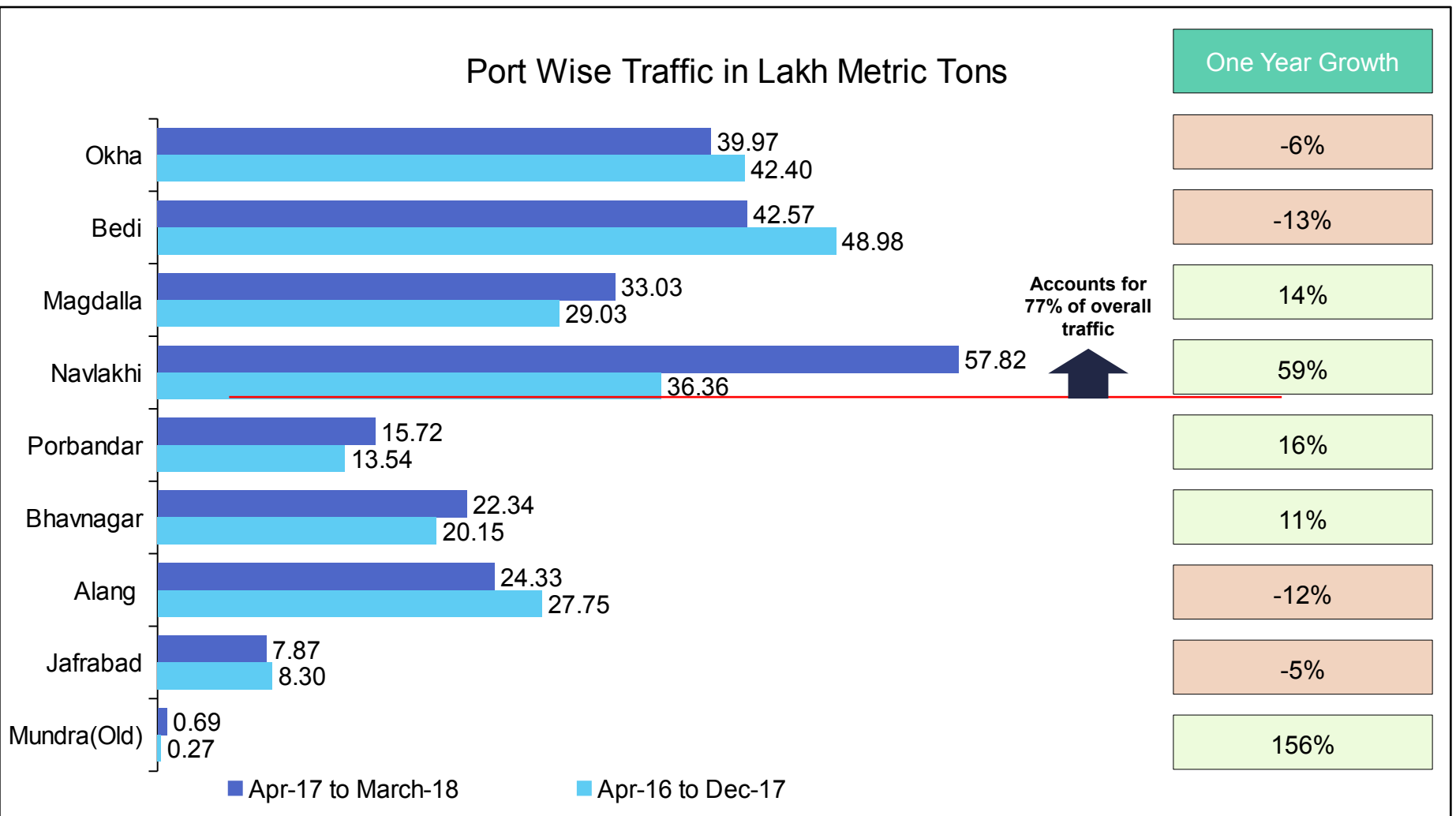
Private Ports handled 155.3 MMT which accounted for about 45 % of the total traffic during the year 2016-17
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 10.70 % in FY 2017-18 compared to the year 2016-17

Captive Jetties handled 167.6 MMT which accounted for about 45.2% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in the Year 2017-18



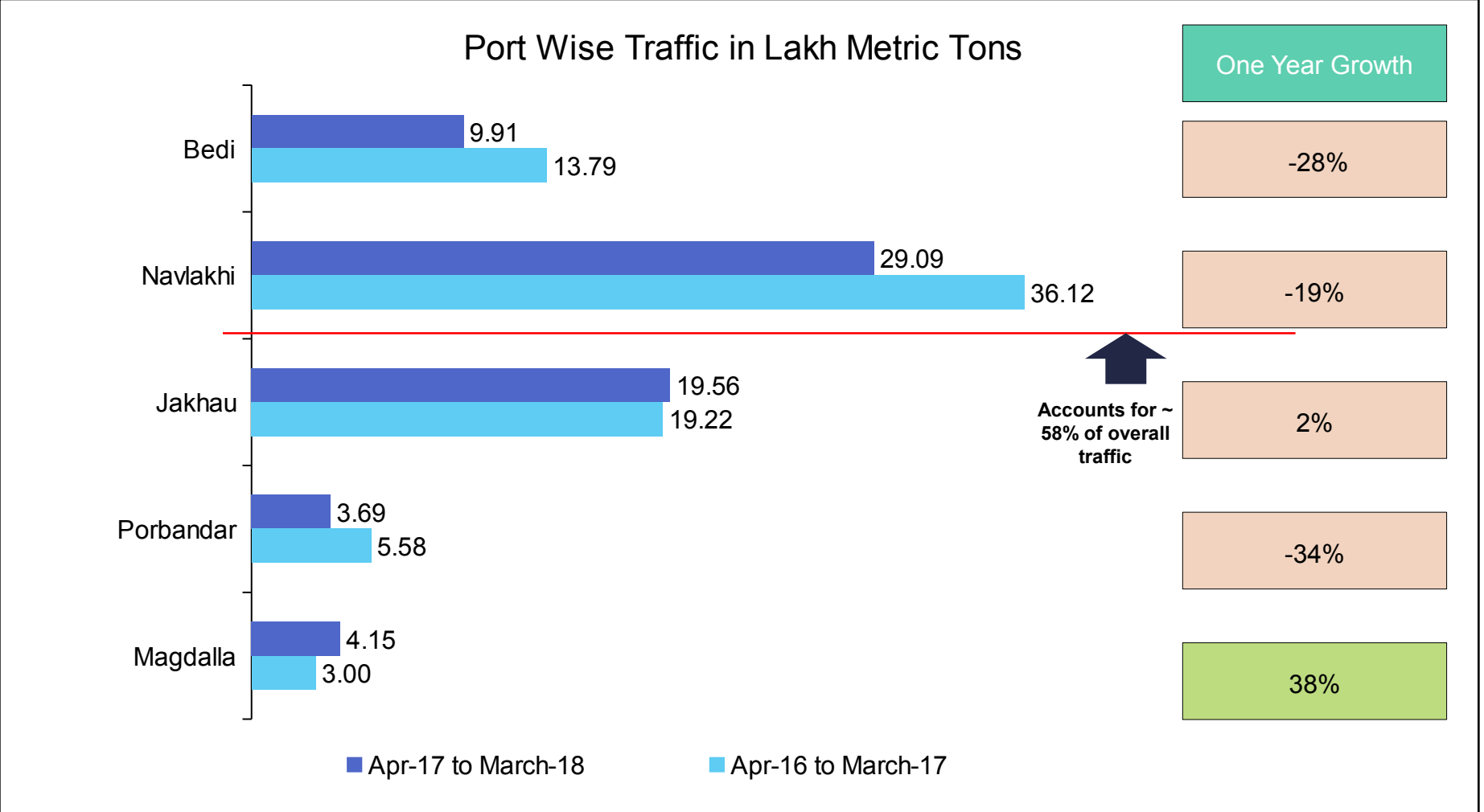
Captive Jetties handled 159.8 MMT which accounted for about 46.2 % of the total traffic for the 2016-17

GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 24.4 MMT which accounted for about 7% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for Year 2017-18
