



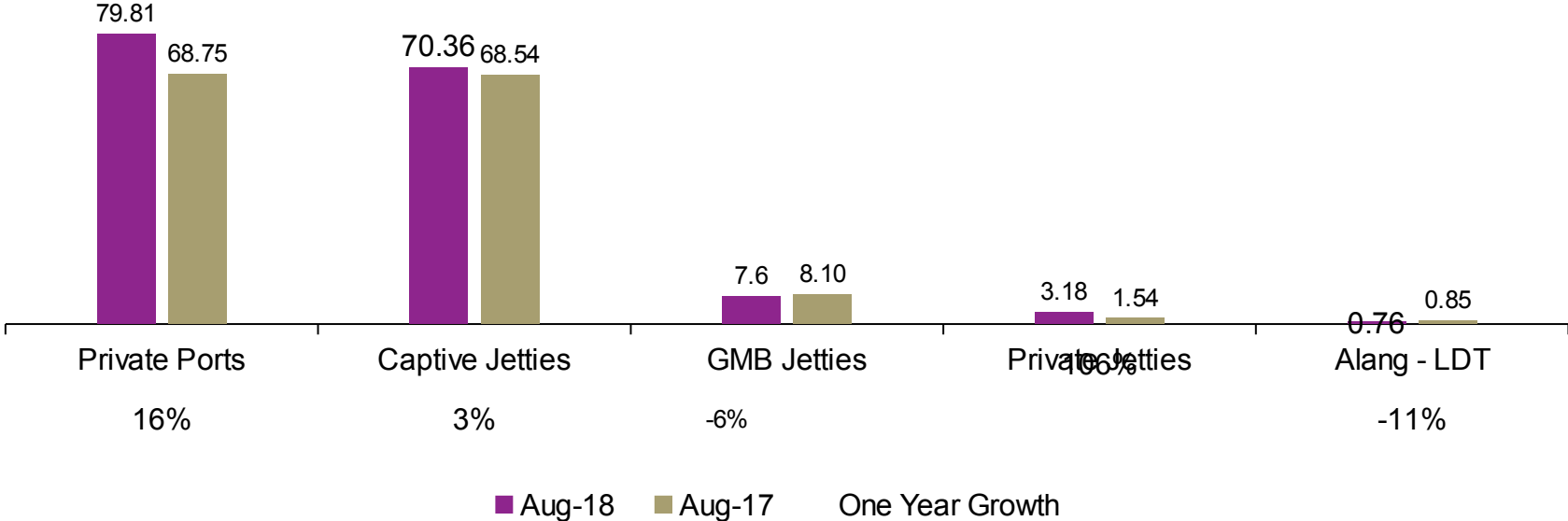

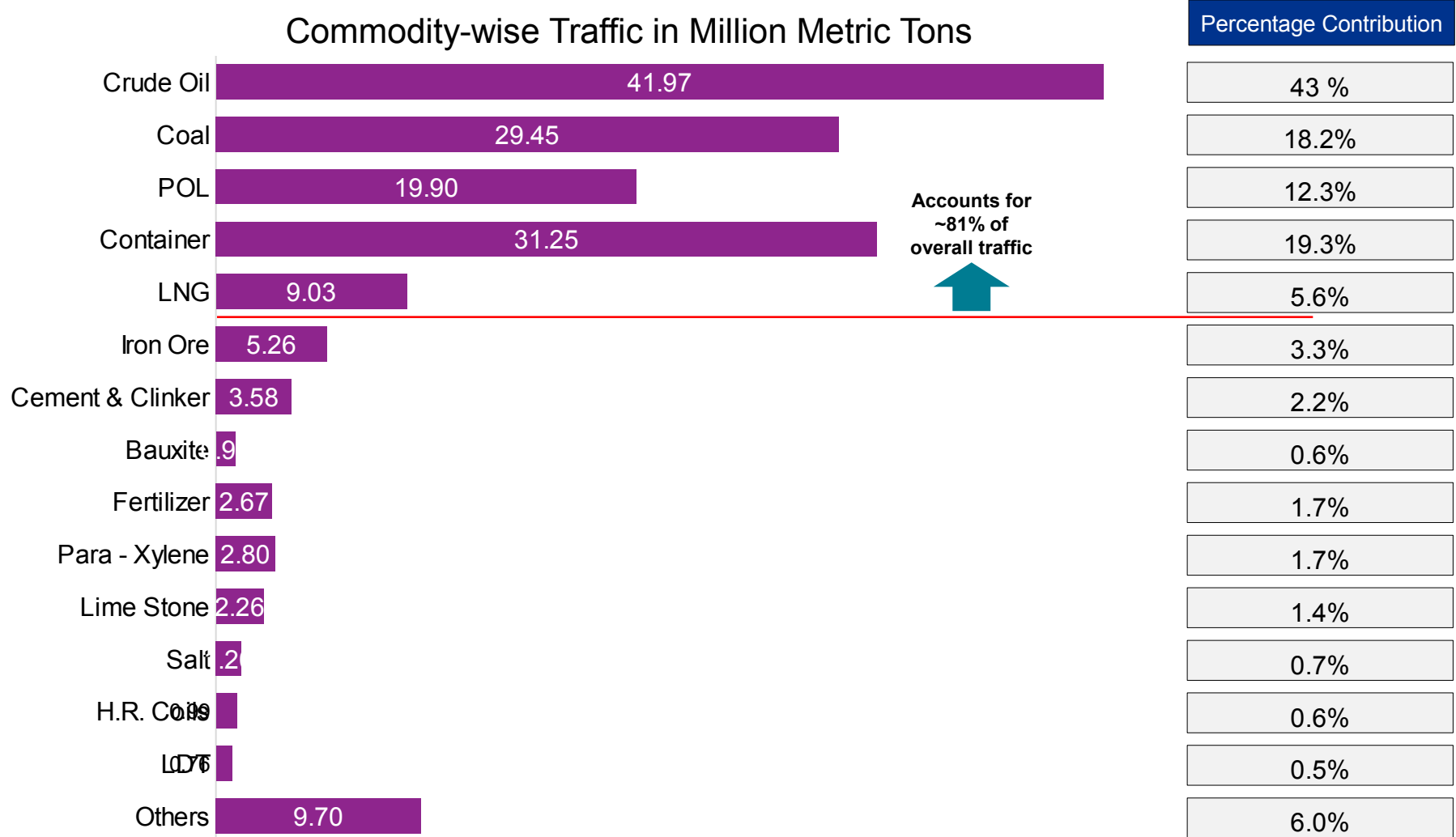
The traffic for the first five months of FY 19 saw an increase of 9.41% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

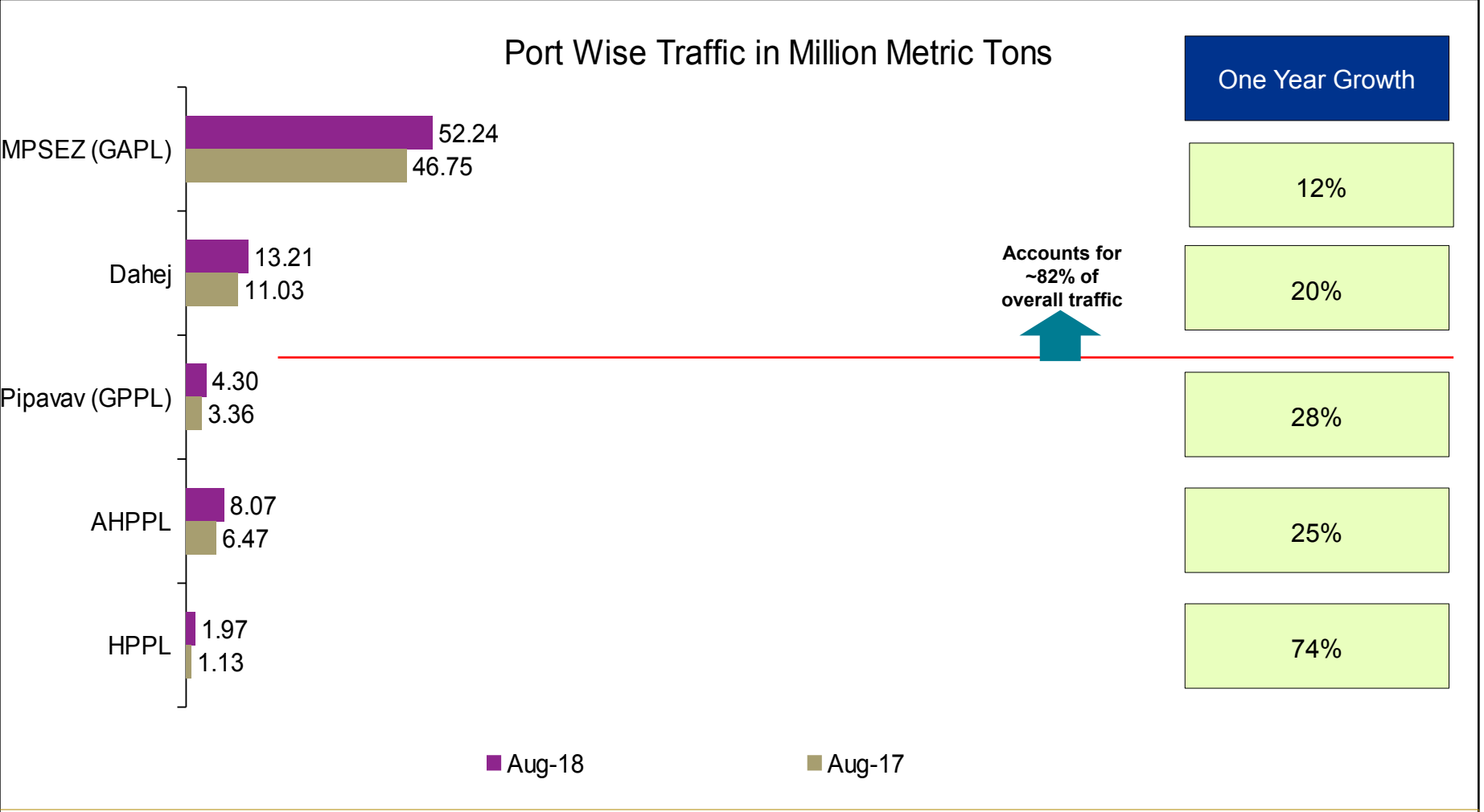

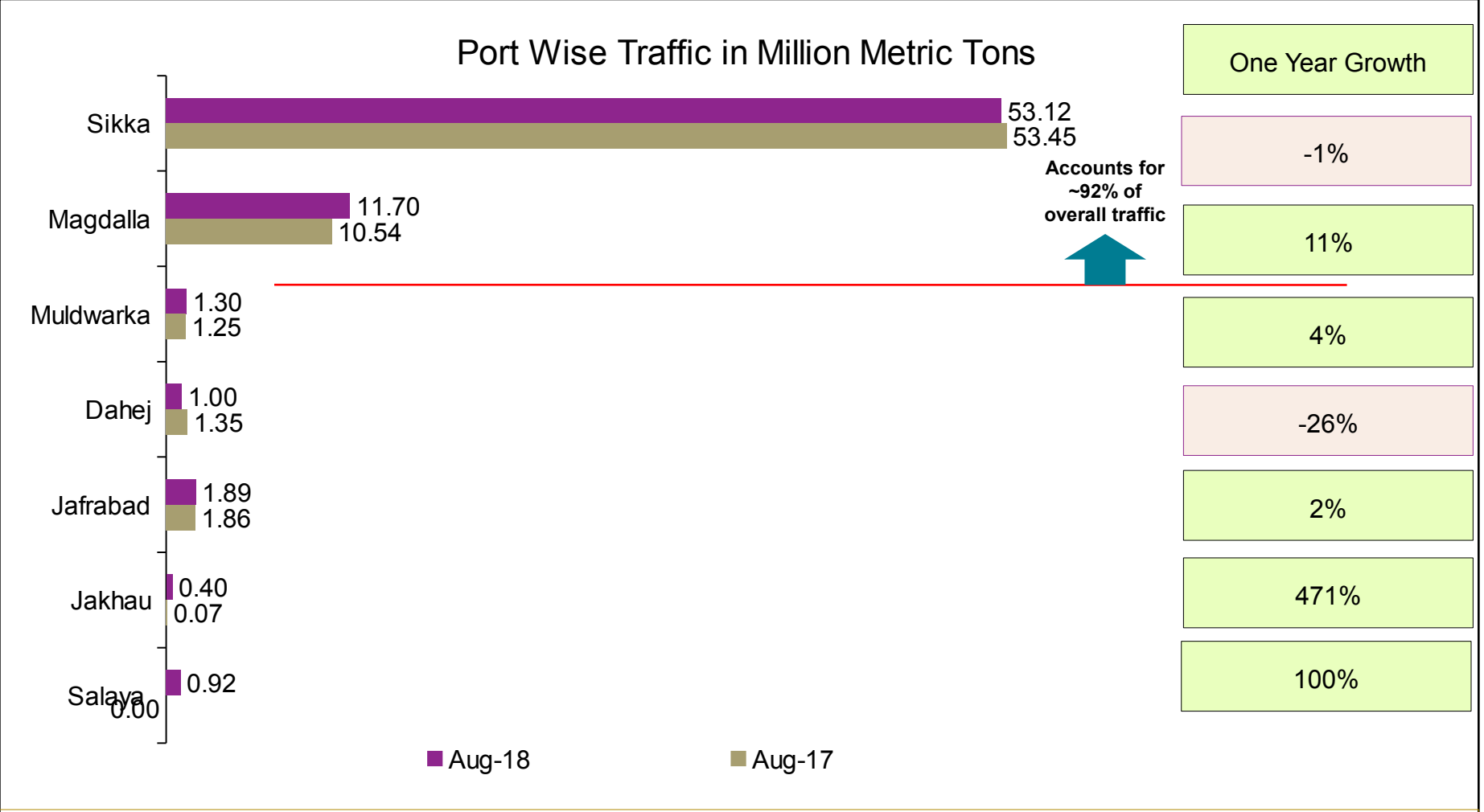


Private Ports handled 79.81 MMT which accounted for about 49.3% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first five months of FY 19



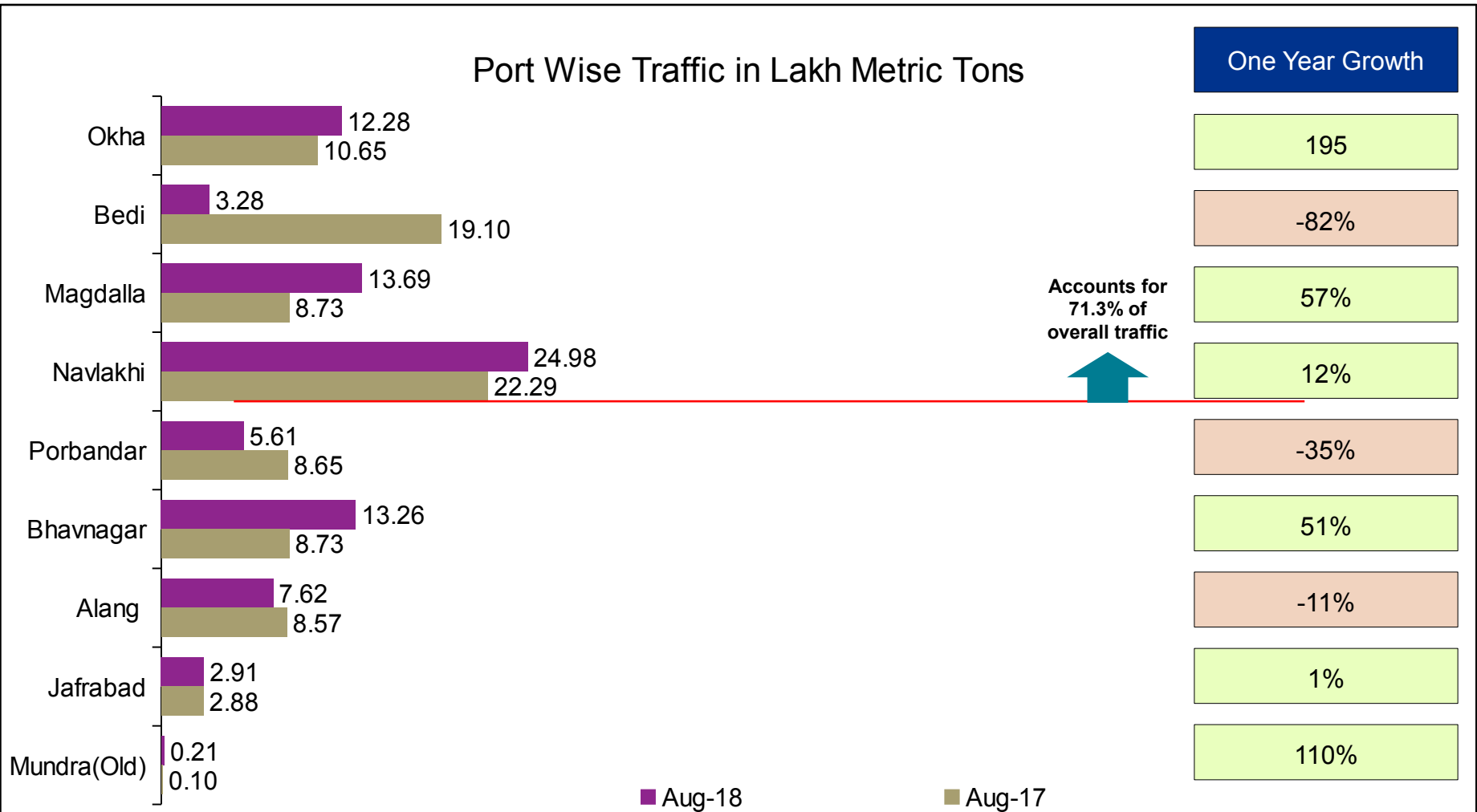
Private Ports handled 68.75 MMT which accounted for about 46.5 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 16.08 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

Captive Jetties handled 68.54 MMT which accounted for about 46.3% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for first five months of FY 19

 The cargo handled showed a growth of 2.64 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

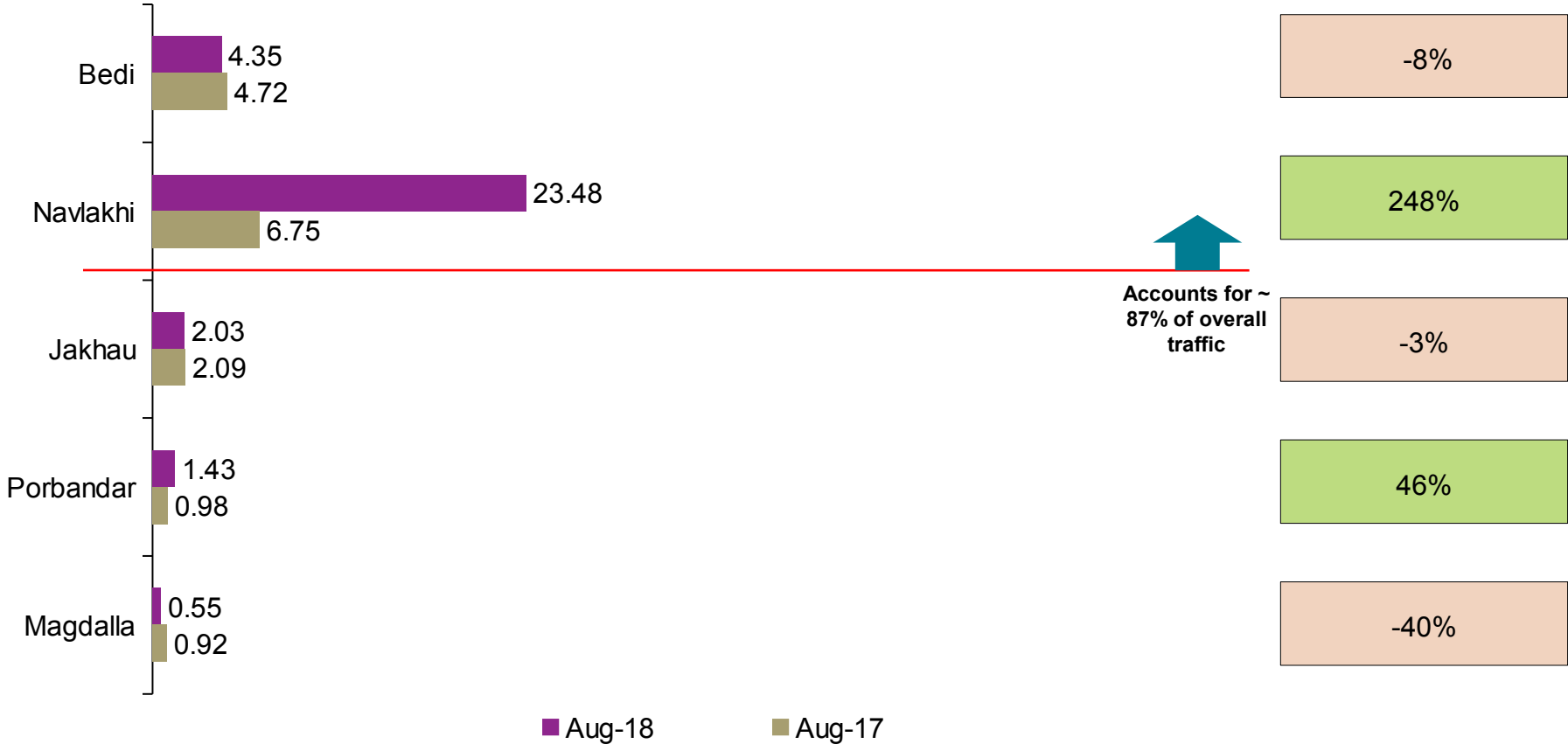
GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 8.38 MMT which accounted for about 5.18% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first five months of FY 19



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 8.97 MMT tons which accounted for about 6.0 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a decline of 6.5 % in FY 19 compared to the same period in FY18

Private Jetties handled 3.18 MMT which accounted for about 1.9% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat the first four month of FY 19

Port Wise Traffic in Lakh Metric Tons



Private Jetties handled 1.54 MMT tons which accounted for about 1.0% of the total traffic compared to the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a growth of 105.9% in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18
