

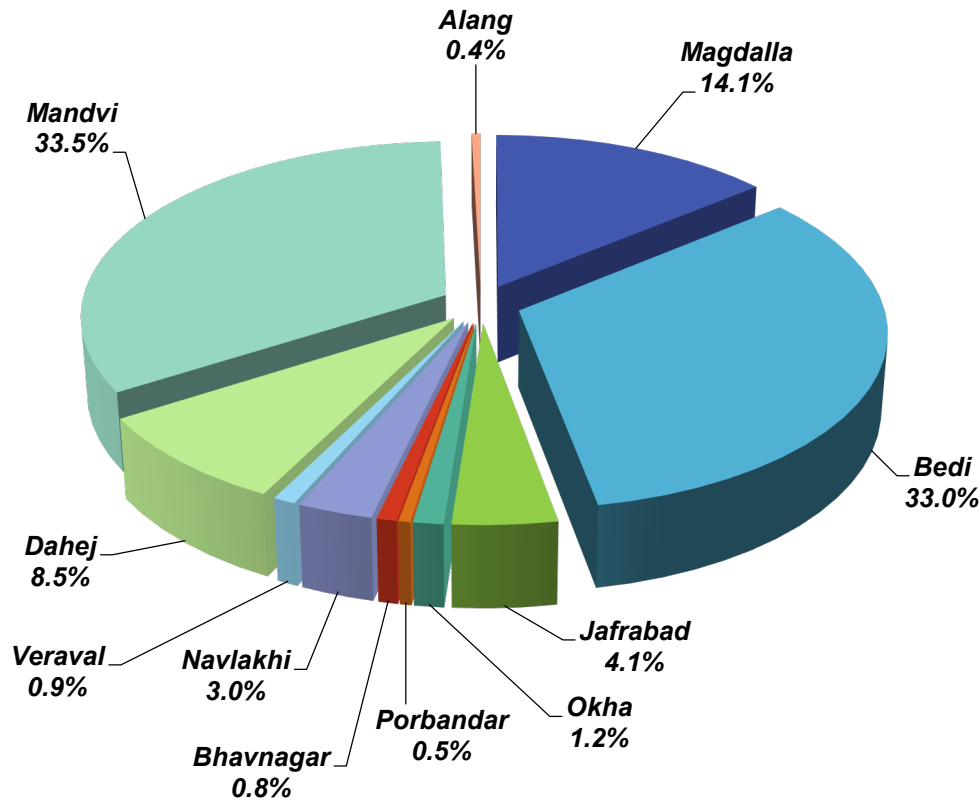

GMB Group of Ports - Cargo Share in 2018-19



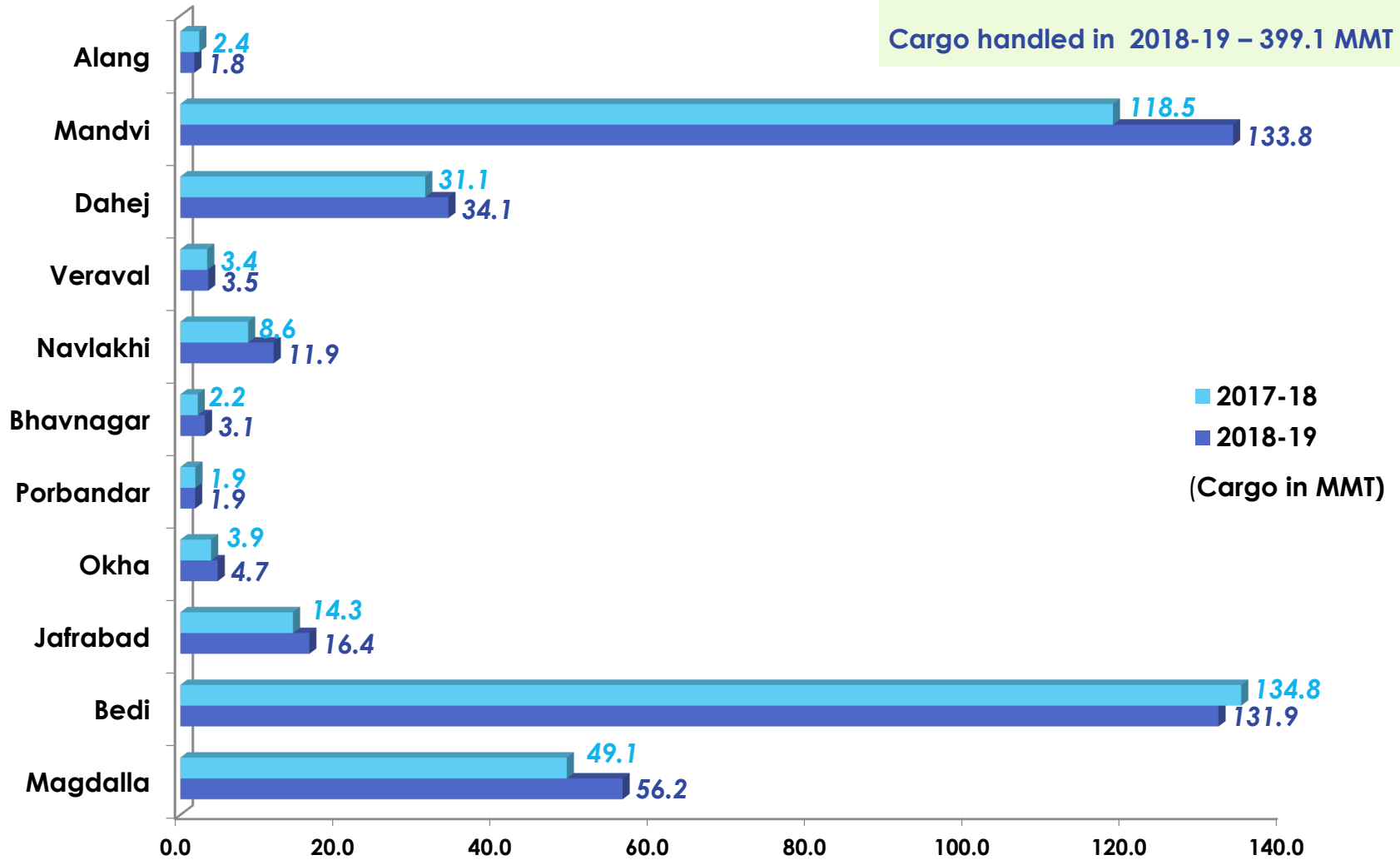

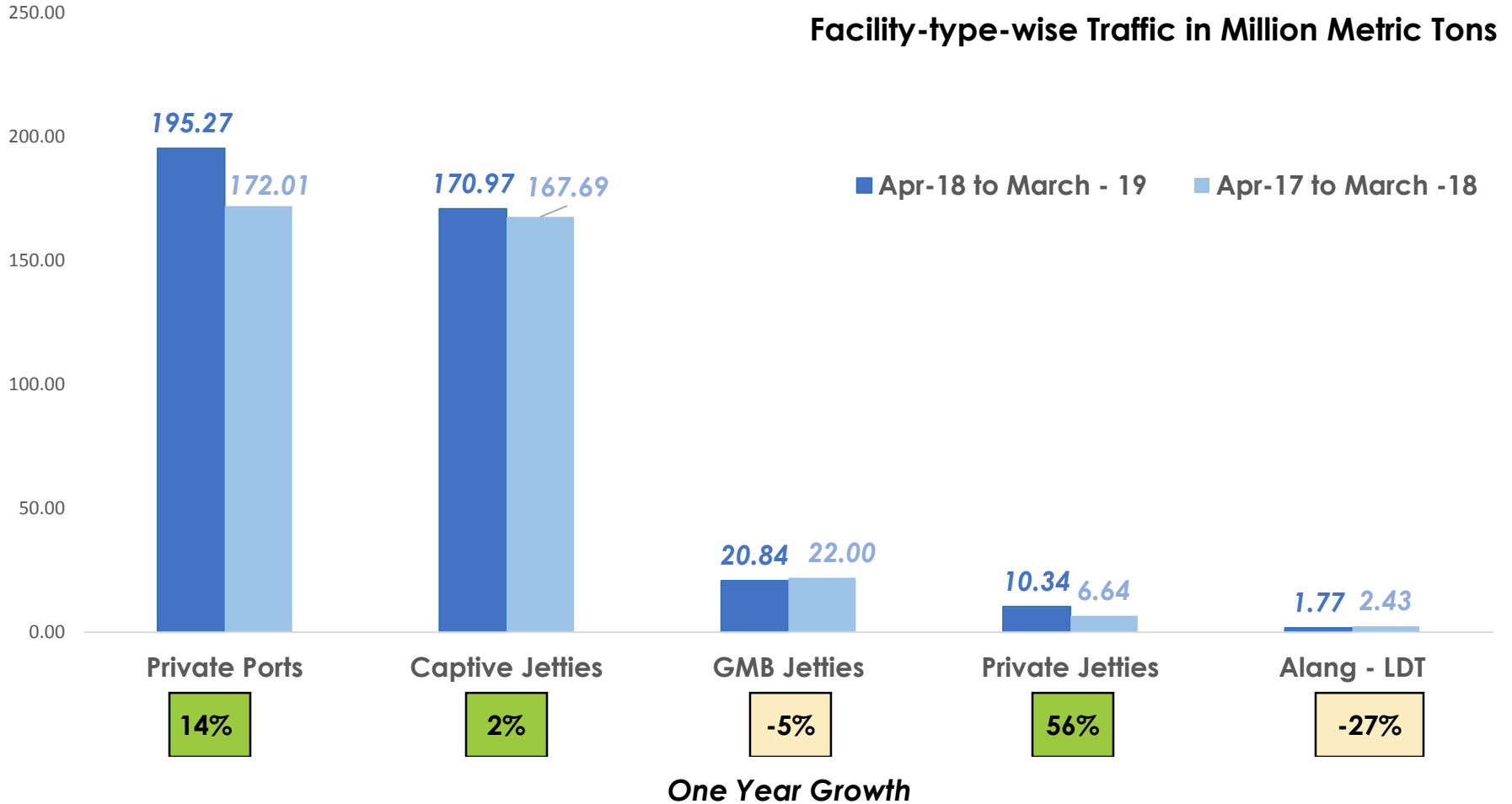
GMB Group of Ports – Cargo Comparison (2017-18 Vs 2018-19)

Cargo handled in 2018-19 – 399.1 MMT

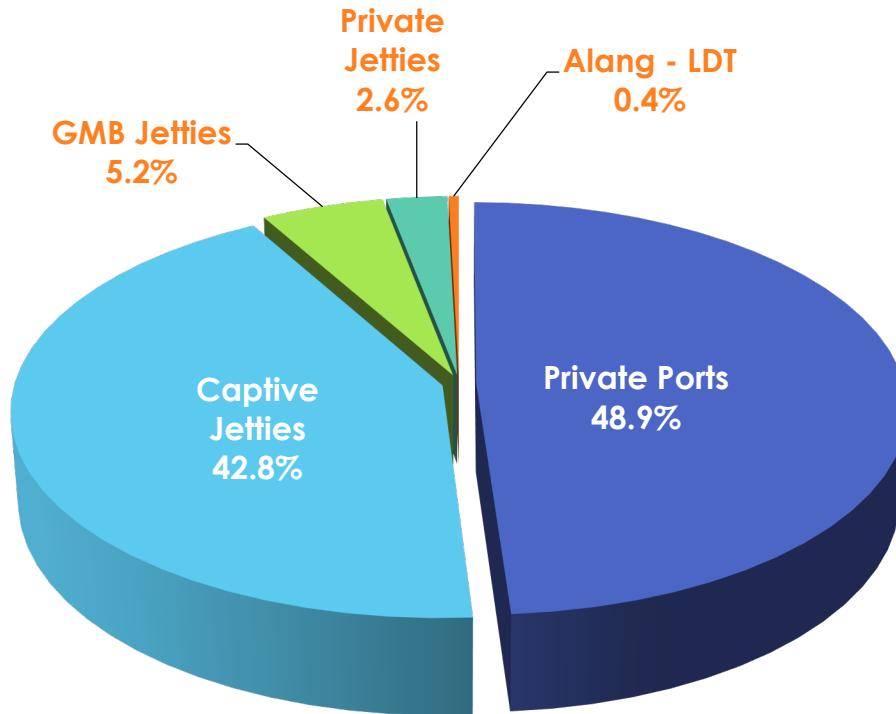


The traffic for the Year 2018-19 saw an increase of 7.67% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

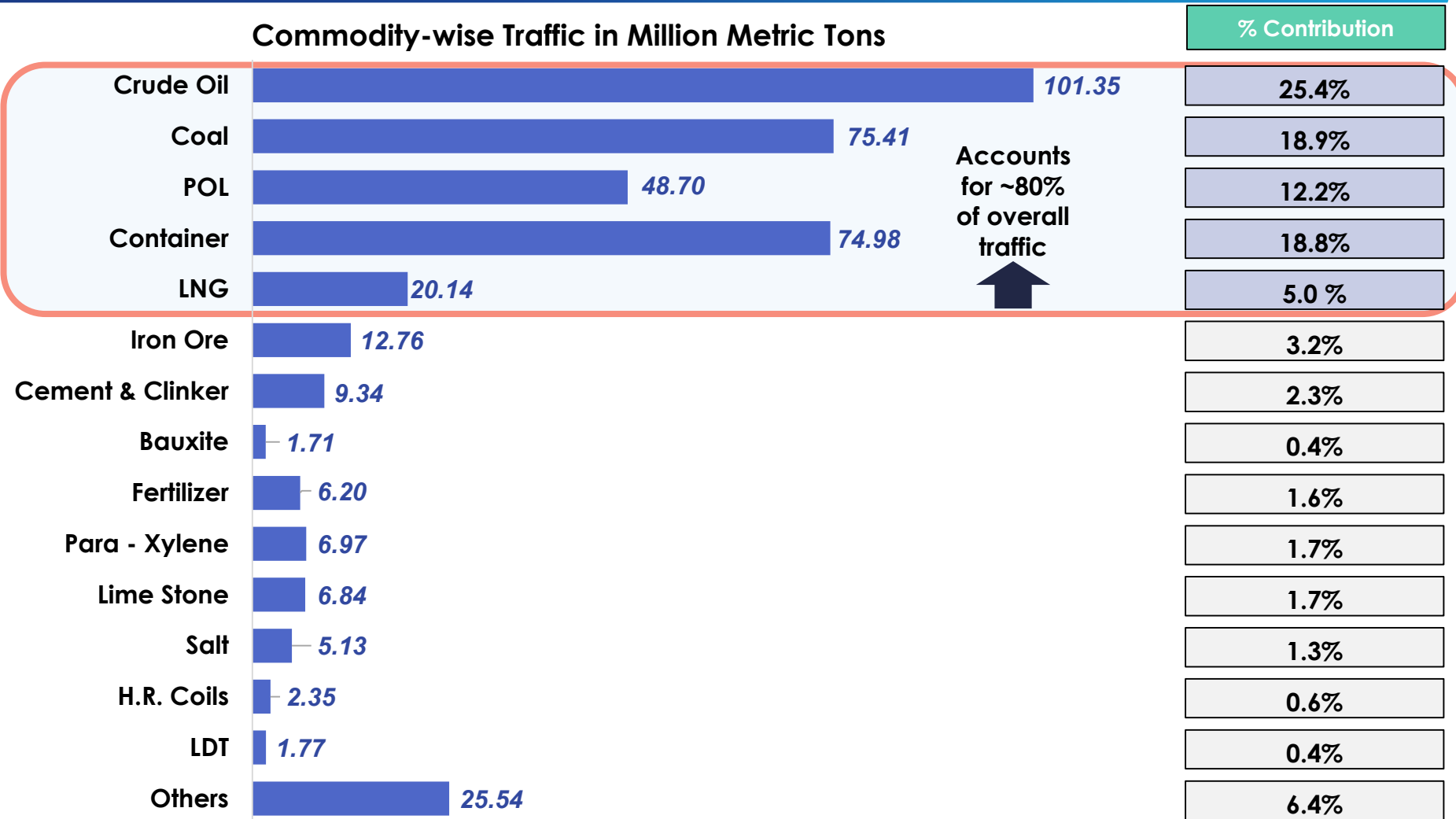
Facility wise Traffic for the Year 2018-19

Commodity mix for the traffic handled during the Year 2018-19

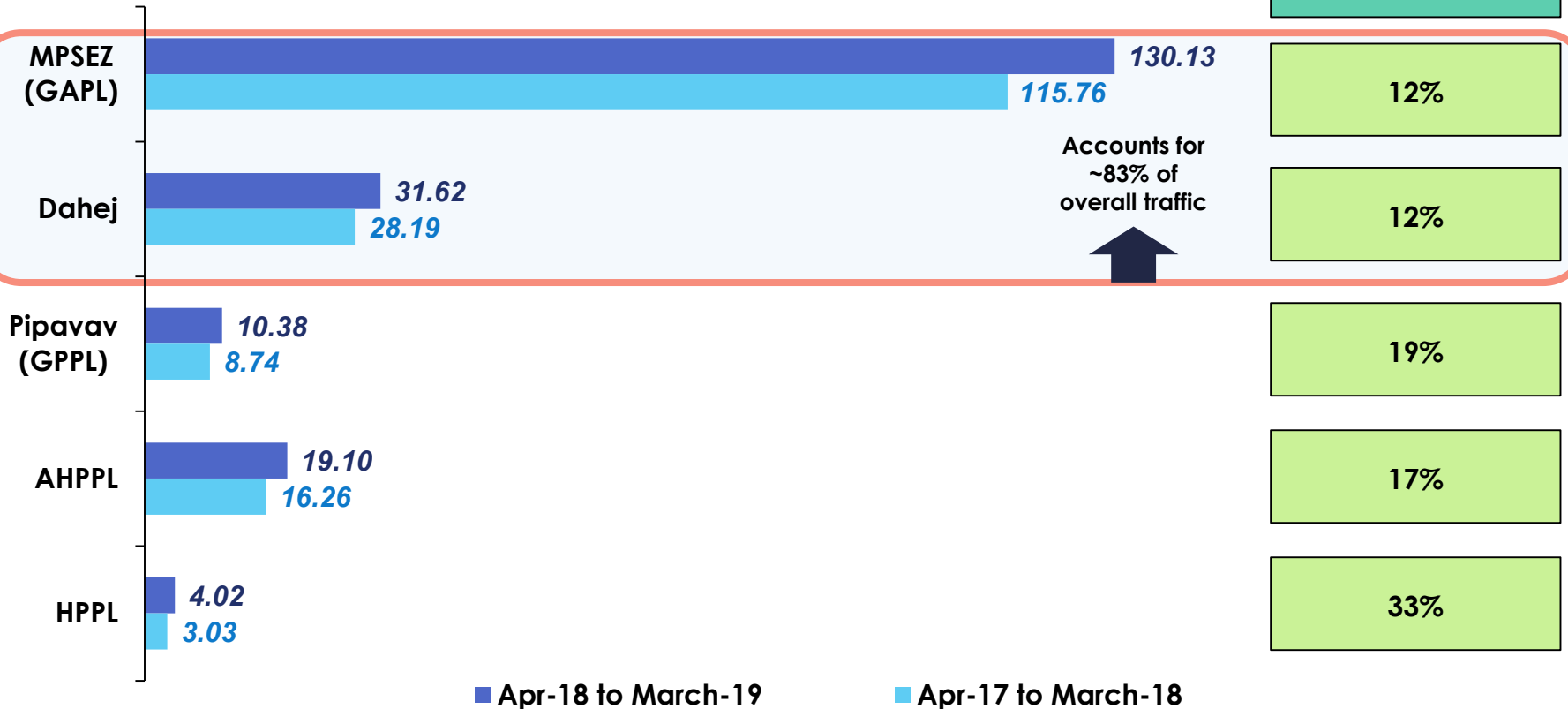
Commodity-wise Traffic in Million Metric Tons

Private Ports handled 195.2 MMT which accounted for about 48.9% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat during the Year 2018-19

Port Wise Traffic in Million Metric Tons

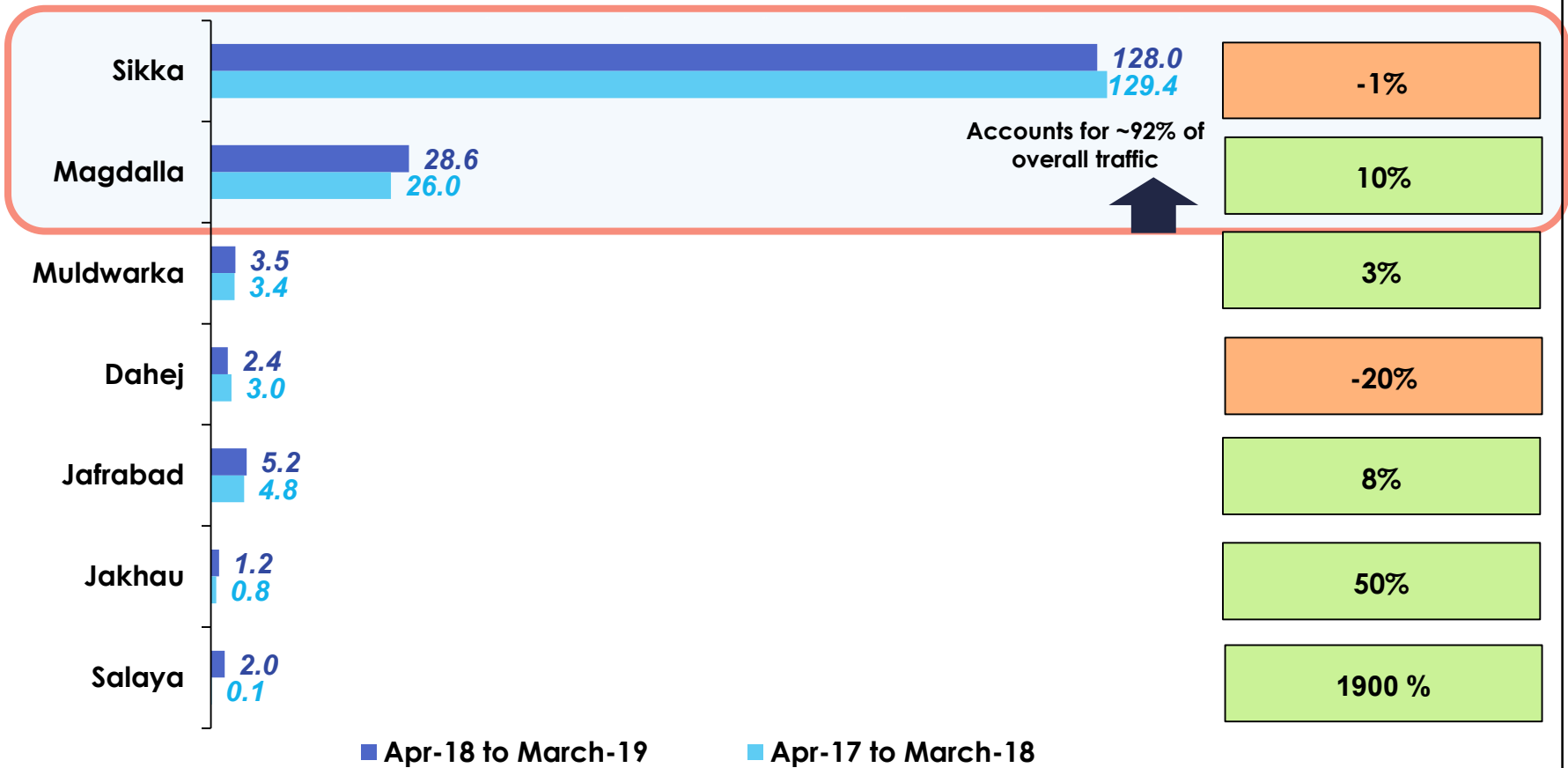


Private Ports handled 172.0 MMT which accounted for about 46% of the total traffic during the year 2017-18

One Year Growth

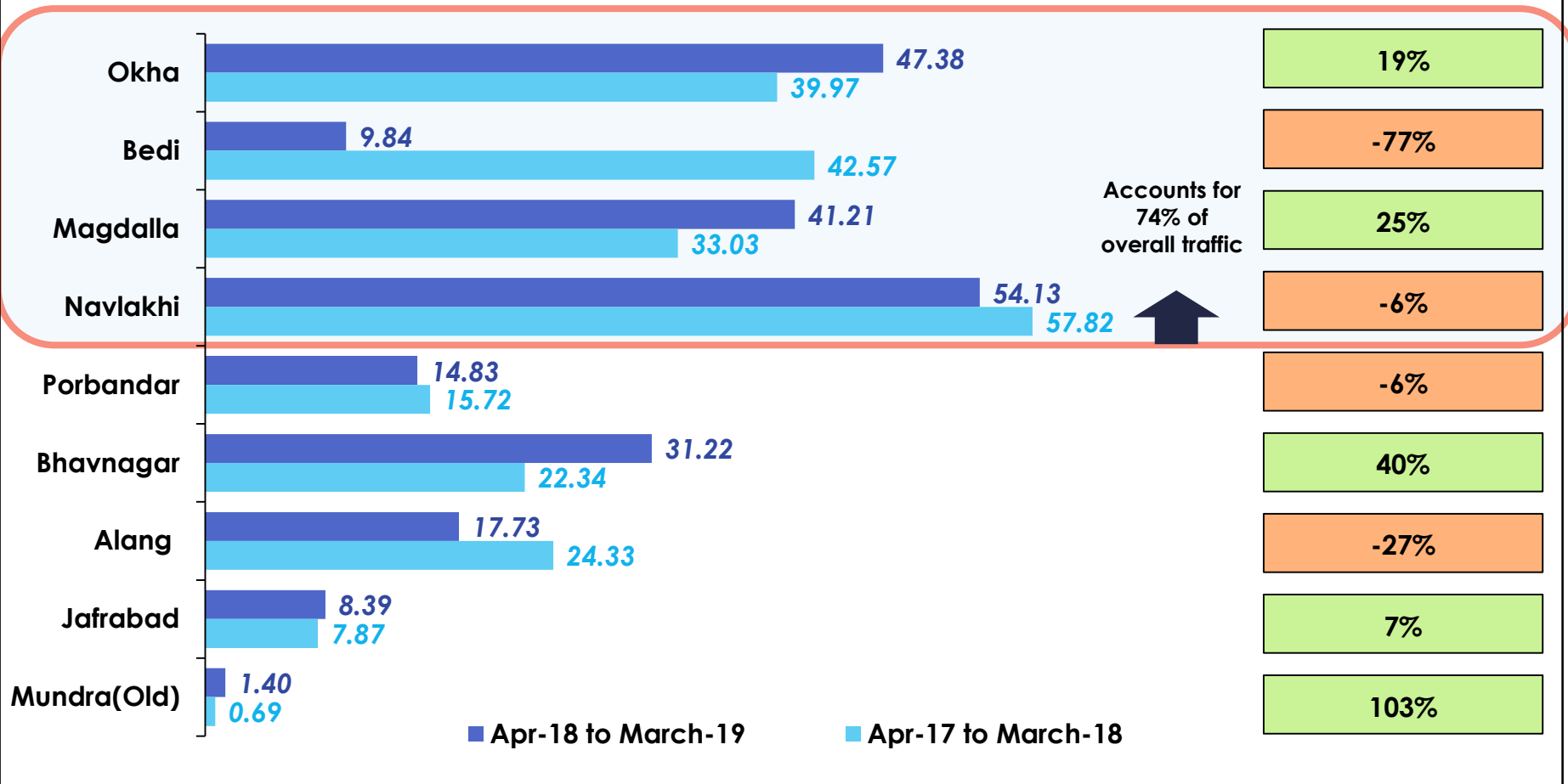


Captive Jetties handled **167.6 MMT** which accounted for about **45.2 %** of the total traffic for the 2017-18

One Year Growth

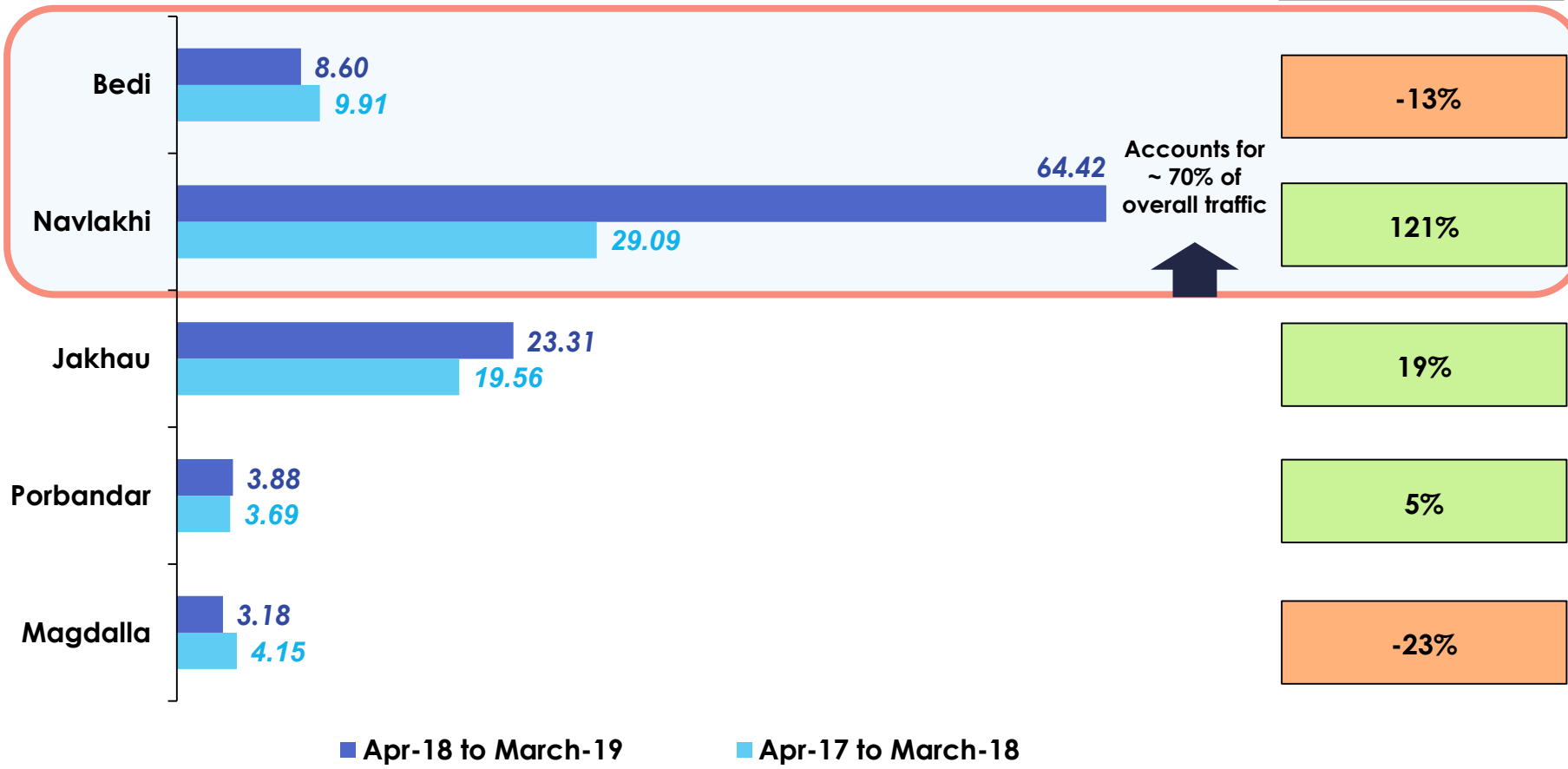


GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled **24.4 MMT tons** which accounted for about **6.5 %** of the total traffic during the year 2017-18
