

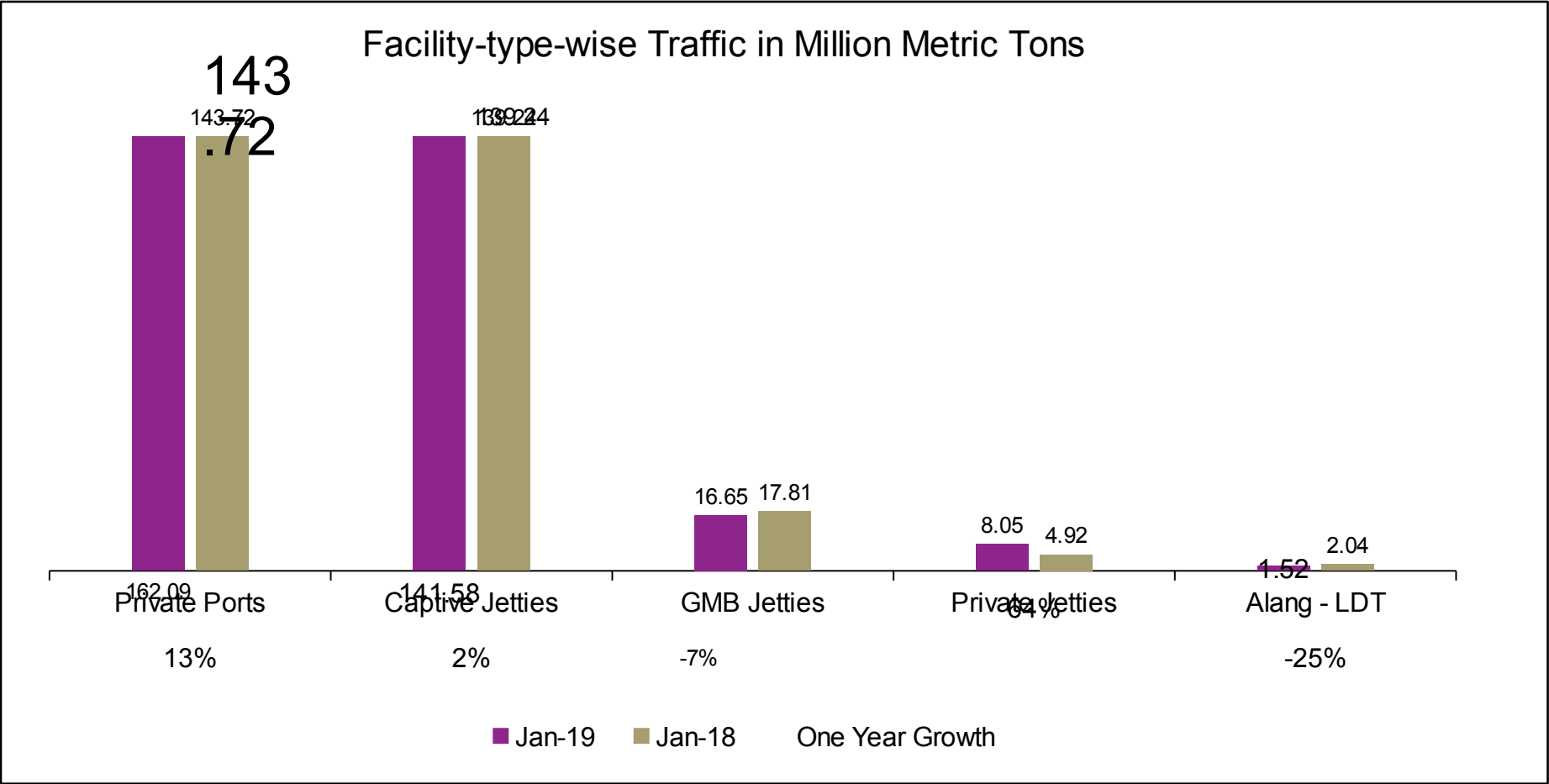

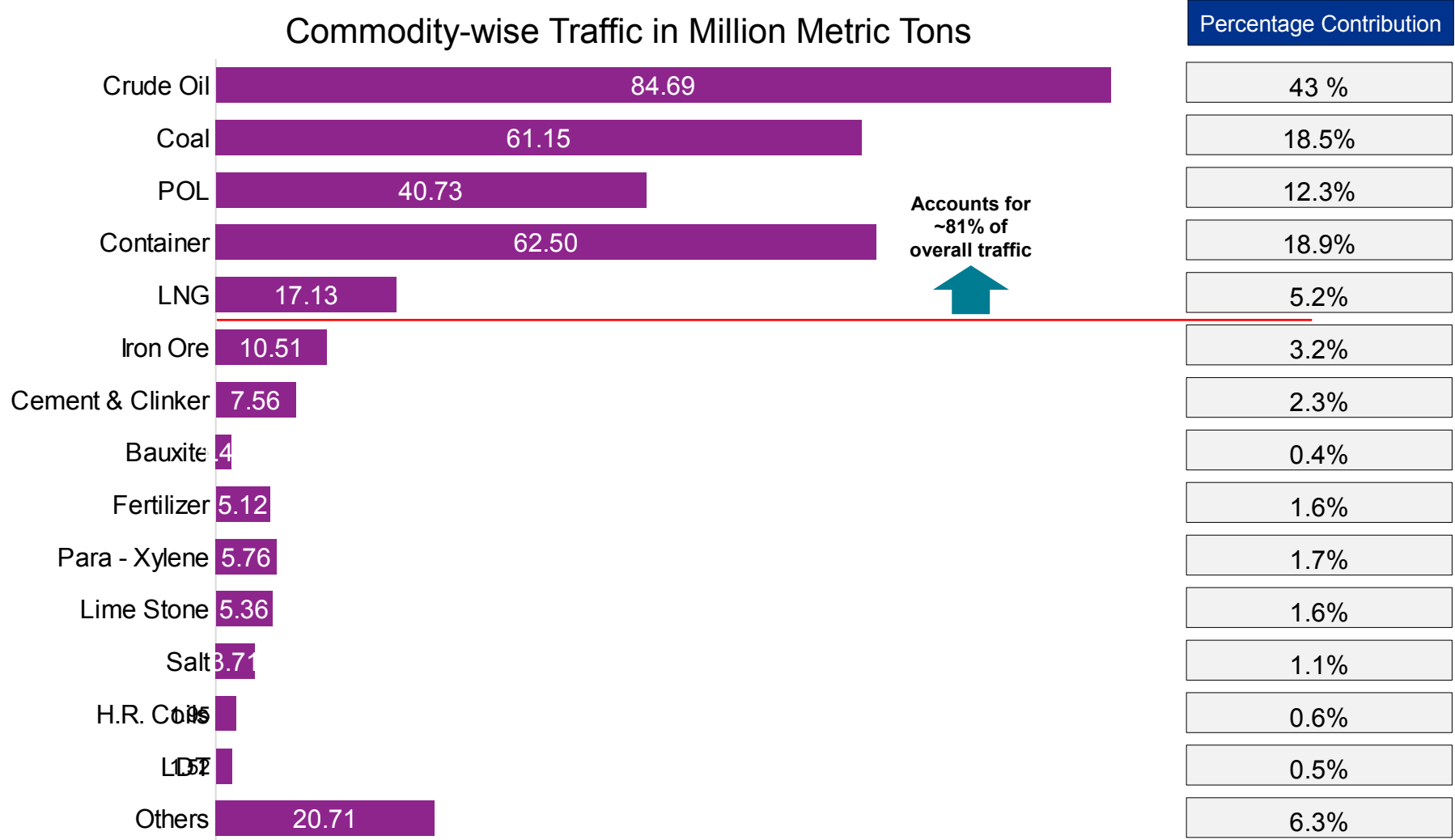

The GMB ports handled around 329.8 (Million Metric Tons) of traffic for first Ten months of FY 19, as compared to 307.7 MMT of traffic handled during the same period last year.

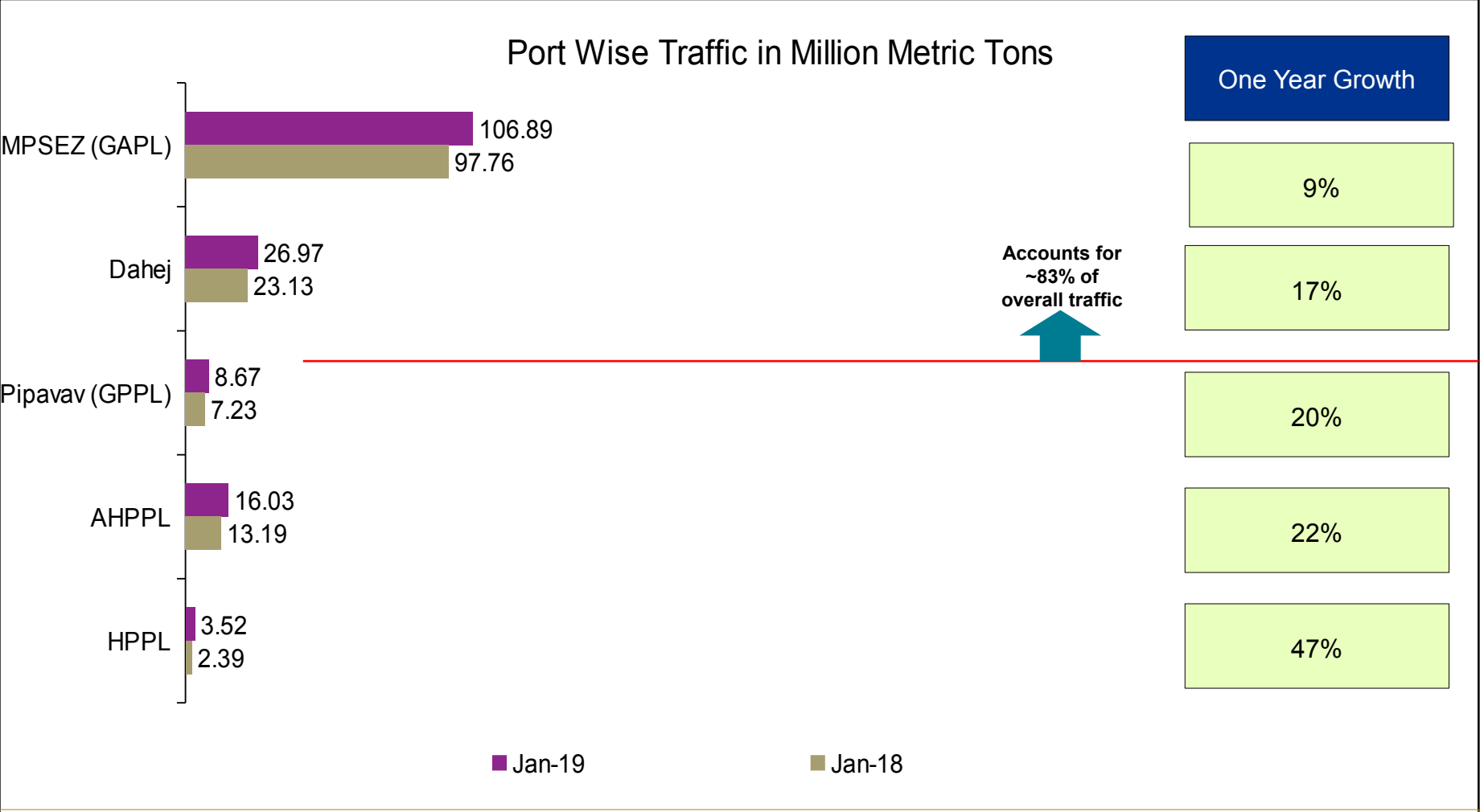

- Private Jetties

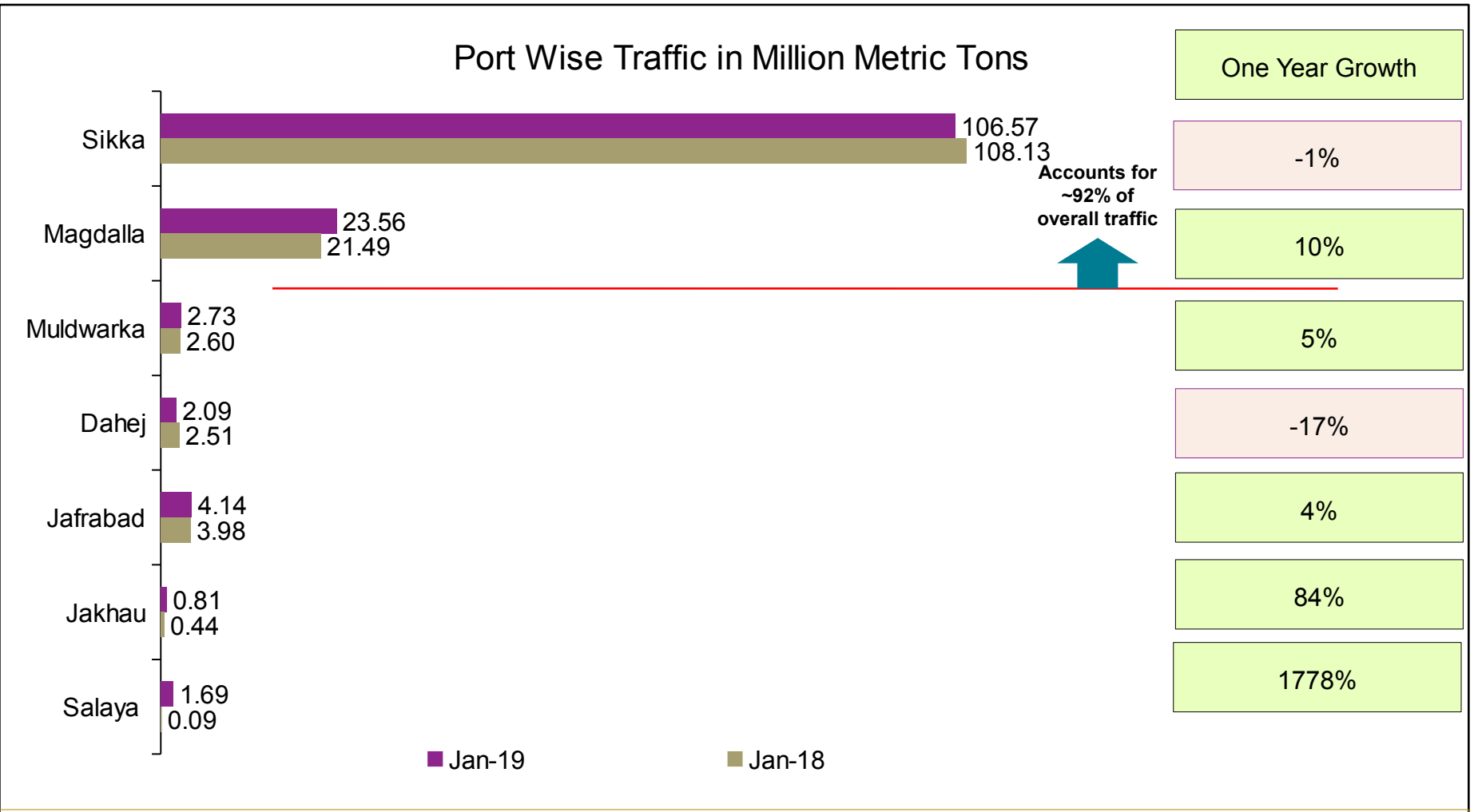


Private Ports handled 162.08 MMT which accounted for about 49% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first Ten months of FY 19



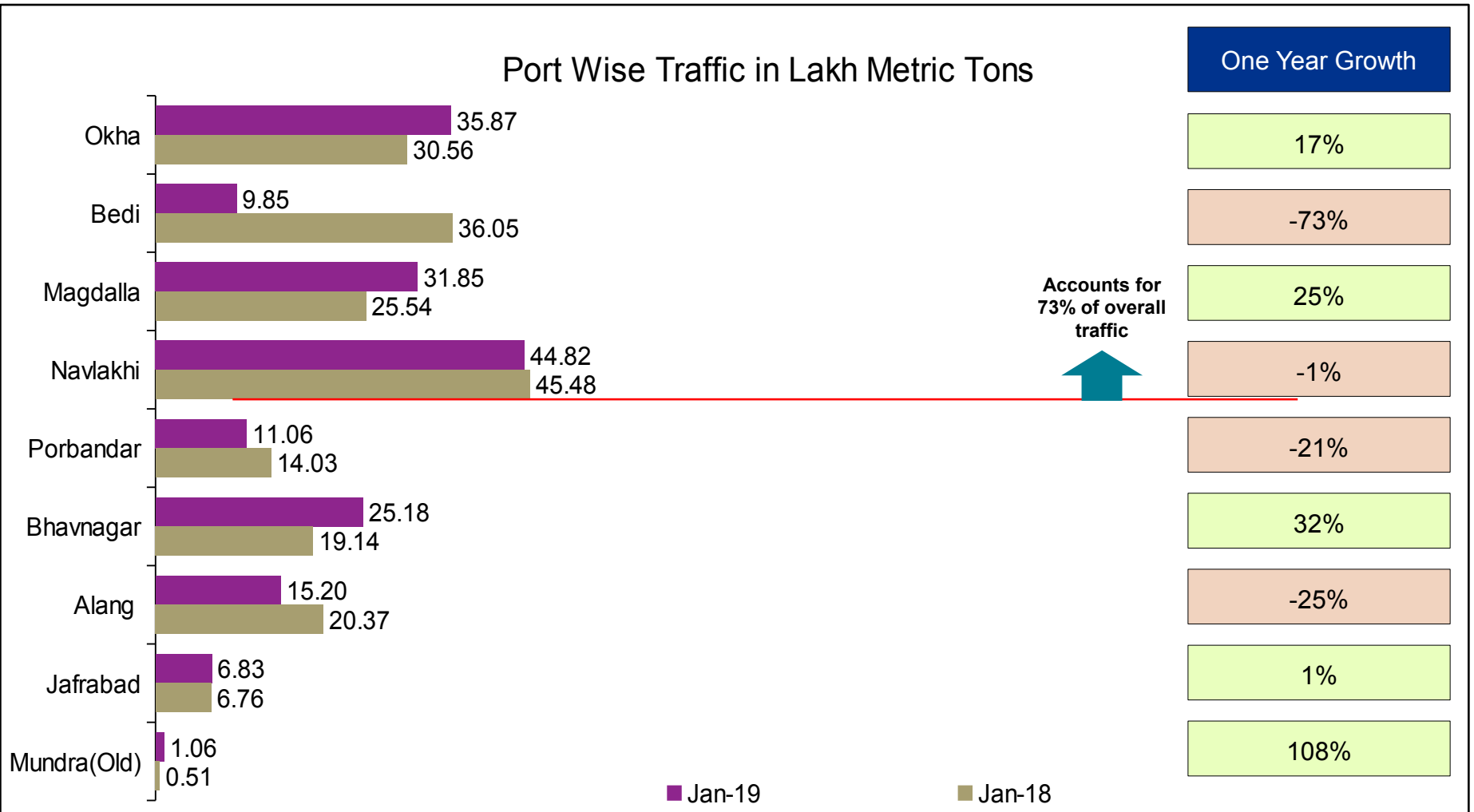
Private Ports handled 143.72 MMT which accounted for about 46.7 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 12.78 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

Captive Jetties handled 141.58 MMT which accounted for about 42.9% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for first Ten months of FY 19



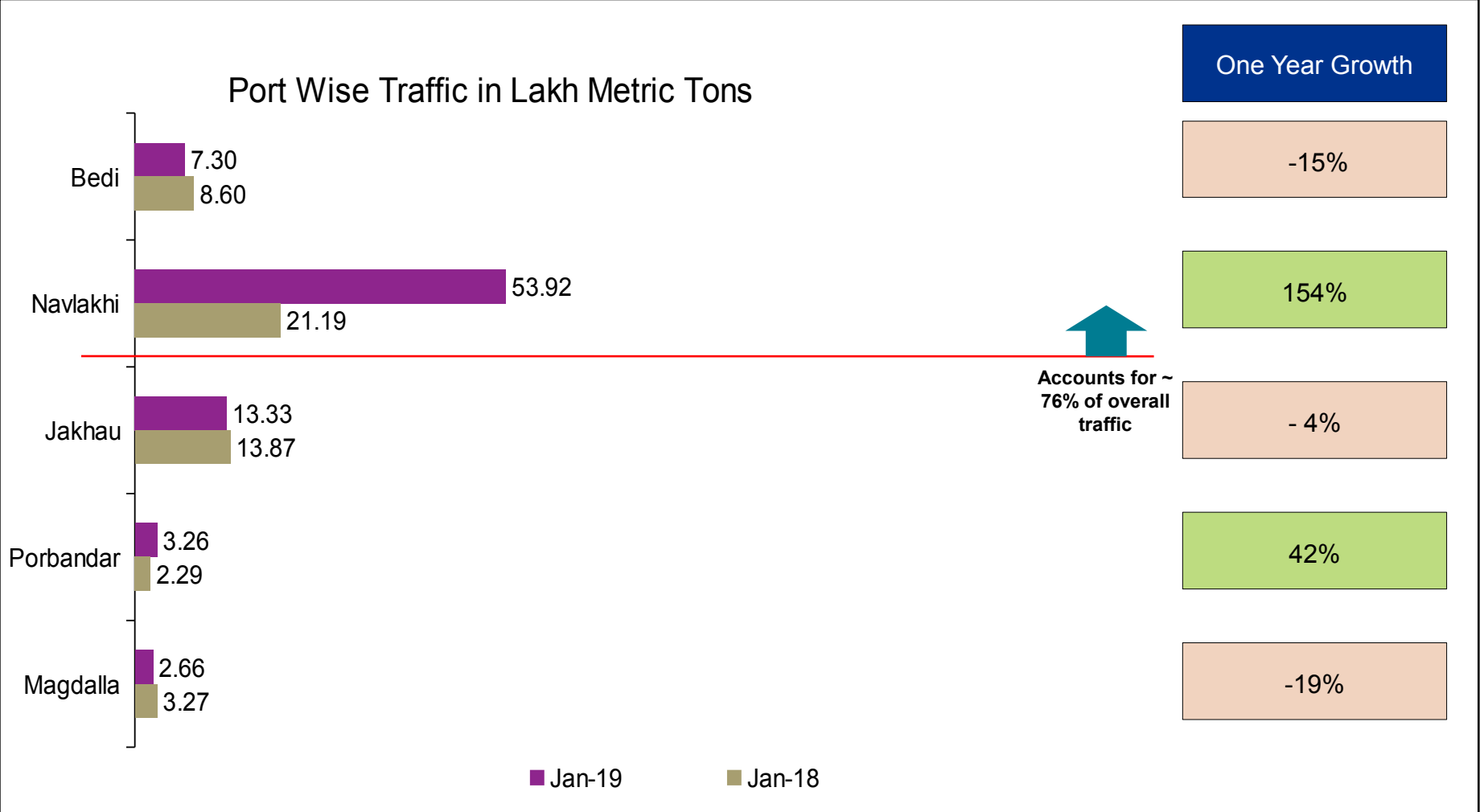
Captive Jetties handled 139.24 MMT which accounted for about 45.2% of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 1.68 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 18.17 MMT which accounted for about 5.50 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first Ten months of FY 19



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 19.84 MMT tons which accounted for about 6.4 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a decline of 8.43% in FY 19 compared to the same period in FY18

Private Jetties handled 8.01 MMT which accounted for about 2.4 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat the first Ten months of FY 19



Private Jetties handled 4.92 MMT tons which accounted for about 1.6% of the total traffic compared to the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a growth of 63.49 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18
