



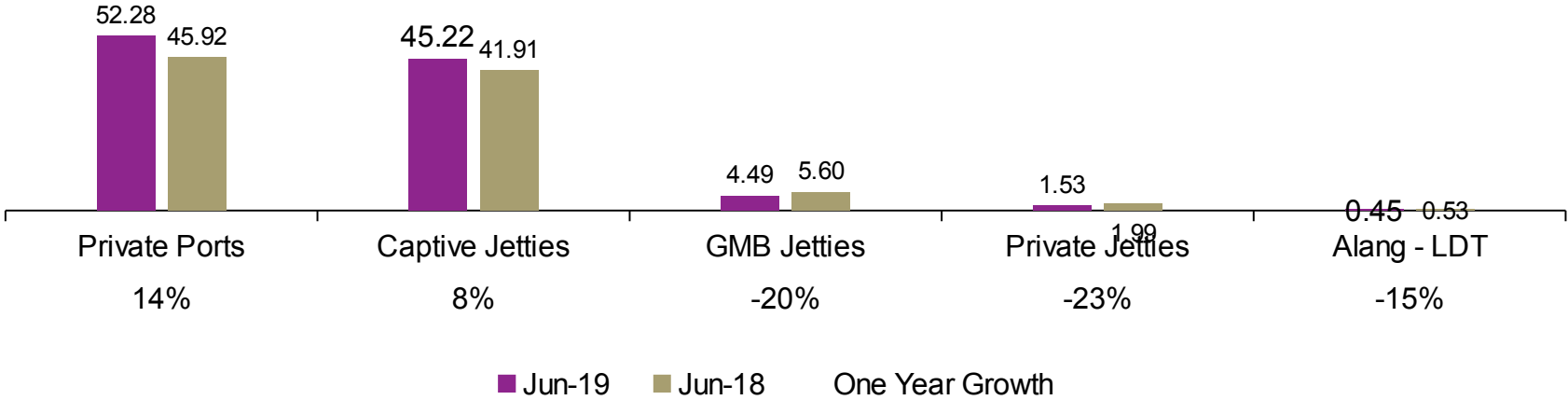

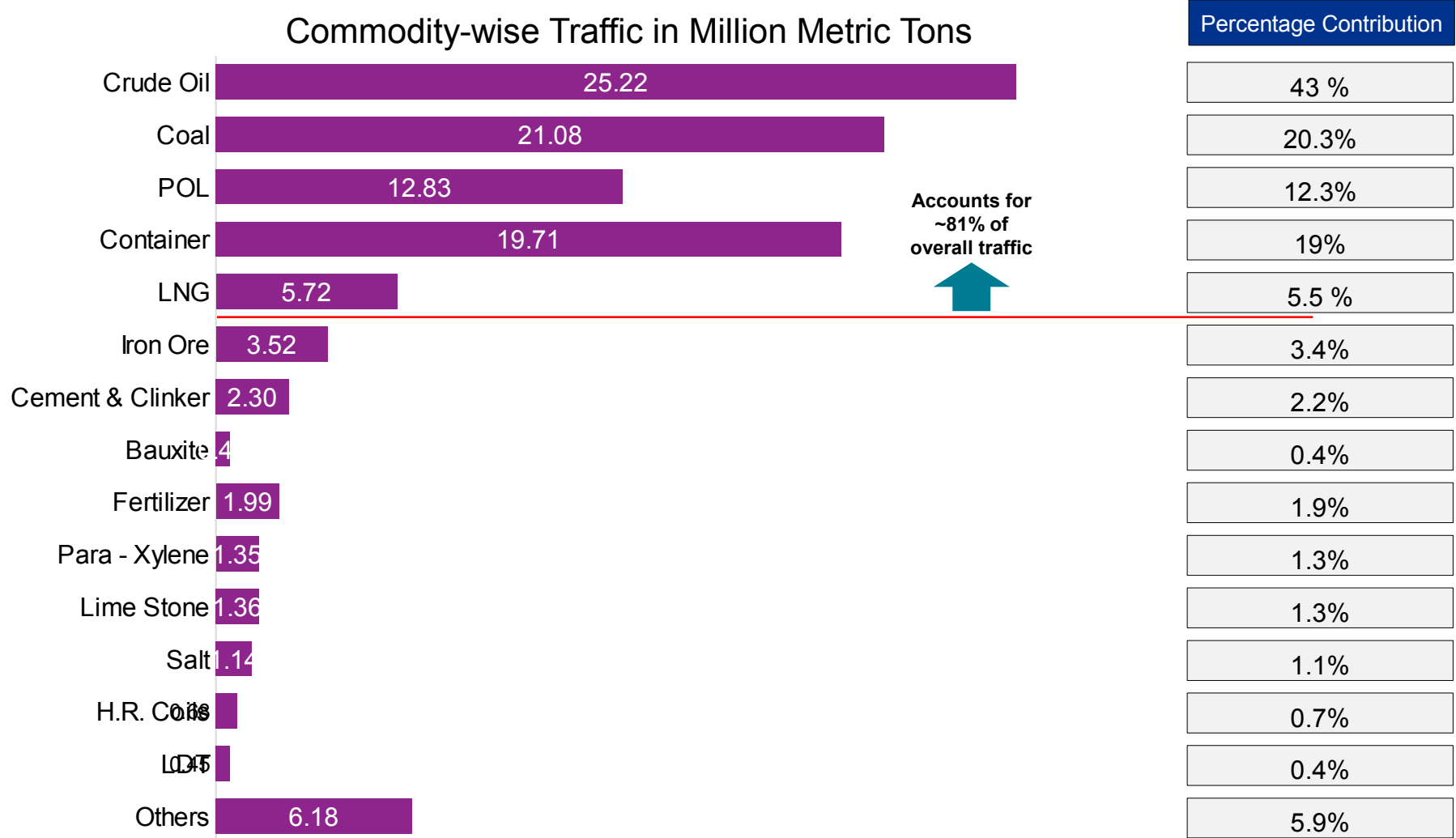
The traffic for the month of June-19 saw an increase of 8.38 % compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

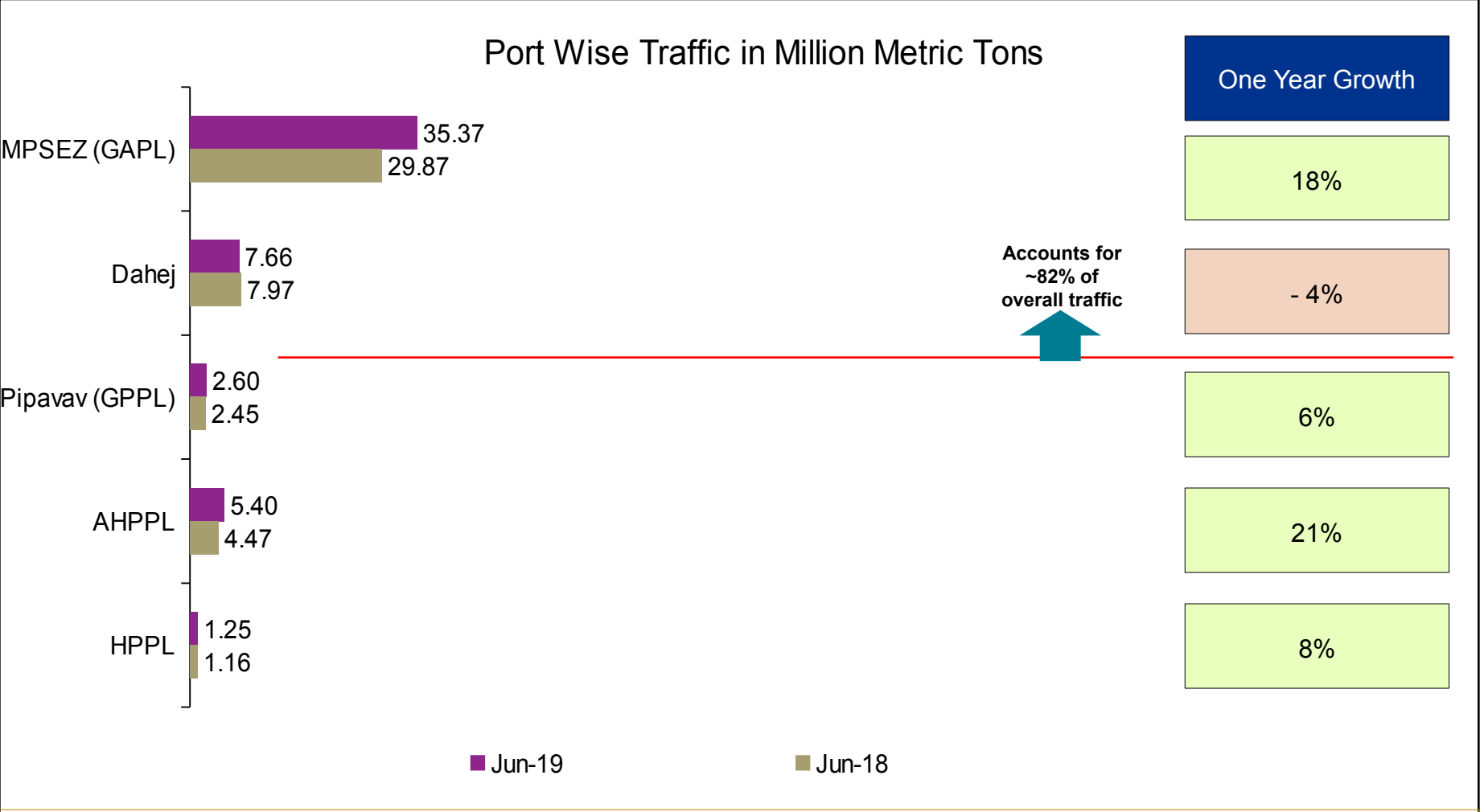

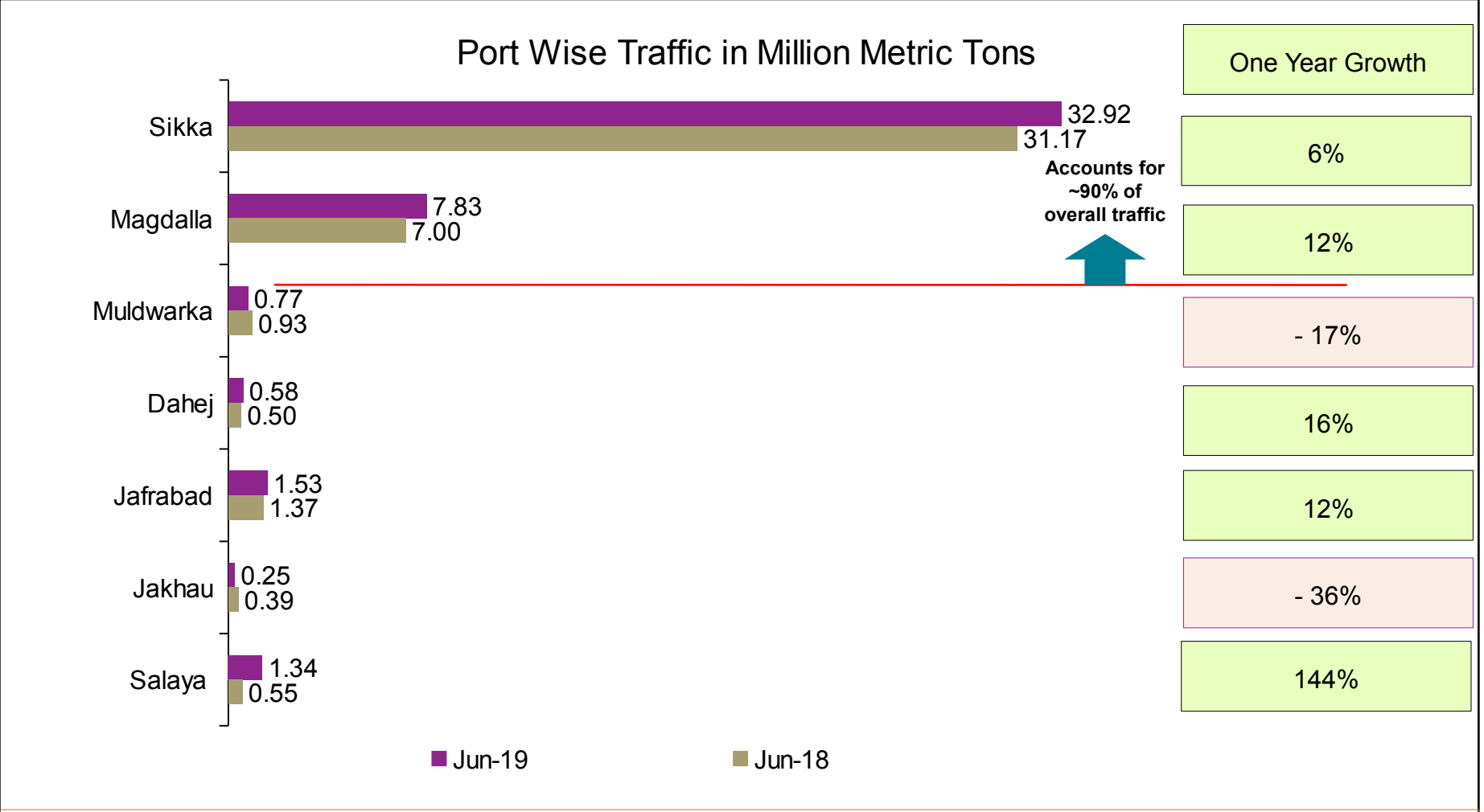


**Private Ports handled 52.28 MMT which accounted for about 50.2% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first quarter of FY 20**



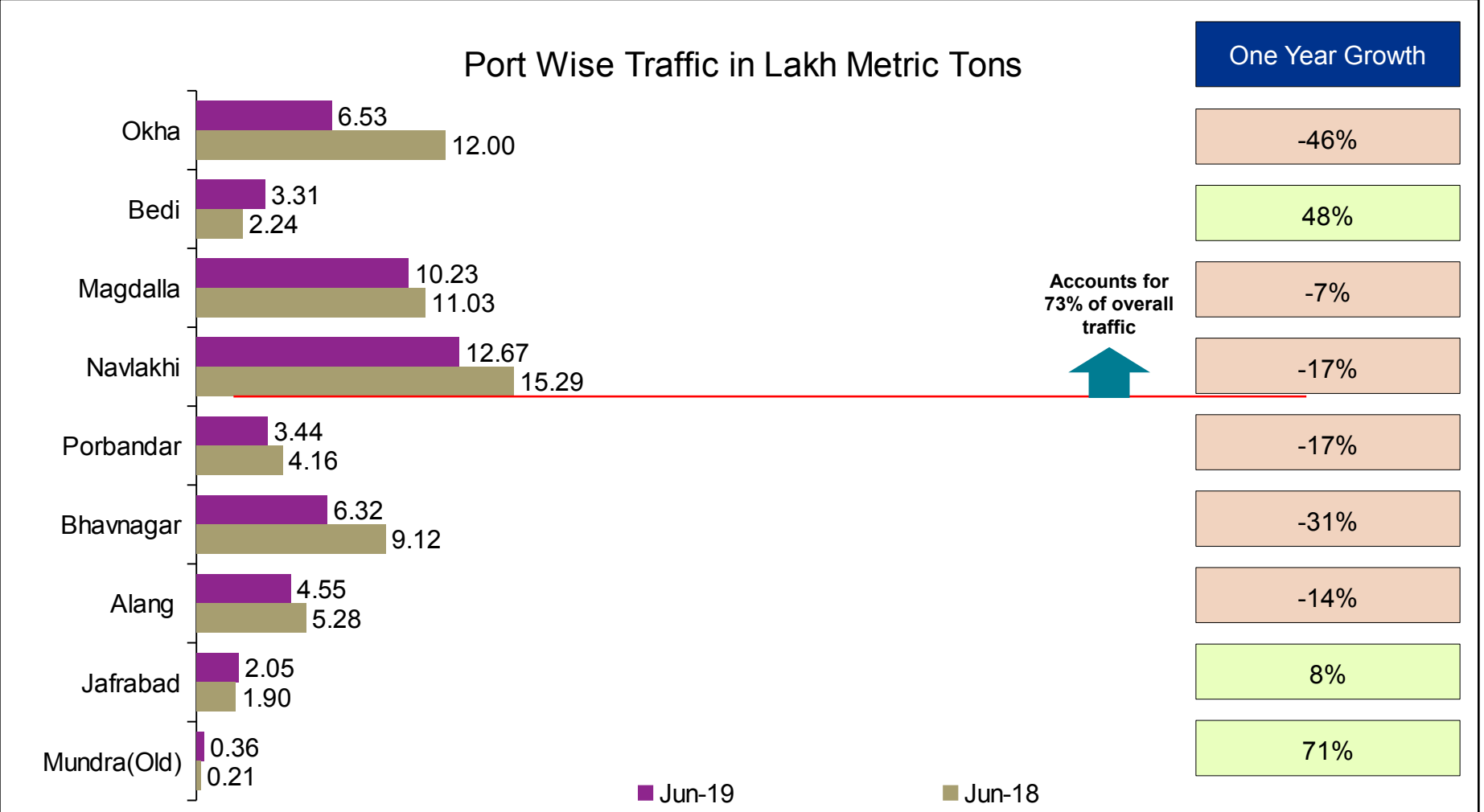
Private Ports handled 45.92 MMT which accounted for about 47.8 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19  
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 13.85 % in FY 2019-20 compared to the same period in 2018-19

**Captive Jetties handled 45.22 MMT which accounted for about 43.4% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in first quarter of FY 20**



Captive Jetties handled 41.91 MMT which accounted for about 43.6 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19  
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 7.92 % in FY 2019-20 compared to the same period in 2018-19

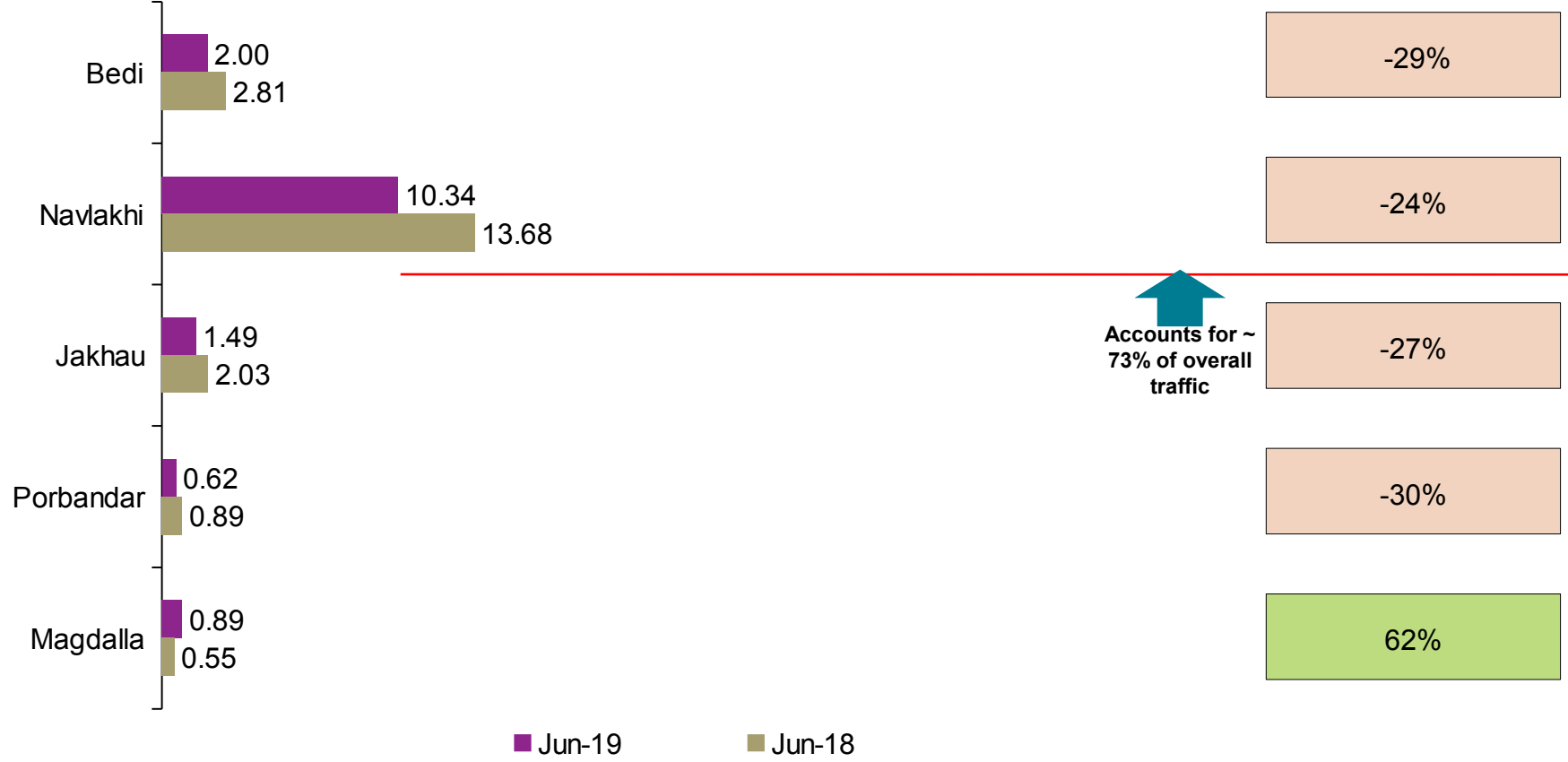
**GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 4.95 MMT which accounted for about 4.8% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in first quarter of FY 20**



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 6.12 MMT tons which accounted for about 6.3% of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19 .The cargo handled showed a decline of -19.22 % in FY 20 compared to the same period in FY19

**Private Jetties handled 1.53 MMT which accounted for about 1.47 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for first quarter of FY 20**

Private Jetties handled 2.00 MMT tons which accounted for about 2.1% of the total traffic compared to the same period in 2018-19
