



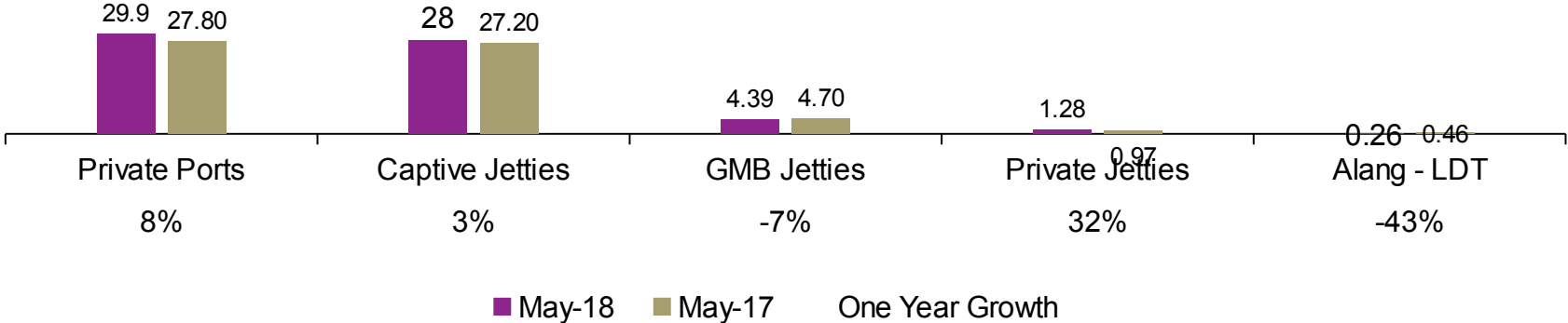

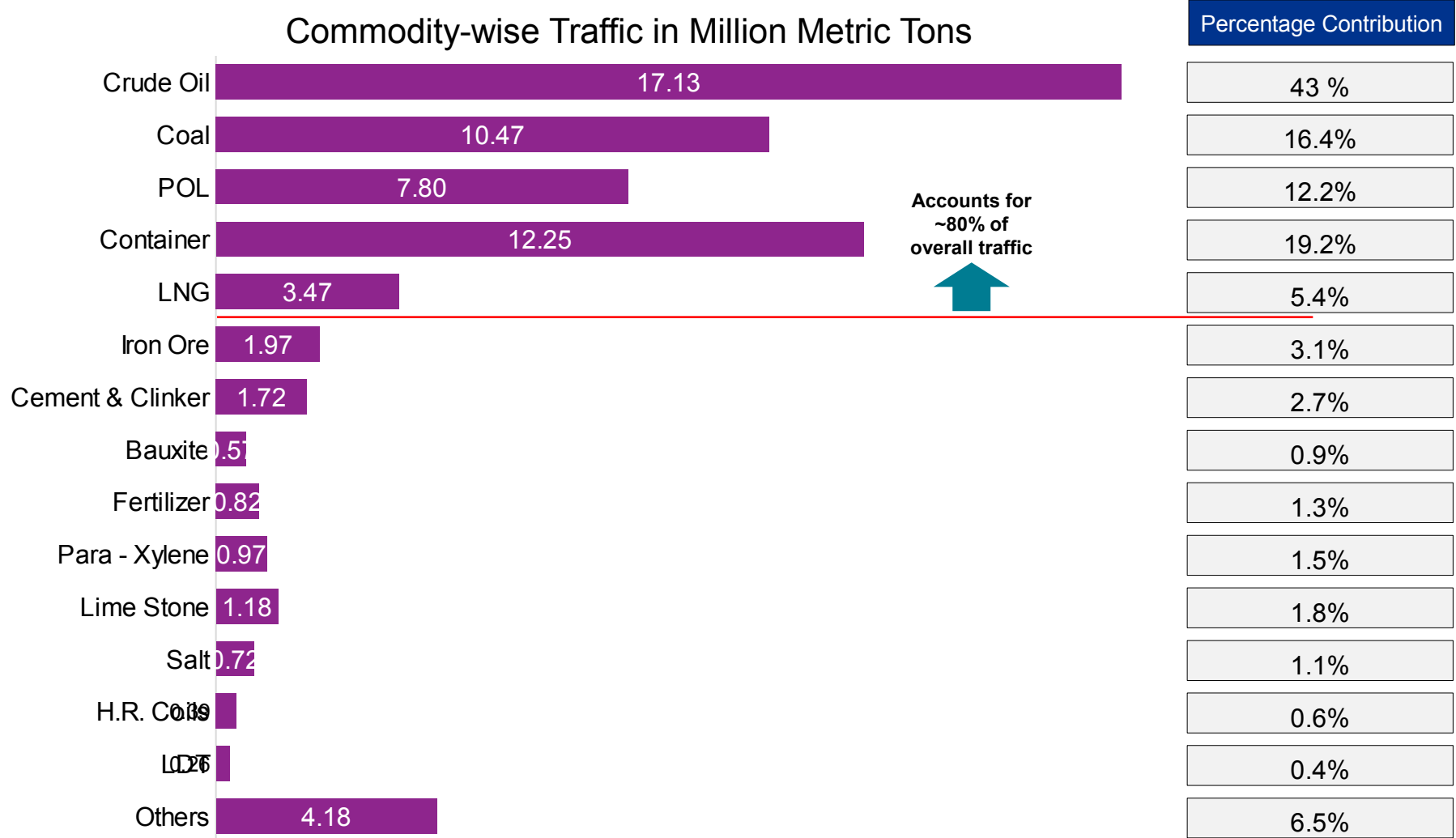
The traffic for the first two months of FY 19 saw an increase of 4.45% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

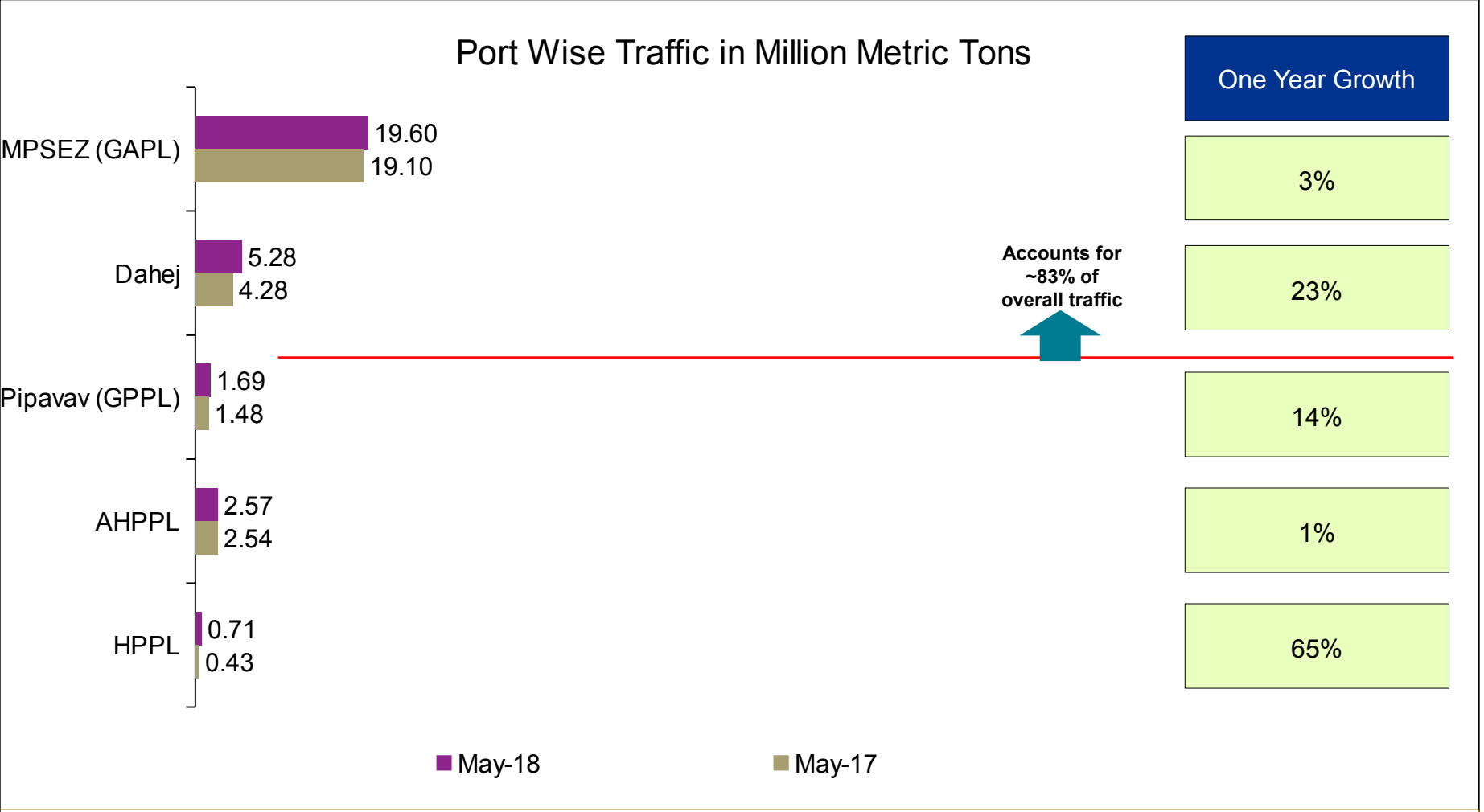

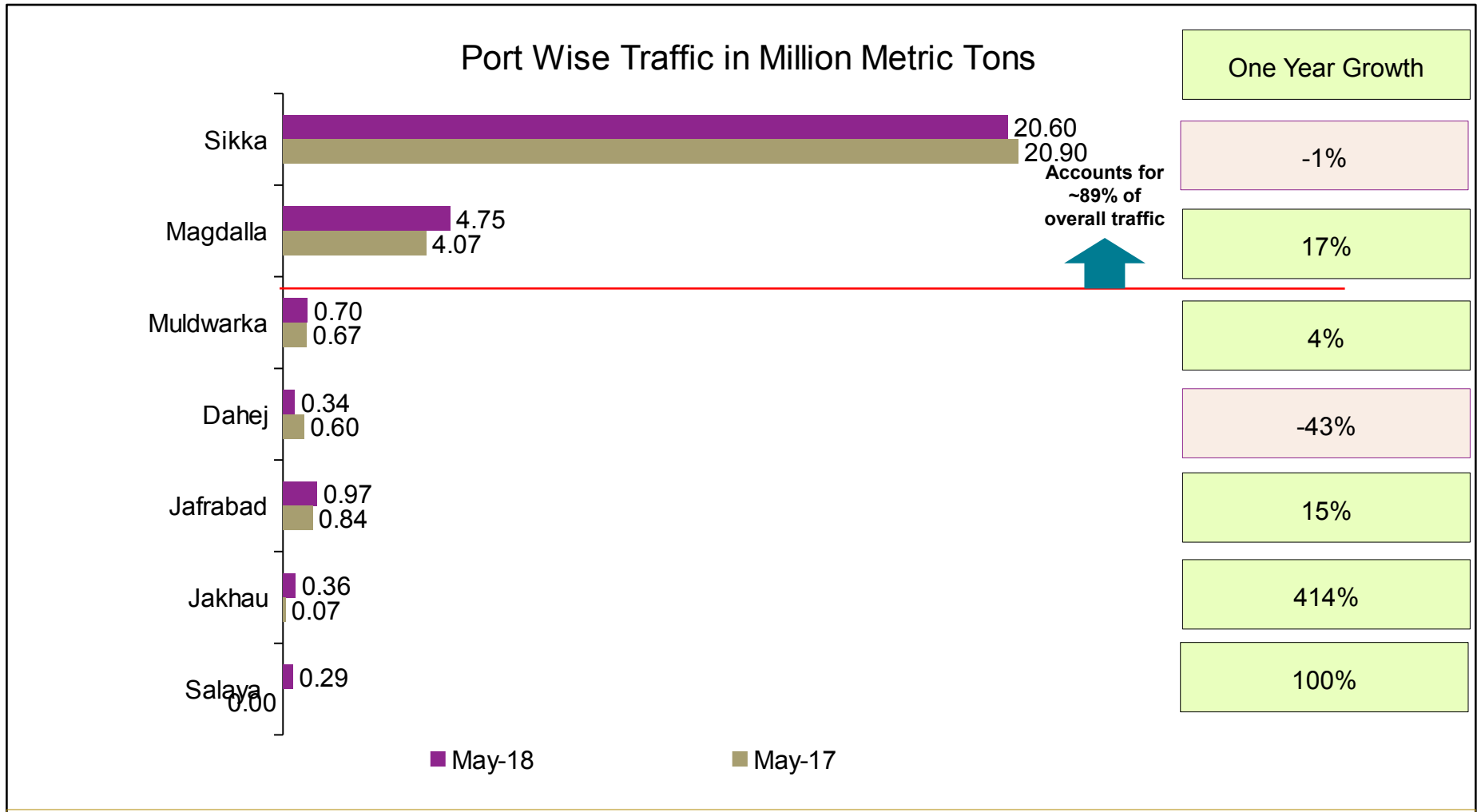


**Private Ports handled 29.9 MMT which accounted for about 46.7% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first two months of FY 19**



Private Ports handled 27.8 MMT which accounted for about 45.4 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18  
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 7.20 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

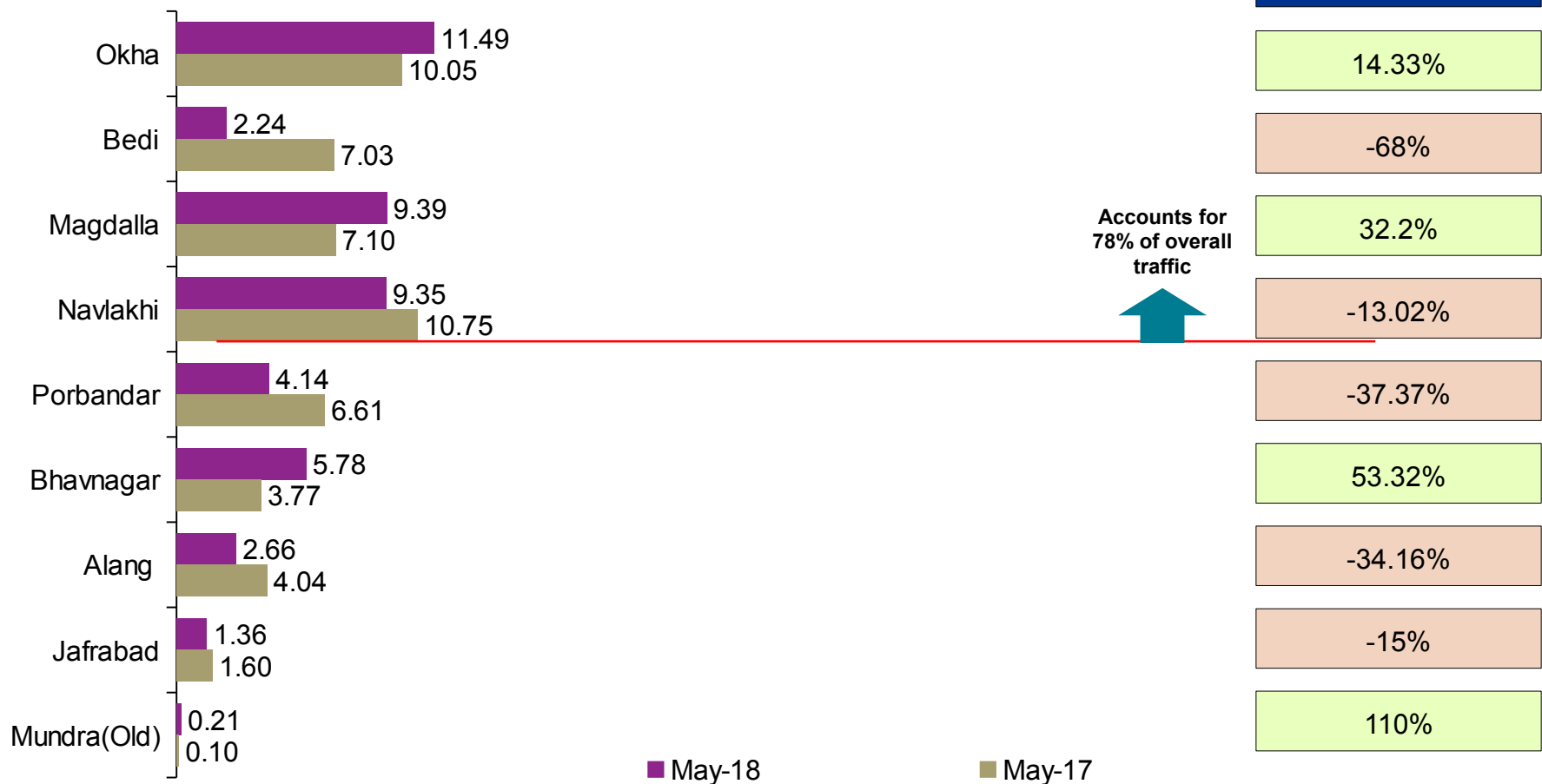
**Captive Jetties handled 28 MMT which accounted for about 44.4% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for first two months of FY 19**



Captive Jetties handled 27.2 MMT which accounted for about 44.4 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18  
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 3.10 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

**GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 4.66 MMT which accounted for about 7.36% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first two months of FY 19**

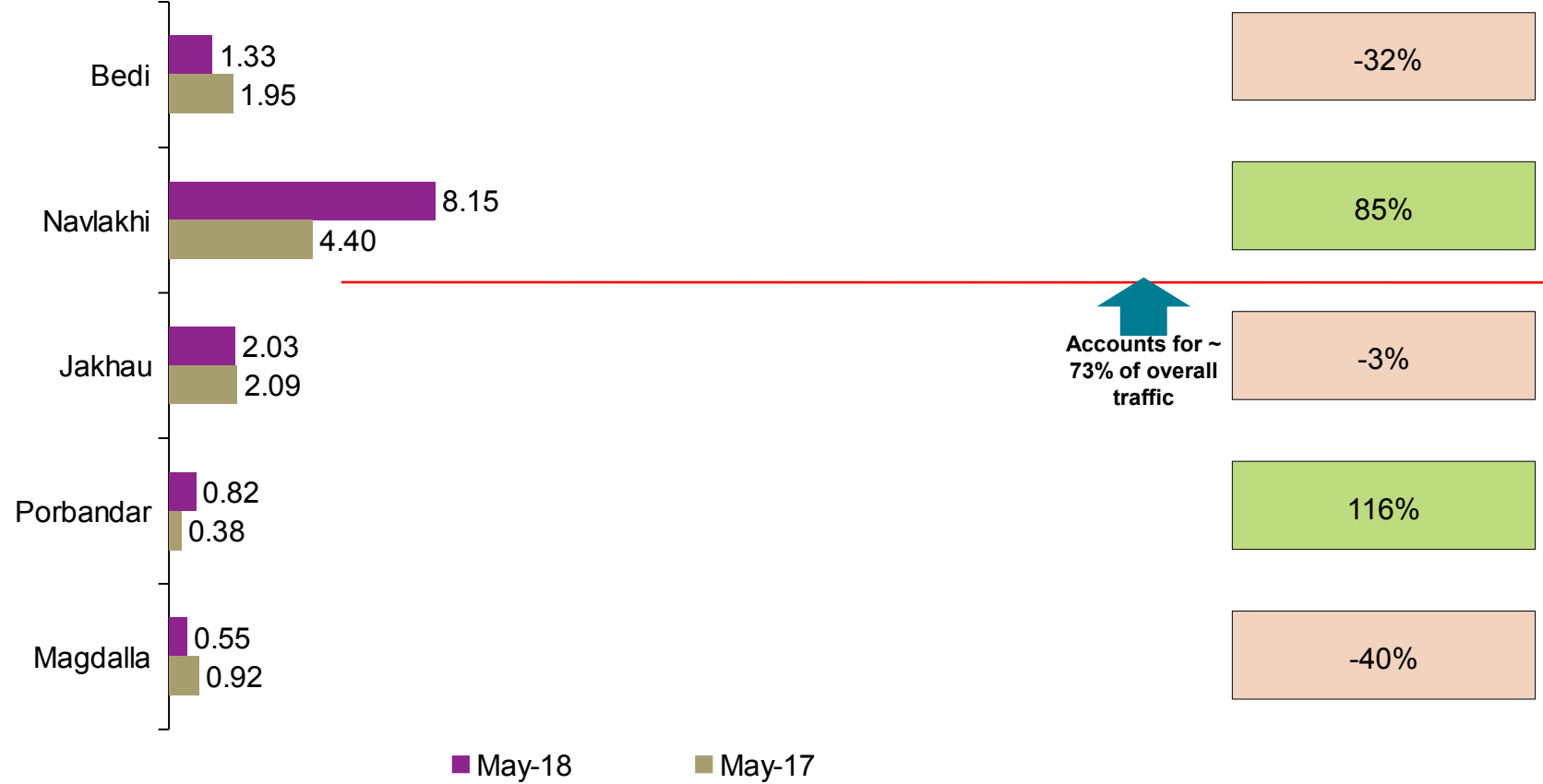
**Port Wise Traffic in Lakh Metric Tons**



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 5.05 MMT tons which accounted for about 8.2 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a decline of 8.68 % in FY 19 compared to the same period in FY18

**Private Jetties handled 1.28 MMT which accounted for about 2.0 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat the first two month of FY 19**

Private Jetties handled 0.97 MMT tons which accounted for about 1.5% of the total traffic compared to the same period in 2017-18
