



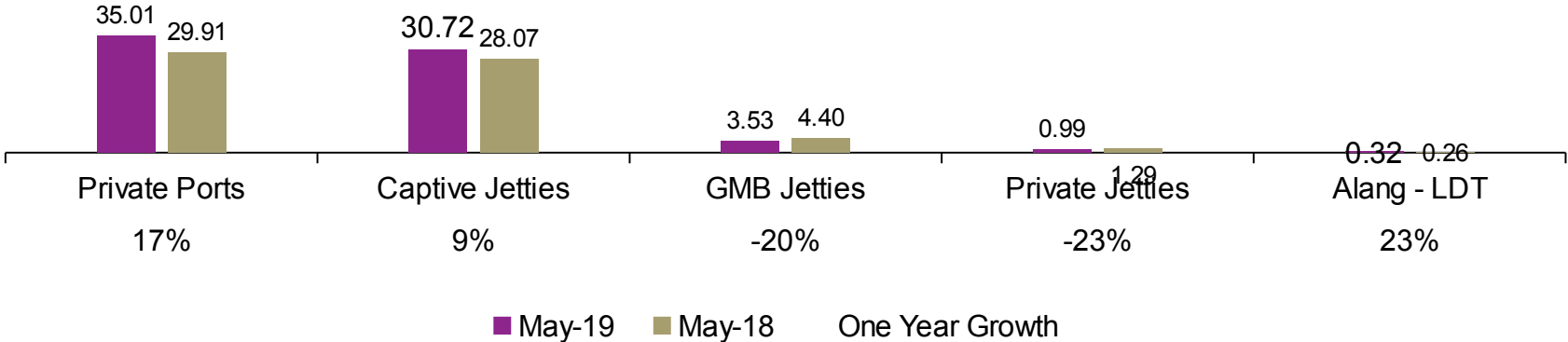

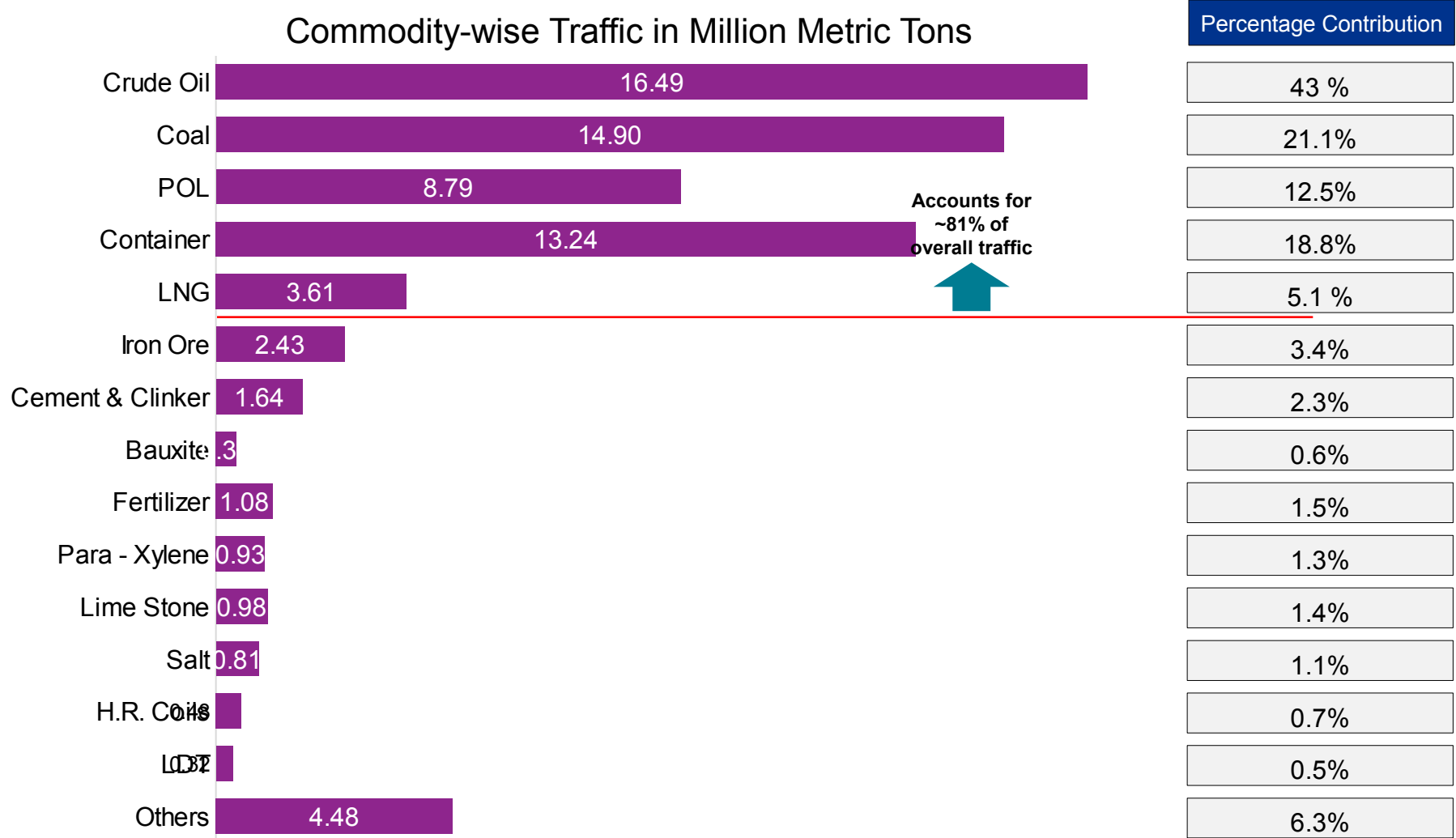
The traffic till the month of May-19 saw an increase of 10.38 % compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

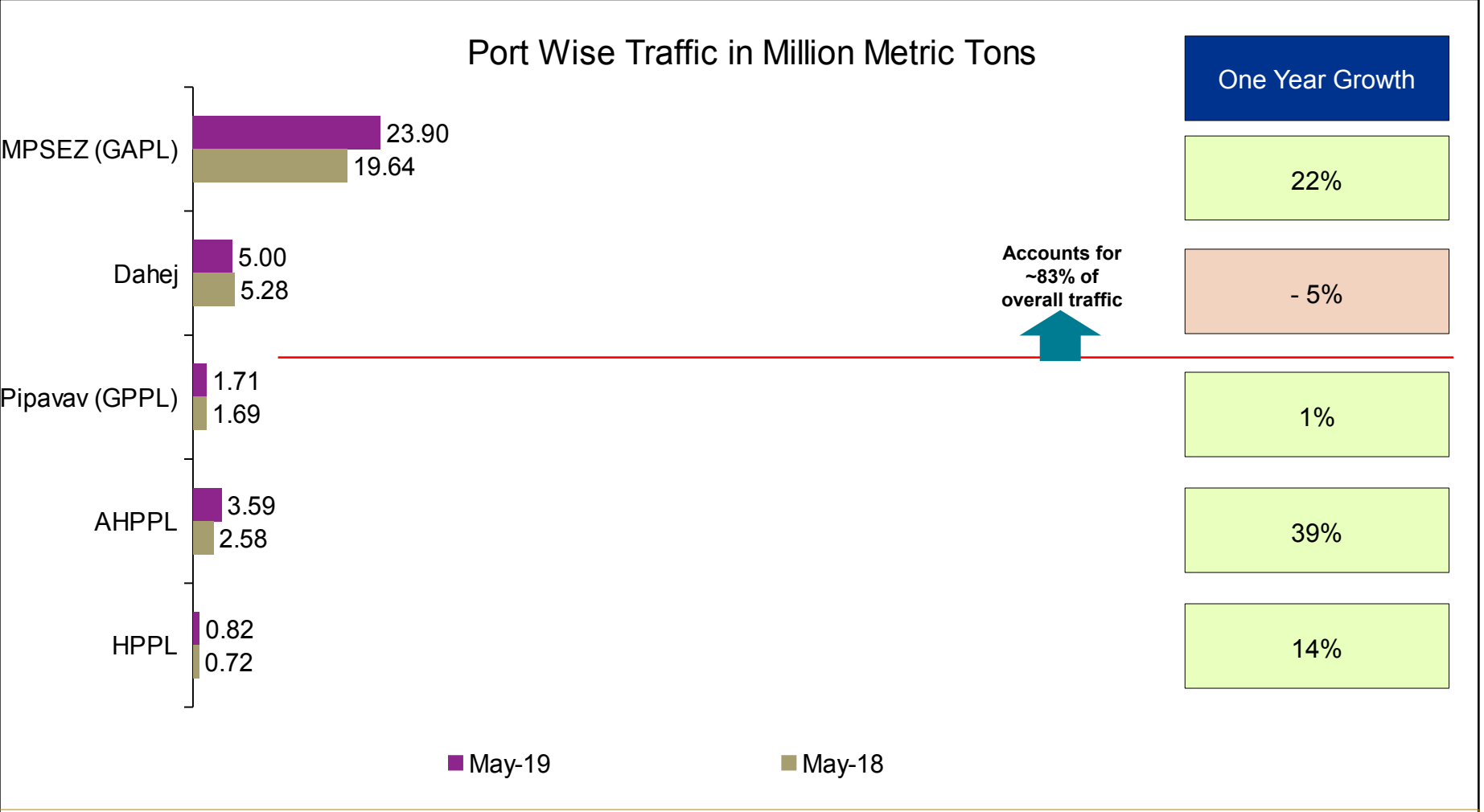

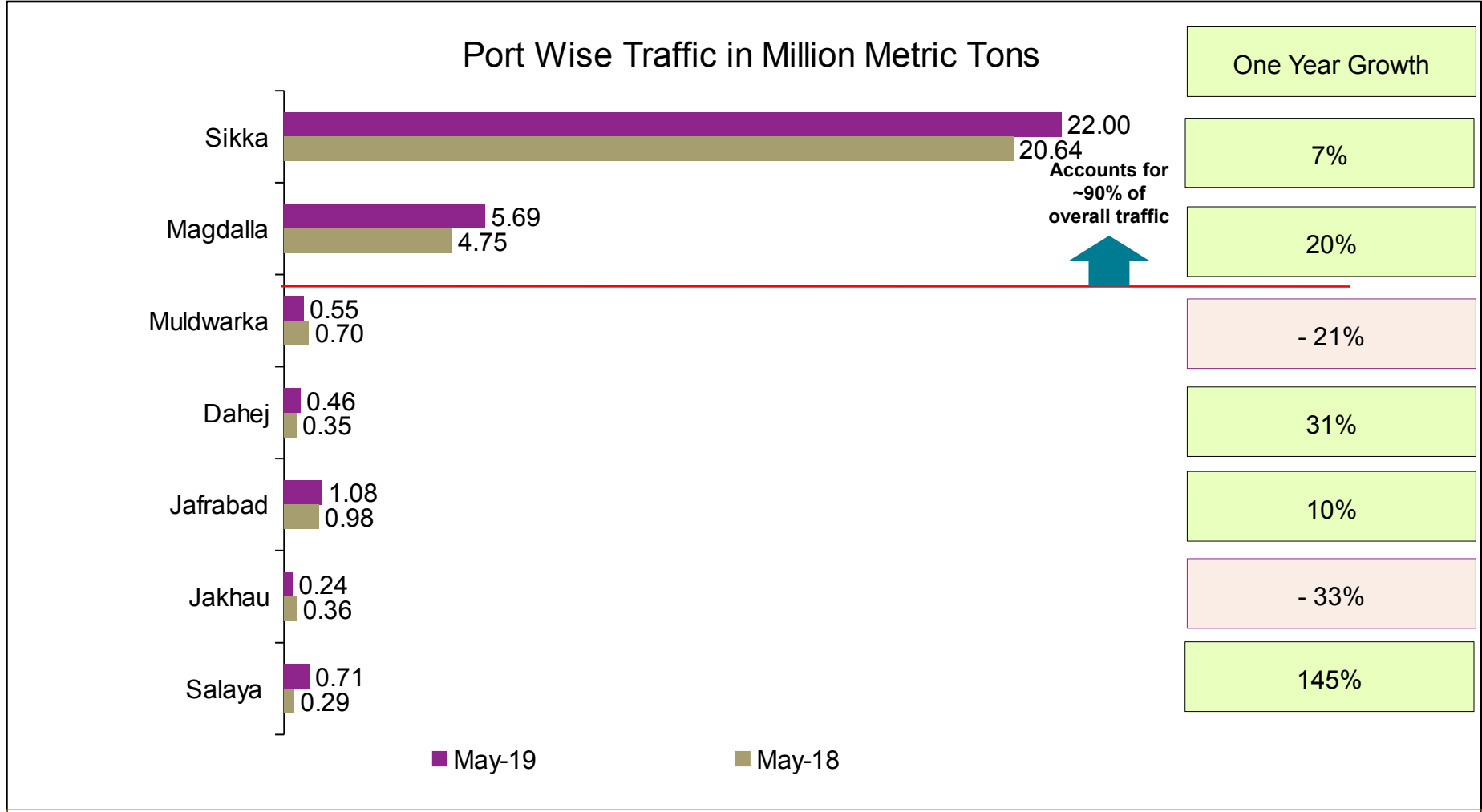


Private Ports handled 35.01 MMT which accounted for about 49.9% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat during first two months of FY 20



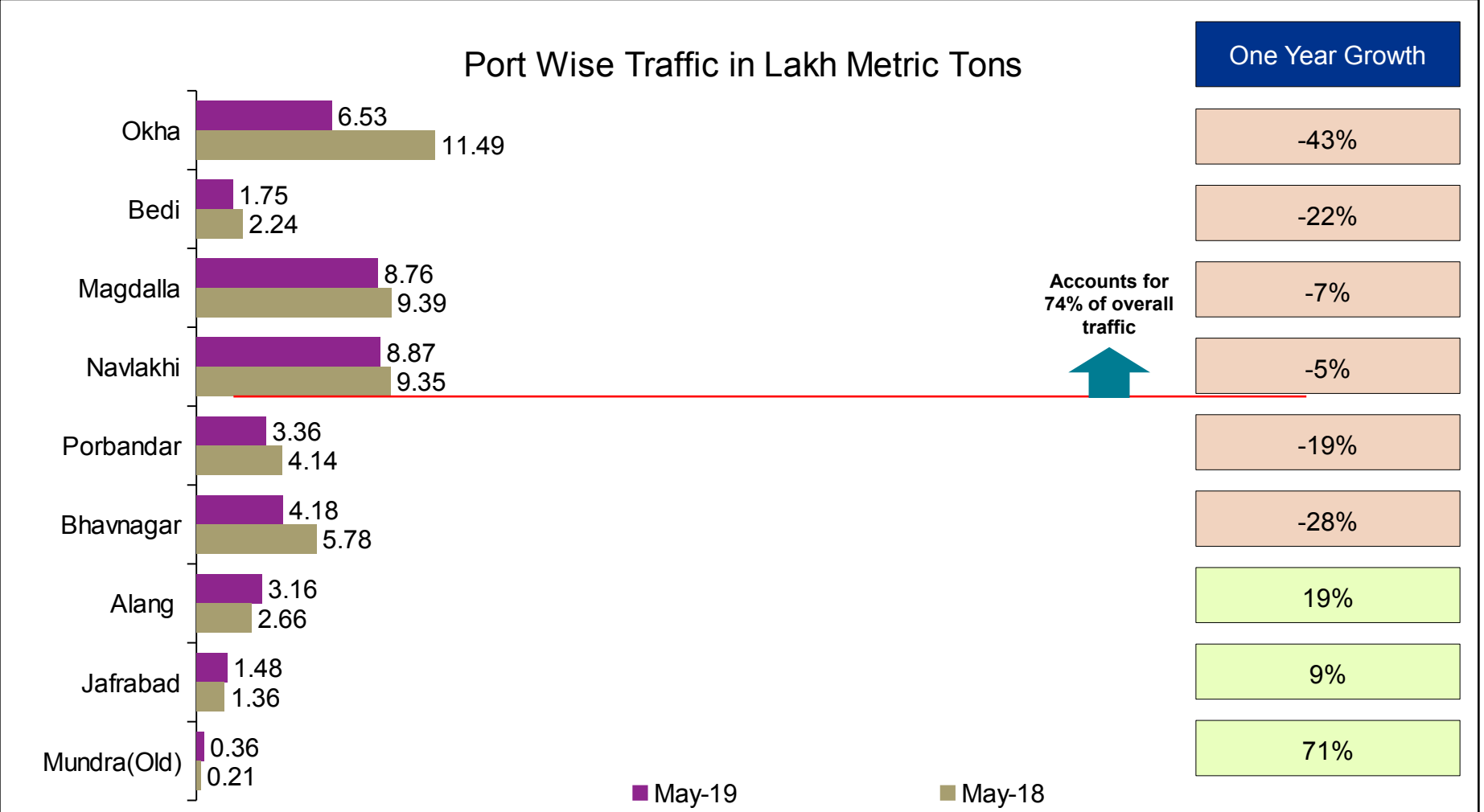
Private Ports handled 29.91 MMT which accounted for about 46.7 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 17.06 % in FY 20 compared to the same period in FY 19

Captive Jetties handled 30.72 MMT which accounted for about 43.5% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat during first two months of FY 20



Captive Jetties handled 28.08 MMT which accounted for about 43.9 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 9.43 % in FY 20 compared to the same period in FY 19

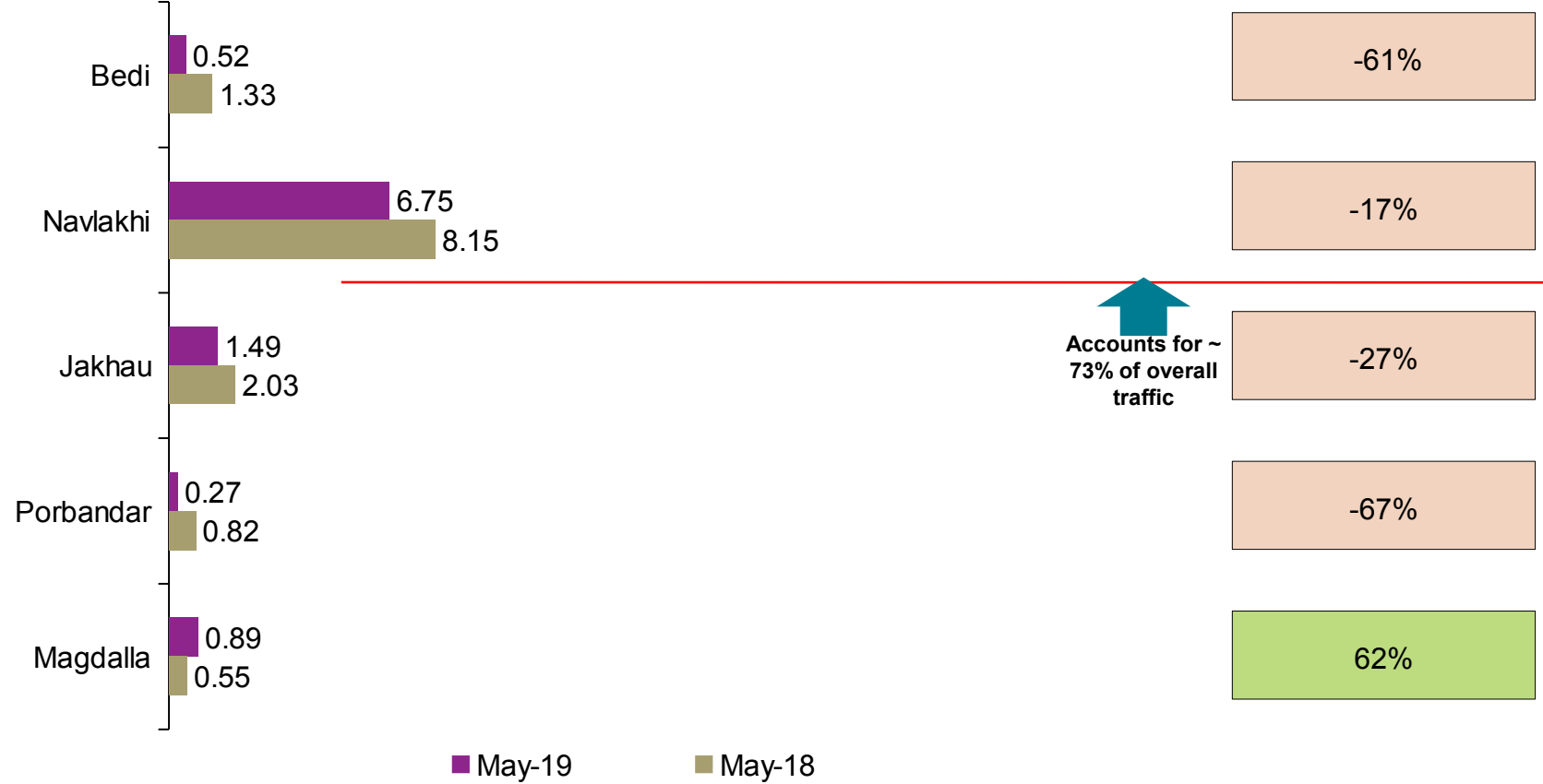
GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 3.85 MMT which accounted for about 5.4% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports during first two months of FY 20



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 4.66 MMT tons which accounted for about 7.2% of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19 .The cargo handled showed a decline of -17.52 % in FY 20 compared to the same period in FY19

Private Jetties handled 0.99 MMT which accounted for about 1.4 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat during first two months of FY 20

Private Jetties handled 1.29 MMT tons which accounted for about 2.0% of the total traffic compared to the same period in FY 19
