



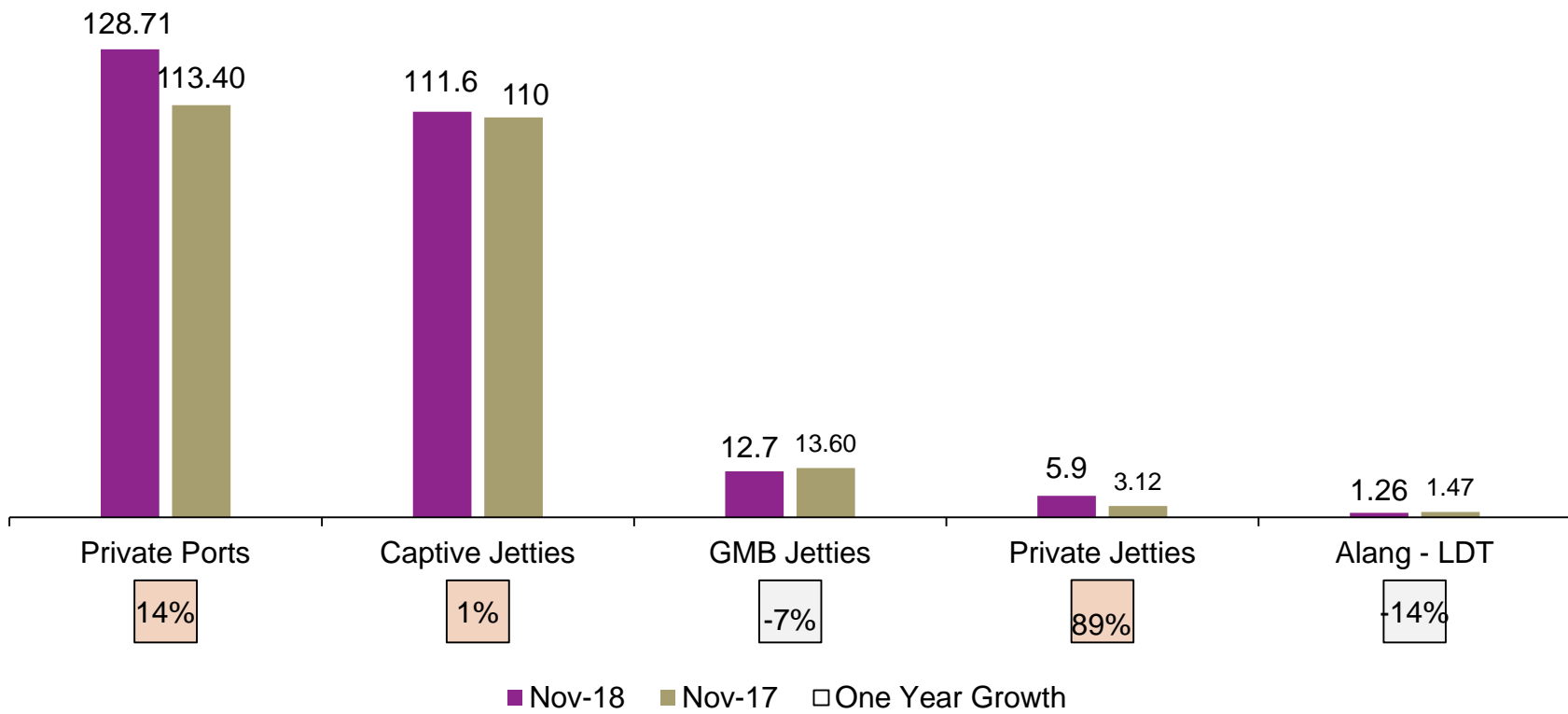

The traffic for the first eight months of FY 19 saw an increase of 7.65% compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

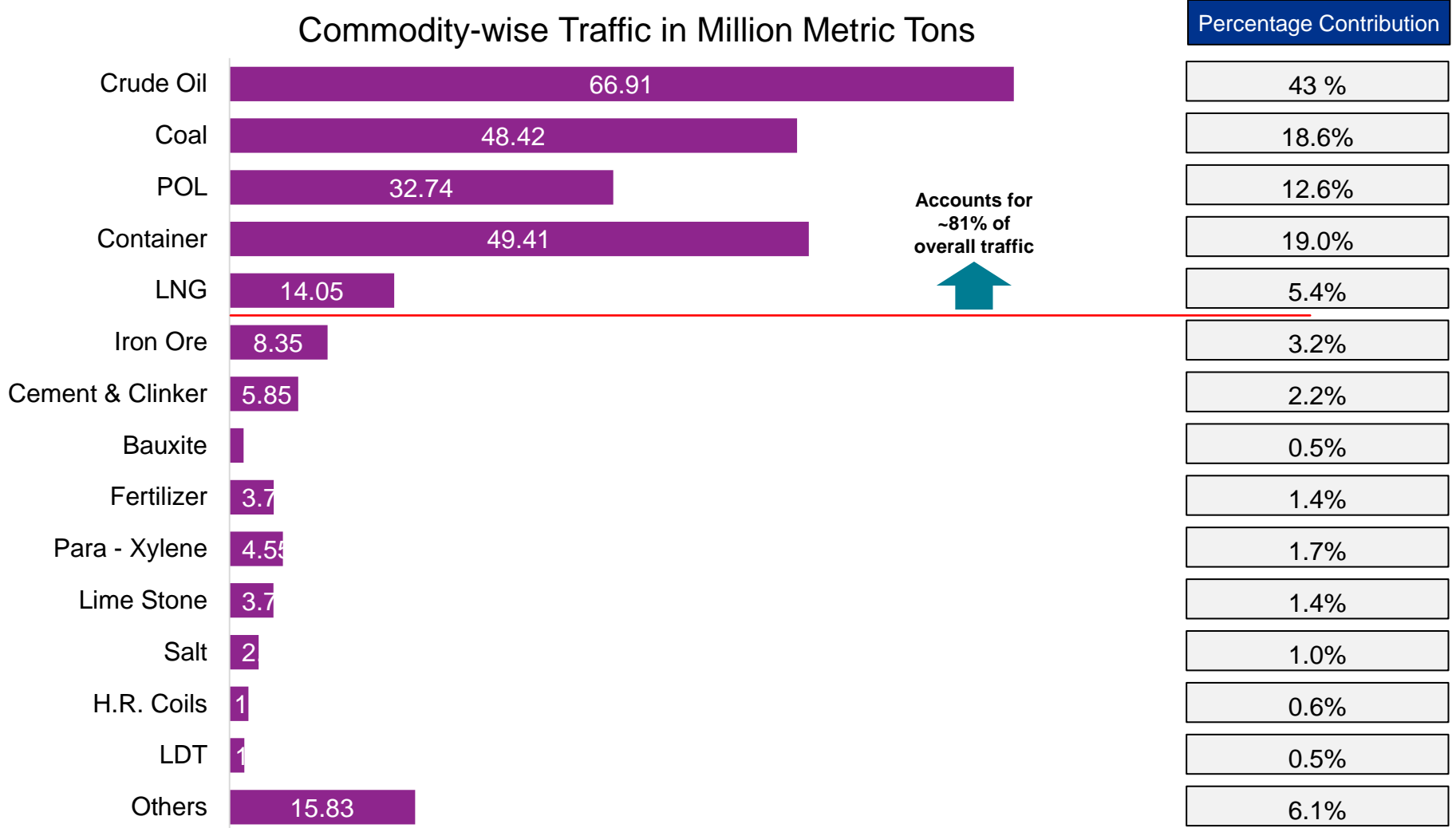
Facility-type-wise Traffic in Million Metric Tons

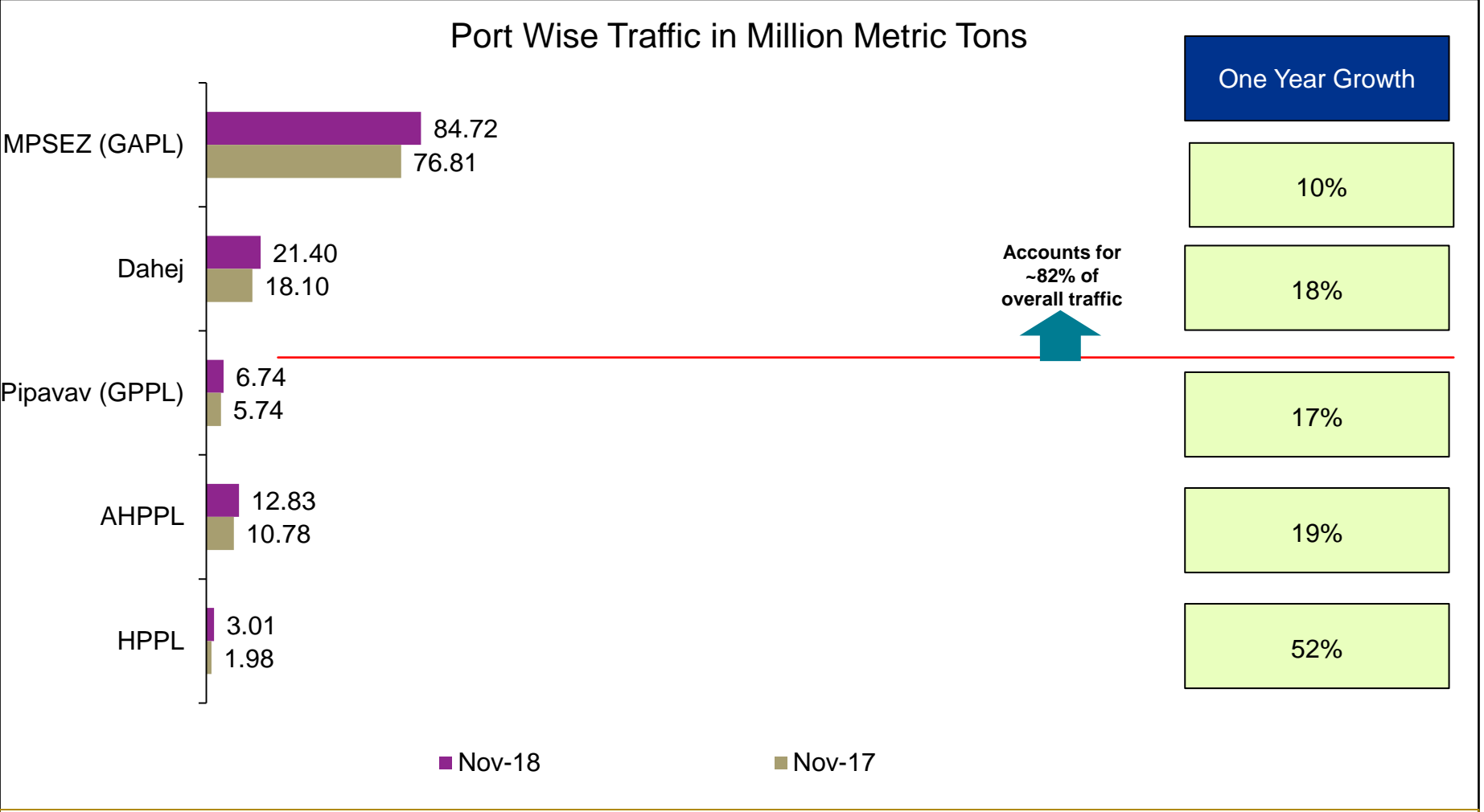

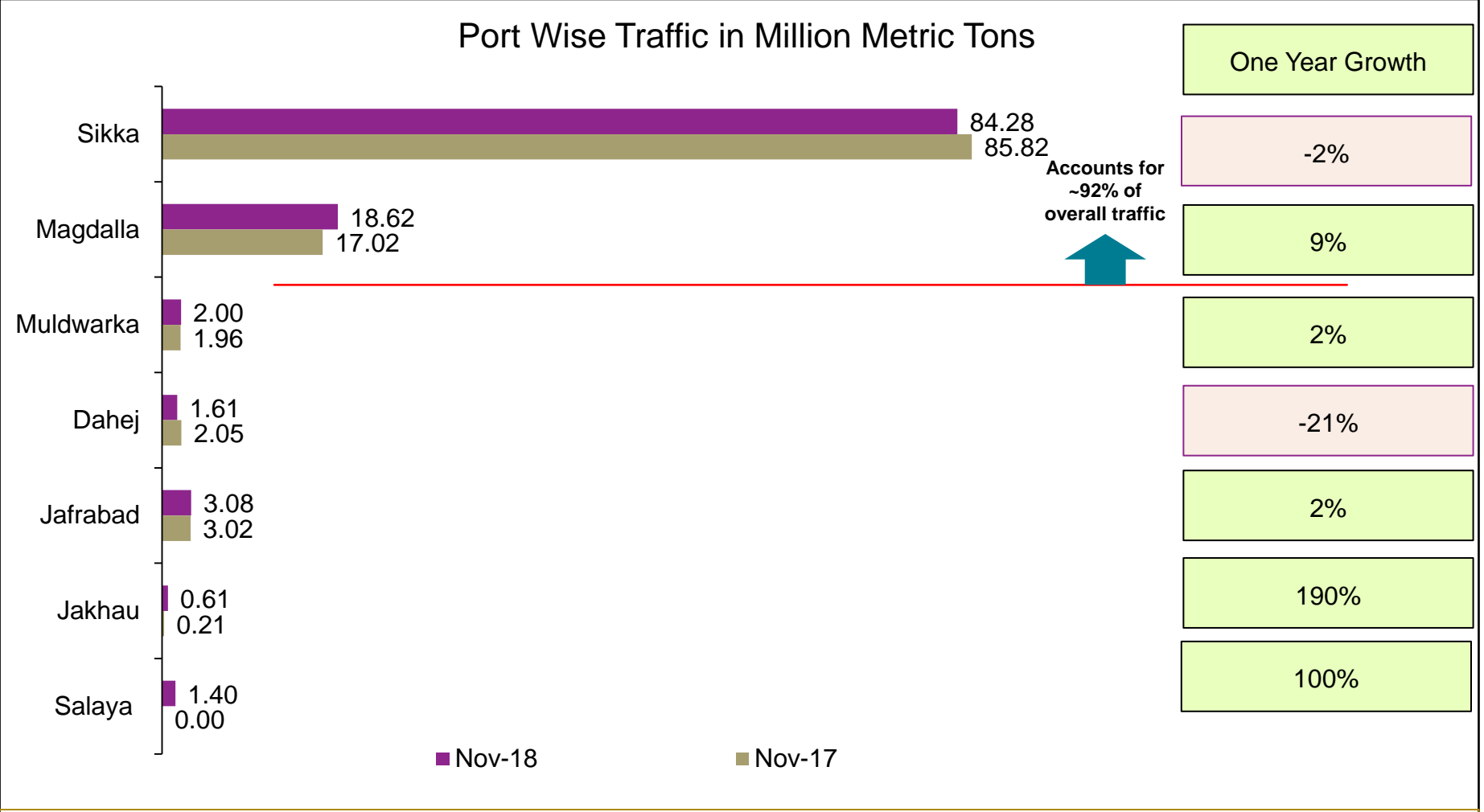


Private Ports handled 128.7 MMT which accounted for about 49% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first eight months of FY 19



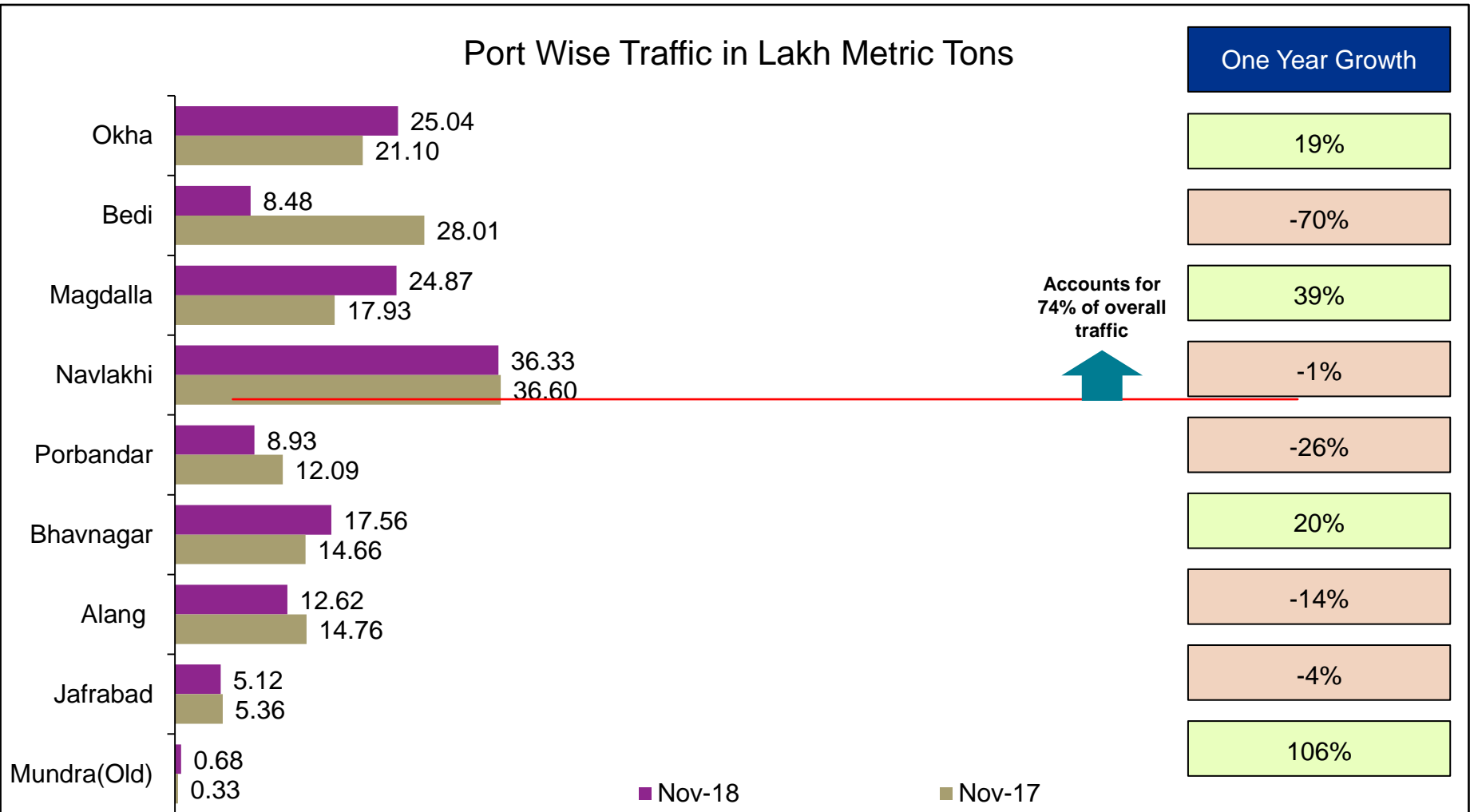
Private Ports handled 113.4 MMT which accounted for about 46.9 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 13.48 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

Captive Jetties handled 111.6 MMT which accounted for about 42.9% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for first eight months of FY 19



Captive Jetties handled 110 MMT which accounted for about 45.5% of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 1.40 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18

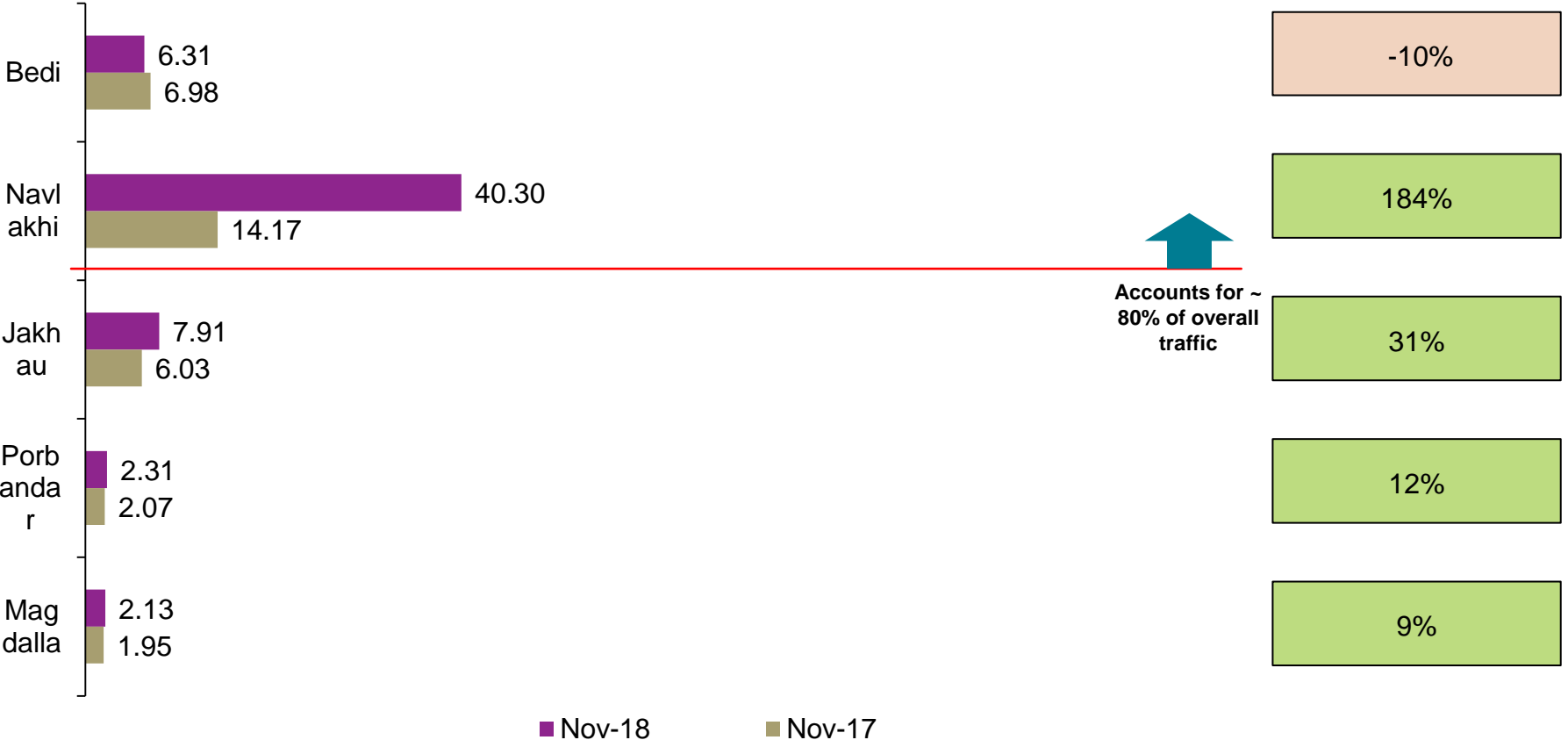
GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 13.9 MMT which accounted for about 5.3 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first eight months of FY 19



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 15 MMT tons which accounted for about 6.2 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a decline of 7.43% in FY 19 compared to the same period in FY18

Private Jetties handled 5.8 MMT which accounted for about 2.2 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat the first eight months of FY 19

Port Wise Traffic in Lakh Metric Tons



Private Jetties handled 3.1 MMT tons which accounted for about 1.2% of the total traffic compared to the same period in 2017-18. The cargo handled showed a growth of 89 % in FY 2018-19 compared to the same period in 2017-18
