



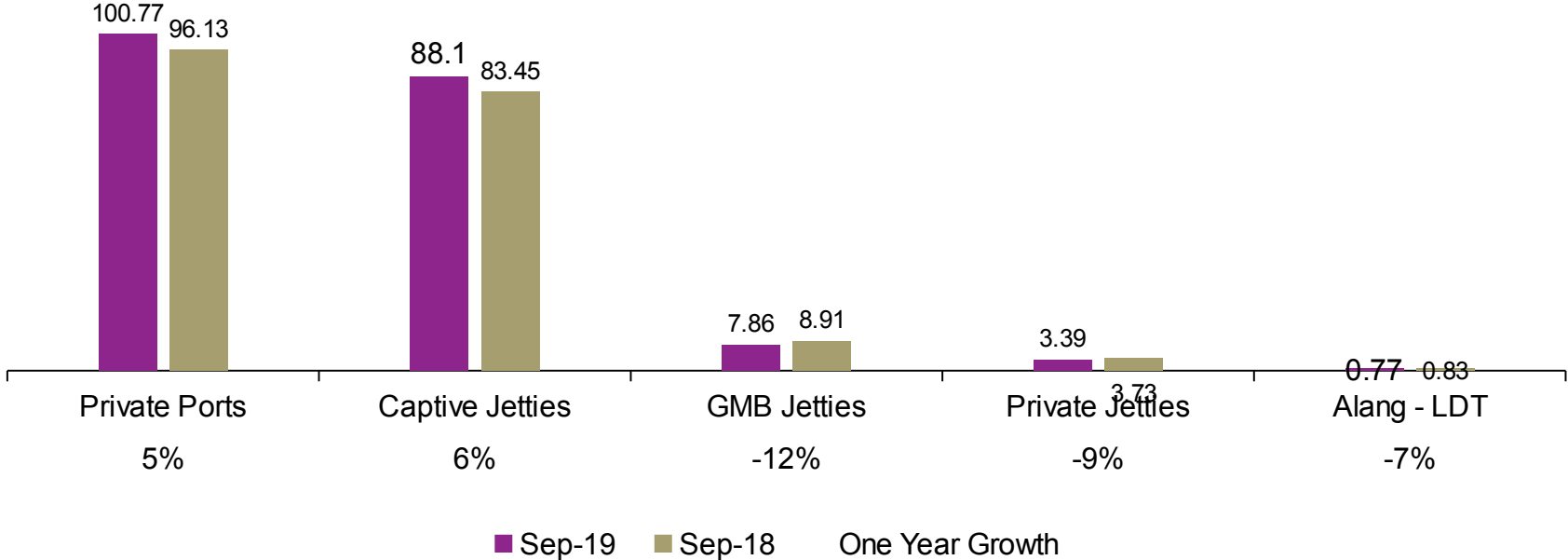

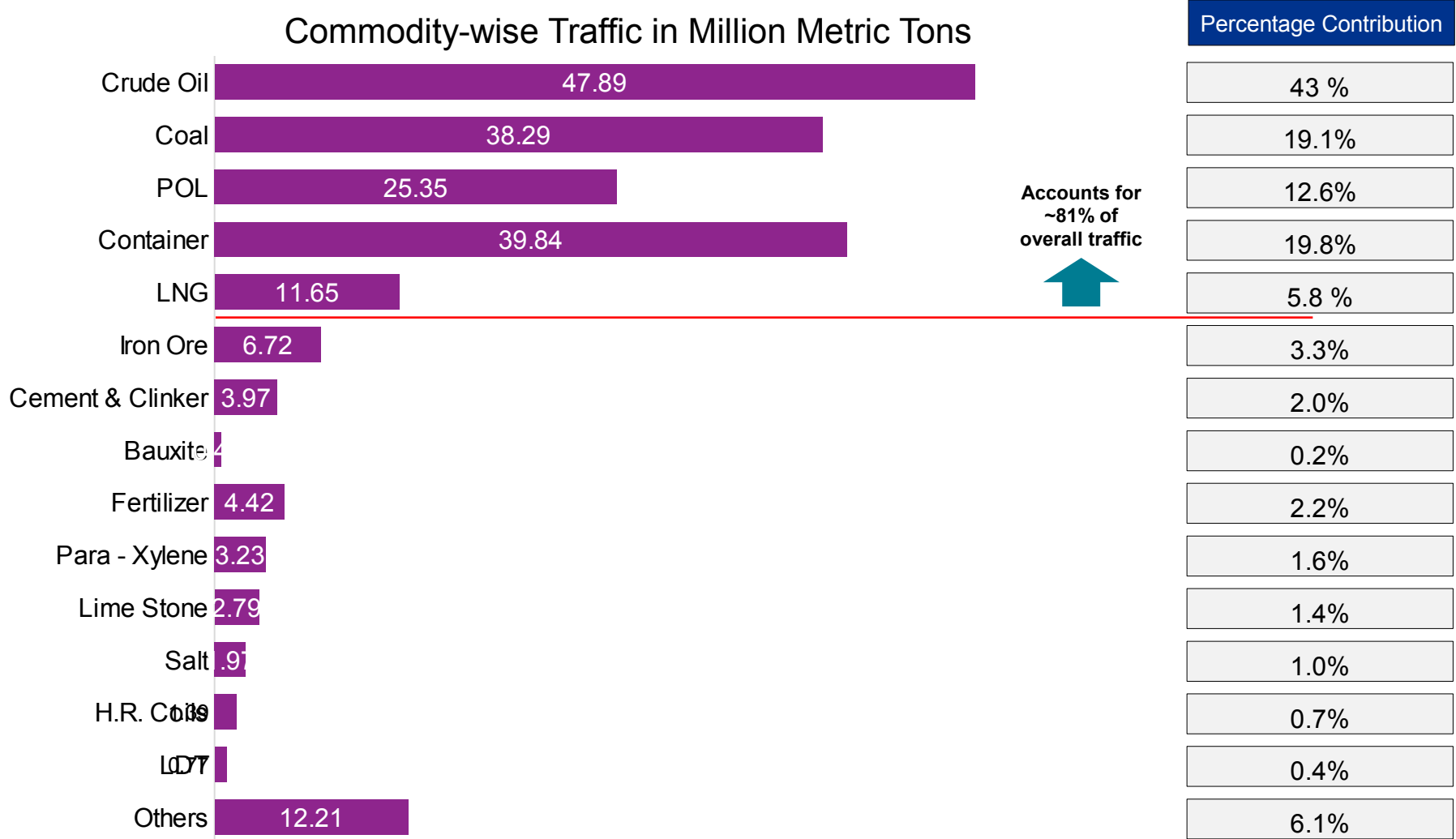
The traffic of the first two quarters of FY 20 saw an increase of 4.07 % compared to the cargo handled during the same period last year

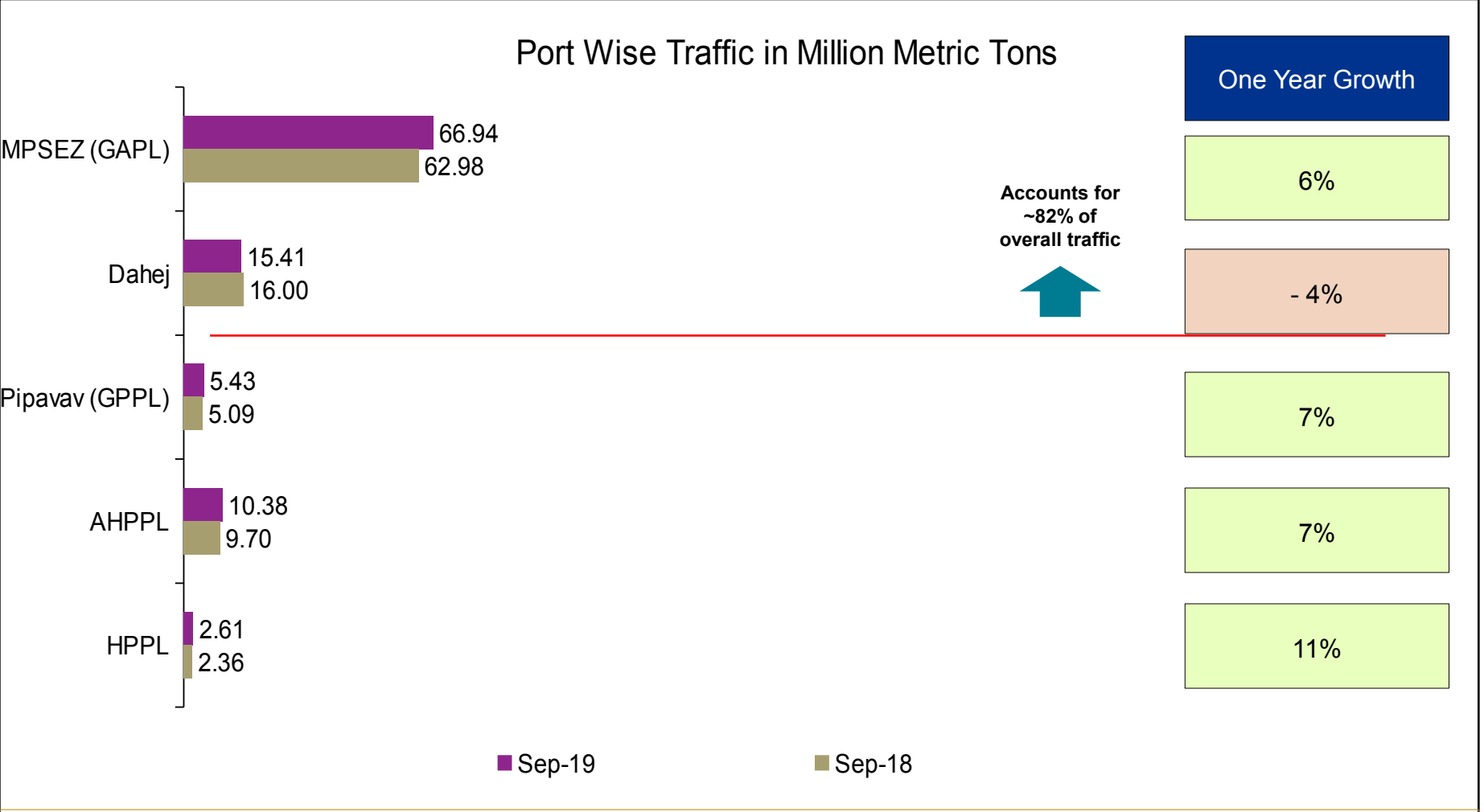

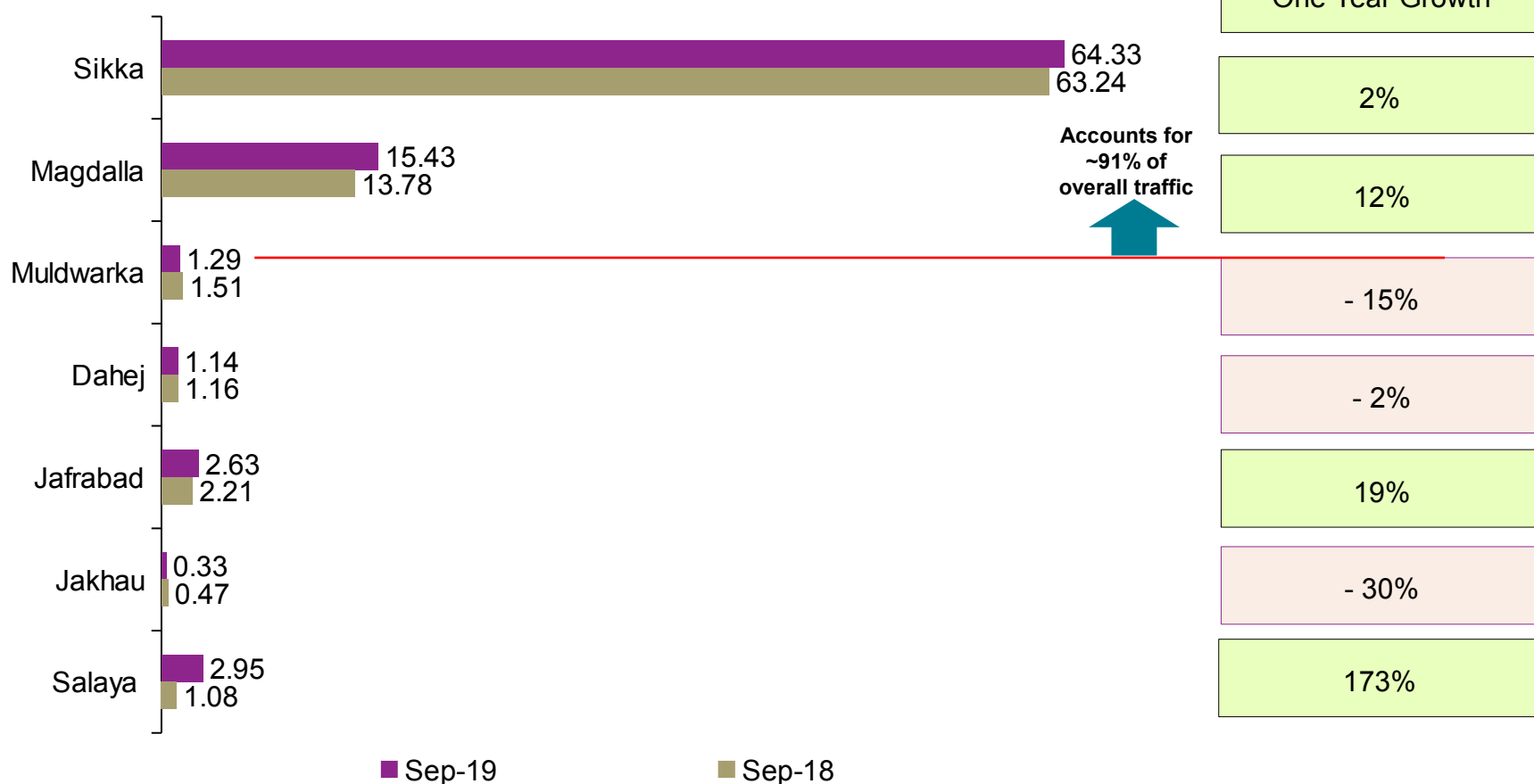
Private Ports handled 100.77 MMT which accounted for about 50.1% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first two quarters of FY 20



Private Ports handled 96.13 MMT which accounted for about 49.7% of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 4.83% in FY 2019-20 compared to the same period in 2018-19

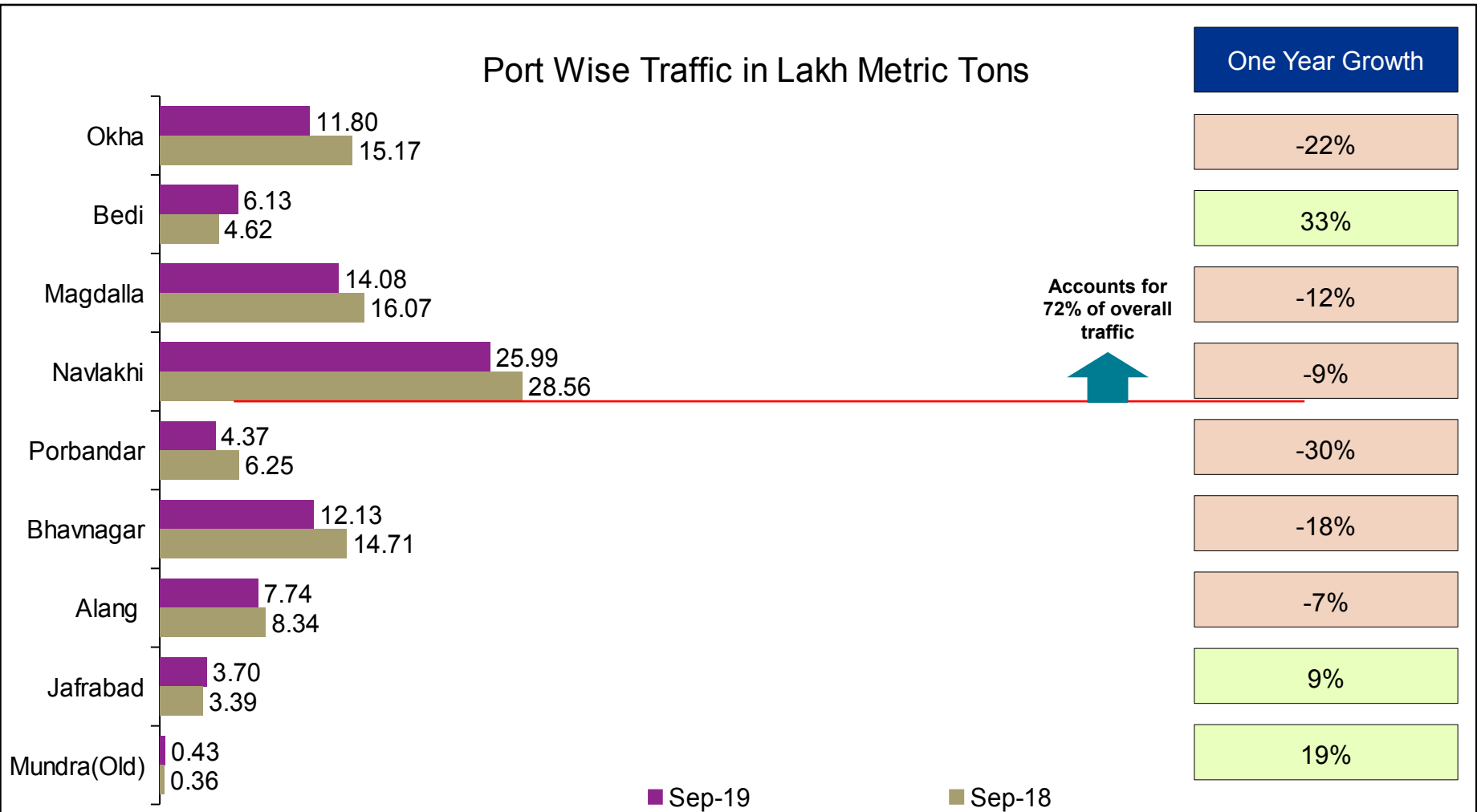
Captive Jetties handled 88.10 MMT which accounted for about 43.8% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in the first two quarters of FY 20

Captive Jetties handled 83.45 MMT which accounted for about 43.2 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19
 The cargo handled showed a growth of 5.58 % in FY 2019-20 compared to the same period in 2018-19

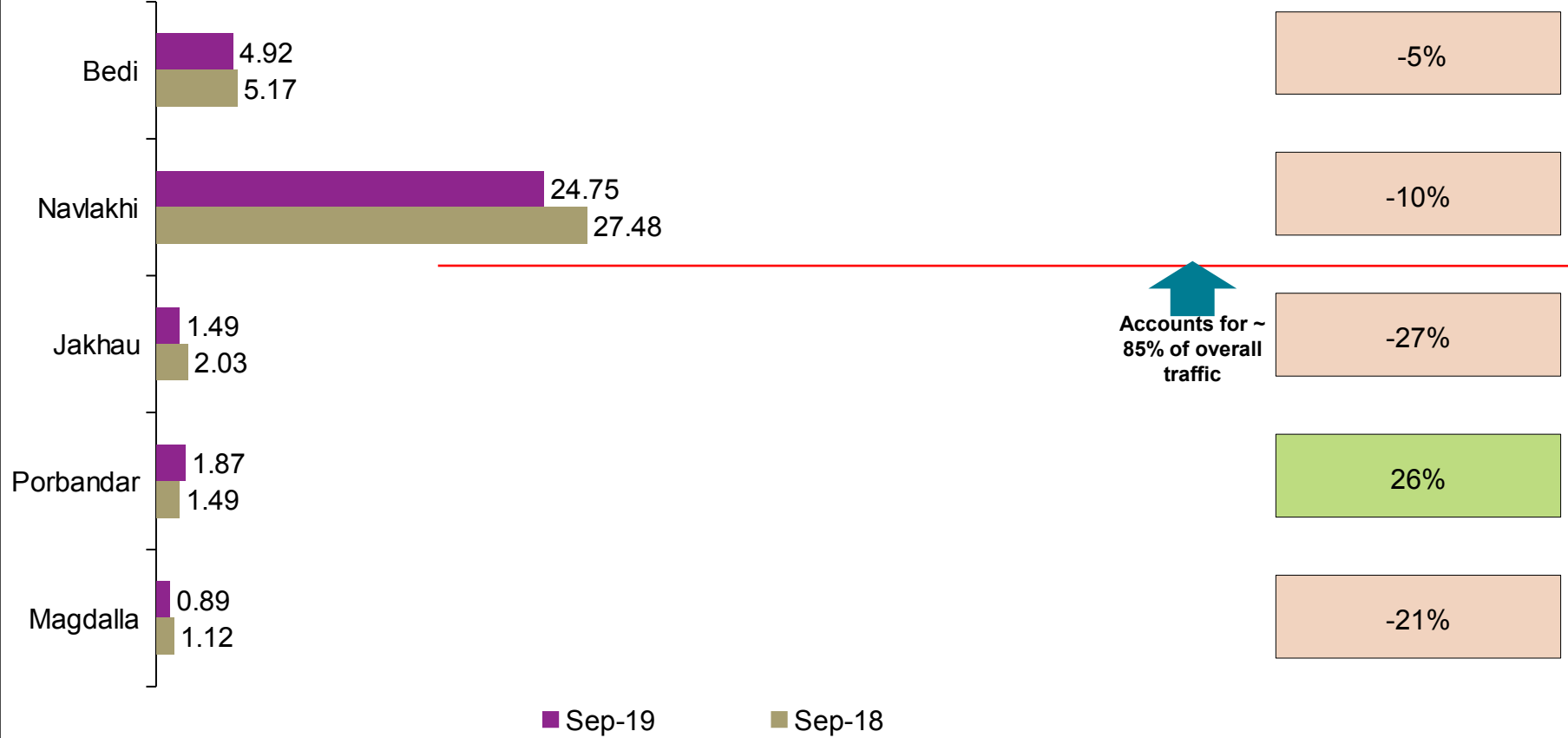
GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 8.64 MMT which accounted for about 4.3% of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat in the first two quarters of FY 20



GMB Operated Jetties (including Alang) handled 9.75 MMT tons which accounted for about 5.1 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19 .The cargo handled showed a decline of 11.39 % in FY 20 compared to the same period in FY19

Private Jetties handled 3.39 MMT which accounted for about 1.7 % of the total traffic registered at non-major ports in Gujarat for the first two quarters of FY 20

Private Jetties handled 3.73 MMT tons which accounted for about 1.9 % of the total traffic during the same period in 2018-19 .The cargo handled showed a decline of 9.04 % in FY 20 compared to the same period in FY19
